CMP Charges and Evidence.

1. Disposal of charges preferred by Provost Service.

- (a). All charges against soldiers preferred by the Provost Service will be brought before O&C units, and will not be disposed of by subordinate commanders.
- (b). After disposal, the original AF B252 will be sent to GHQ 2nd Echelon, where necessary under Section 11 of GRO 793/44; and a certified true copy (or the original, if not sent to GHQ 2nd Echelon) will be sent to the Brigade or equivalent HQ for information.

2. Framing of Charges.

- (a) AF B252 is NOT a charge but is a charge report from which a charge or charges should be framed by the investigating officer. Cases will not be dismissed, nor charge reports returned to military police on the grounds that charges have been improperly framed by them.

- (b) Para 4 of ACI 1911/41 is republished for information and compliance. The NCO or other person who makes out a charge report (AF B252) does not necessarily know all the facts. For instance a charge of absence in a charge report submitted to a unit commander by military police will usually not mention the date on which the absence began, as the military police do not know the date, similarly the charge report will not mention other offences of which the military police are not aware.

It is the duty of the officer who investigates the case to see that charges containing the necessary particulars are entered in the guard report or other document on which the case is brought before him.

3. Attendance of CMP Witnesses.

- (a) Demands are frequently made for the attendance of CMP witnesses at Court Martial, the taking of summaries of evidence and investigations of O&C. Owing to the large number of cases in which CMP are concerned, it is essential :-

(i) That no demand which is not absolutely necessary be made and

(ii) that when the presence of a CMP witness is required adequate notice be given.

- (b) In connection with (a) (i) above attention is directed to the following provisions of ACI 1311 of 1941 which will frequently enable a witness's presence to be dispensed with :-

When a CO is investigating (a case reported on AF B252, the CMP) the attendance of CMP witness's will not be requested unless the accused disputes the statement of evidence on the AF B252, or such part of it as is admissible in evidence, will be used in accordance with the Manual of Military Law, 1929, Rules of Procedure, Rule 4(C) unless the accused demands the presence of the witnesses."

- (c) In connection with (a) (ii) above, when the attendance of a

(c) member of the SIB (CAP) at the taking of a Summary of Evidence is essential, at least 2 clear days notice will be given.

When the attendance of such a witness is required at a Court Martial, at least 3 clear days notice will be given.

NOTICE BOARD INFORMATION

Discipline - Desertion

The attention of all ranks is drawn to the fact that, under the Release Regulations, a soldier who deserts on or after 1 Feb 45, will, on conviction by Court-Martial for the offence of desertion, forfeit all service prior to the date of such desertion, for the purpose of release from the Army under the Age-and-Service Group Scheme.

The result is that a soldier who deserts after 1 Feb 45, and is convicted by a Court-Martial, is in the same position as regards release as if he had been called up on the day on which he is discharged from prison.

Service so forfeited may be restored on the order of an officer not below the rank of Major-General if, after discharge from prison, the soldier

- (a) has been recommended for an award or mention for gallantry by an officer not below the rank of Lieutenant-Colonel, or
- (b) has held the rank of Corporal for three months or is promoted to higher rank, or
- (c) completes 18 months clear of an adverse entry in his Regimental Conduct Sheet.

Except in these cases, only the Army Council can restore the service prior to desertion, on special recommendation where the soldier has performed good and faithful service or shewn special merit.

Whenever the desertion took place, the period spent in desertion and the period whilst the sentence is in execution will be forfeited for purposes of release, and these periods cannot be restored.

Lieut. K. Sutor and Lieut. J. Ashton from the Office of the Financial Adviser AFHQ will visit Rome 5 Feb to 17 Feb 45 for the purpose of inspecting accounts, records and stocks of Stores and Supplies Depots and other accounting units.

It is not known exactly which units will be visited but Heads of Services and O&C units will afford the necessary facilities to these officers during their visit.

AOI 2109/42 is repeated for information and strict compliance:-

1. The measures ordered in AOI 375 of 1941 have not succeeded in eliminating waste of clothing, which - with its consequent waste of shipping, manpower and money - is still a definite and serious hindrance to the nation's war effort.
2. Issues to soldiers in replacement of actual or alleged deficiencies in their kit, whether made free or chargeable against the soldier, will be carefully scrutinised to ensure that such issues are not used as a means of procuring army clothing for civilians. It will be made clear that this form of 'Black Market' offence may involve both the soldier and the civilian concerned in severe penalties.

Voluntary purchases which would bring the soldier's clothing and necessities in excess of the authorized scale, are forbidden.

Sir,

I respectfully submit this report to you.

The damage caused to Austin Utility No 5288603 was caused by me.

I do not remember much of the incident except that I left the Headquarters Office at 2245 hrs on the 14th May 1944 together with a friend. We consumed spirits in a local house and thereafter proceeded to a dance.

I drank a considerable amount in this house, and do not remember clearly leaving the building, and have little or no recollection of entering the dance. At about 0130 hrs (I cannot verify this time as I do not remember what time I arrived at my billet) I drove away the above mentioned vehicle.

The journey from the village I cannot recall and I do not truthfully remember anything until I found the vehicle bumping on an uneven surface. A few second later the car tilted and rolled over. My last recollection of this incident was when I extinguished the red ignition light.

When I regained consciousness the vehicle was on the road, facing LEQUITE, and was in running order. Immediately I drove the vehicle to the main car park outside Headquarters, and returned to my billet.

I reported the incident to Major HEGGIE at about 1500 hrs on 15th May 1944 and later to B.C.M.S. ROBERTSON.

Obediently I submit this report having read the above and believe it to be a true report.
