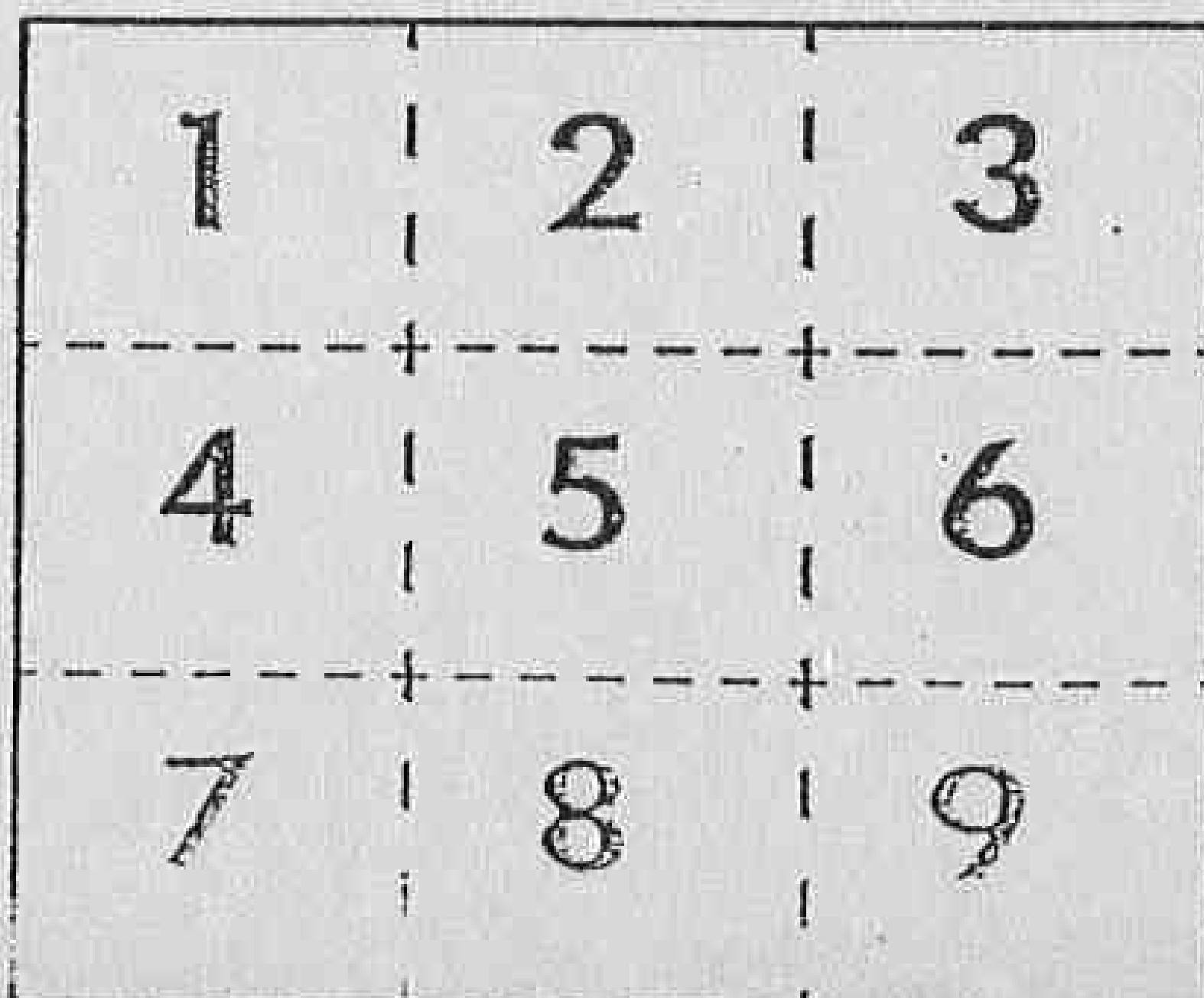
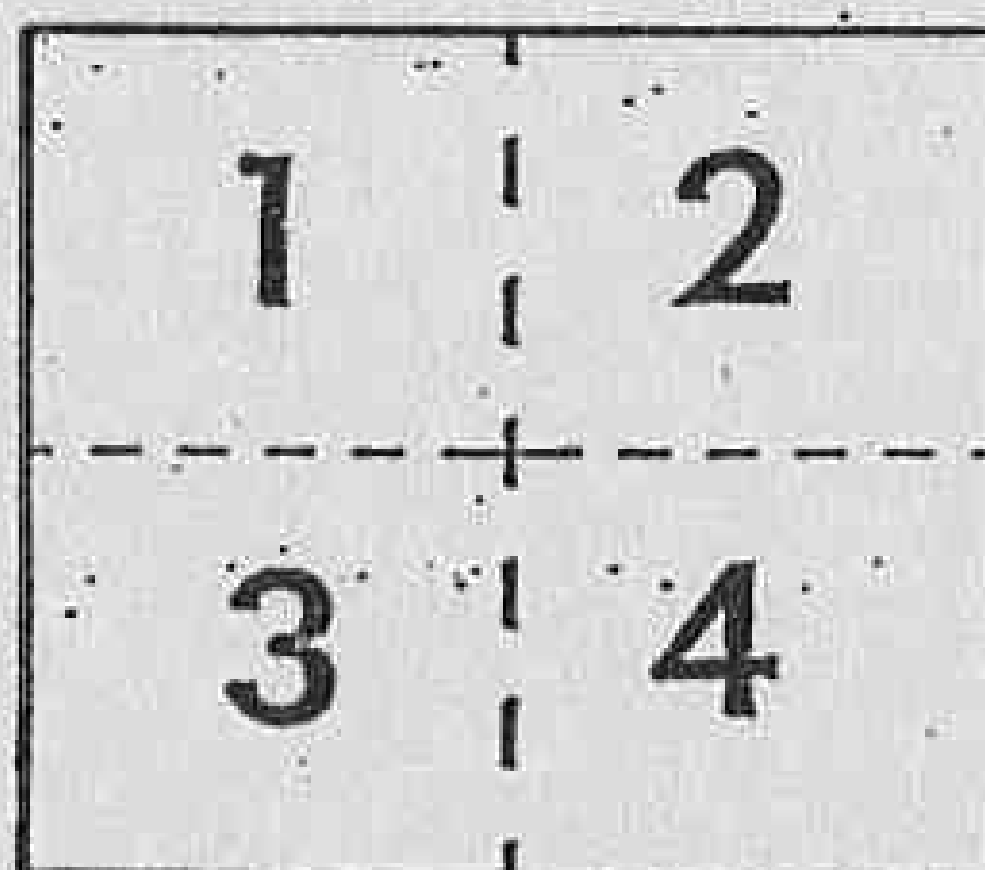
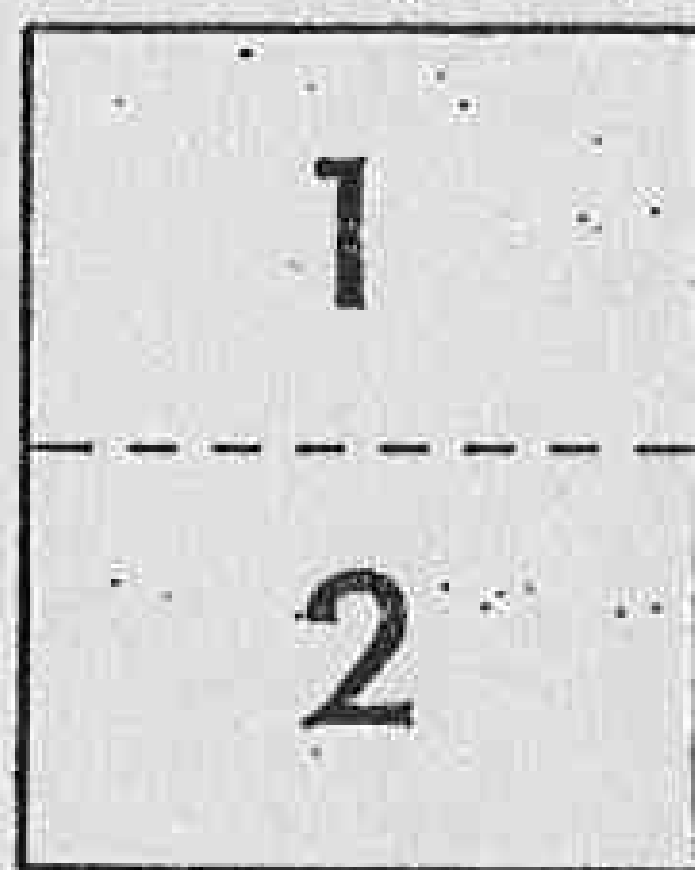

inclusion of SICILY and SARDINIA in the responsibilities of this HQ and the supply control and accountability requirements as indicated by the recent visit of Staff Officers from AFHQ based on FAN 338.

4. As in my G/8/18 of 1 Mar 44, I have assumed that the personnel of Adv HQ SALERNO will be attached from A.C.C. as their duties are those of liaison with Comando Supremo on all subjects affecting its dealings with A.C.C. If you wish to have them included on my establishment will you please take up the matter (for both American and British staff involved) with HQ AAI with copy to me.

5. The following points have been considered in crystallising the British WE:-

(a) Allowance has been made for the lessening of Italian Army responsibility for Allied L of C by the deletion of two Engineer officers and their staff.

(b) One Staff Capt previously proposed for liaison with HQ AAI has been deleted as he is considered better to effect this by frequent personal visits of officers from this HQ.

(c) A Pool of Interpreters has been inserted instead of showing them separately under the various Services as heretofore. No increase or decrease is involved.

7. (c) I request that the T/C(Prov) be approved as early as possible as a separate entity from 2675 Regt in order that the position may be regularised and the remaining officers assigned.

8. The d tailed implication of the proposed increase to WE/NA/24.1/1 will be laid before the WE Committee by my AA & QM. He is also available to explain such points in the proposed US T/C(Prov) as may be necessary.

9. The proposals forwarded herewith are recommended for major review in six months time when the AA I programme as at present framed, should be completed.

10. It is requested that this letter be treated as urgent as the extra personnel involved have in large part already been obtained on loan in order to carry out the work.

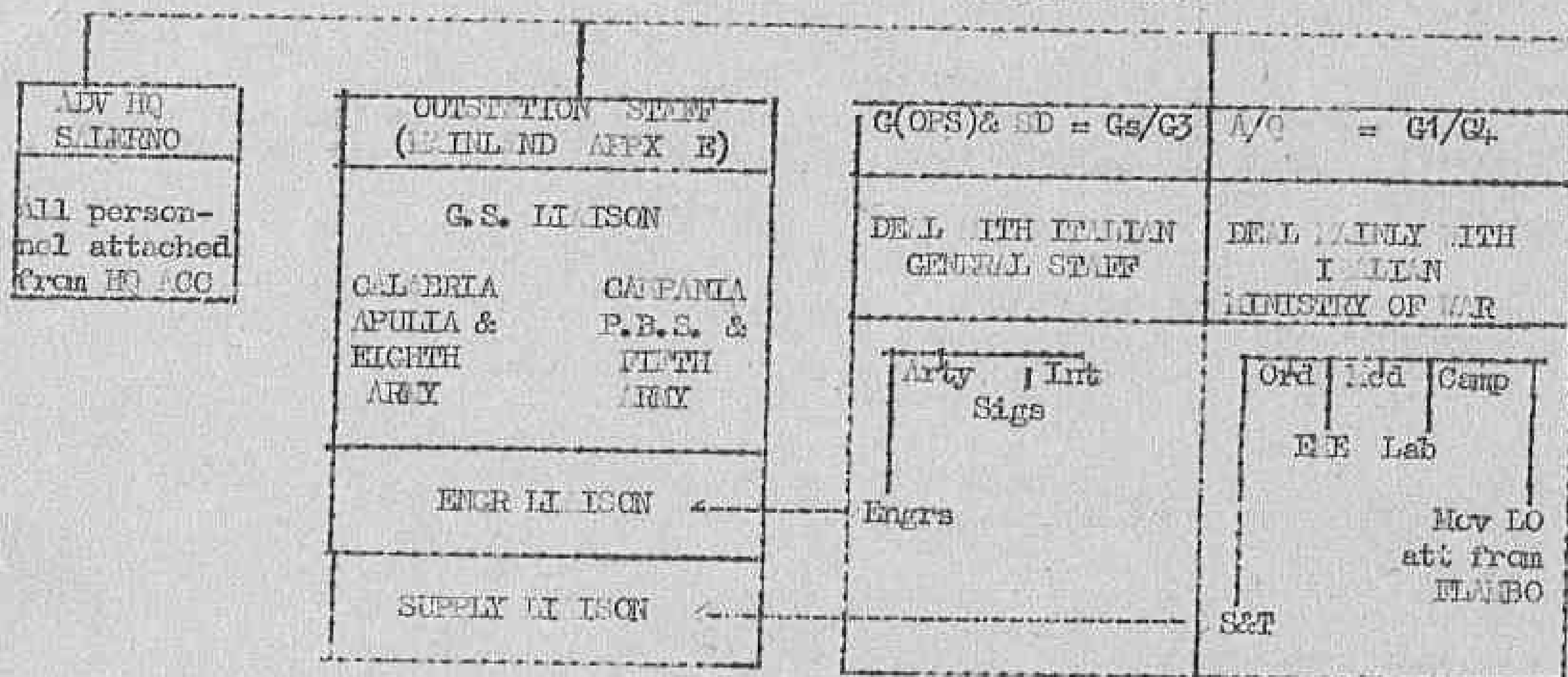
