(a) FOOTBALL. Standard - Professional, or first class amateur club player.

Details - Age, pre war club, position played.

(b) RUGBY. Rugby League or Union standard First class or county club.

Details - Age, pre war club, position played.

(c) CRICKET. Standard - Good class club or higher.
Details - Clubs played for and specialist ability e.g. fast bowler, wicket keeper, opening bat, etc.

(d) HOCKEY. Standard - Good club or higher.
Details - Age, pre war club or Army qualifications, position played.

(e) BOXING. Amateur or professional, standard required for amateur, A.B.A. intermediate or open class. Army divisional or District champion. Details required. If amateur, weight, pre war club and standard. If professional, weight, whether novice 2nd, or championship contender.

2. OFFICIALS. The roll will also include the names and qualifications of referees, judges, and umpires in all the above spheres of activity.

3. This will be treated as urgent by all units and returns submitted to Senior Welfare Officers, Rome Allied Area Command by 7th October 1944.
