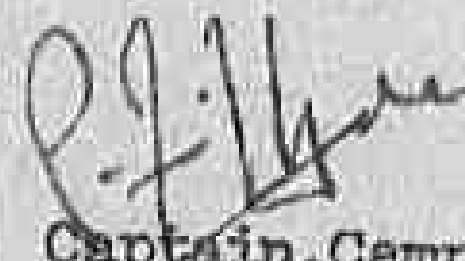

In accordance with RAAG Operations Memo No.6, dated 14th Aug 44 and in view of the possibility of bad weather affecting road communication, the Officers' Messes will hold a reserve of 3 days hard rations (e.g. Biscuits, Tinned Equivalents in lieu of fresh rations).

Particular care will be taken to keep reserve holdings separate from normal daily rations, complete and in good condition. Special attention should be paid to regular turnover of all items composing the reserve rations.

These reserves will be available for inspection by S.F. representative or C.O., D.I.D.

Reserve Rations will be issued to messes on inventory and should be kept locked up.

It is probable that the reserve rations will be available for collection from the Q.M. stores on the afternoon of 24th October 1944, and should then be collected by Mess R.O.Os.

H.Q., London, stating that owing to difficulties in obtaining bottles, beer shipments from Canada were falling off by over 100,000 cases per month, and that beer must be expected to be in very short for a period of at least 3 months. A further communication has been received from AFHQ to the effect that there is still no improvement in sight.
- 3 For the past five weeks all beer has been sent to the troops forward of Army and Corps boundaries, with the exception of the British share of the local beer from the Bari Brewery, which is unsuitable for drinking. This has been issued to Bari Regt Camp and Operational Air Force in the Foggia area, and the small remainder locally in the Bari area. Otherwise I of C Troops have had no beer for five weeks.
- 4 There is a possibility of a further supply coming from the Tunis Brewery which may make possible a restricted issue later in June.
- 5/Local to sheet 2

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5 Local production of beer is hampered by lack of certain essential commodities, which cannot be obtained locally. The position has been presented to AFHQ and H.Q. M.A.P.F.I. London are endeavouring to make good this position. It is in addition hoped that the supply of imported beer will improve.

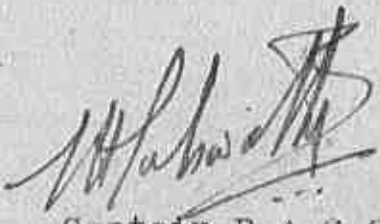
