He is very worried, as his sight is getting worse, and as you can guess is worried about the future after the war, as his sight is important. We have three children to make a living for. Will you please see if you can help him by getting the Army Authorities to get the right glasses out there to him.

He has to see the specialists out there about every three months, and all that has been done in the past year, is to re-grade him from A.1. to B.5."

Sir,

As desired during my personal interview with you this morning, I give below extract of letter from my Wife dated 29th Jan. relating to my Father who is seriously ill in Hospital:-

"Have just received a notice from the Essex County Council informing you - (It was addressed to you of course) that poor old 'J.D.' is in St. Margarets Hospital, Epping & the payment for same is 36/2d per week. Attached were the usual pages of questions on every damned thing (private) they could think of, and a note typed at the top - 'Unless this is filled in and returned within 7 days it will be presumed the full amount is to be deducted' ....."

I am very worried - more especially as my Father was all alone at home (both my brothers being in H.M. Forces) - but it appears to me (a) that as, being married, my Army pay is only approx. 19/- per week I cannot possibly be held liable to pay 36/2d per week or (b) if I can still be held liable then it is perhaps a case for which there is some provision in the Army in the form of a grant, or some sort of assistance. I would add that my Father, in the event of illness is, so far as I am aware, entirely without means and am naturally anxious to know that he is being properly taken care of.

I understand, Sir, that you will take up this matter with the proper Army Authority and trust to hear of a favourable outcome in due course.
