7. If any of the above named personnel is now committed to Prison or Detention Barracks to serve a sentence, this authority in his respect is to be considered as inoperative, and this HQ should be informed of the circumstances immediately.

NOTE: Attention is drawn to GEO 456/44. Personnel affected by this GEO will NOT be despatched to No. 3 Transit Camp, or 4 Reception Camp.

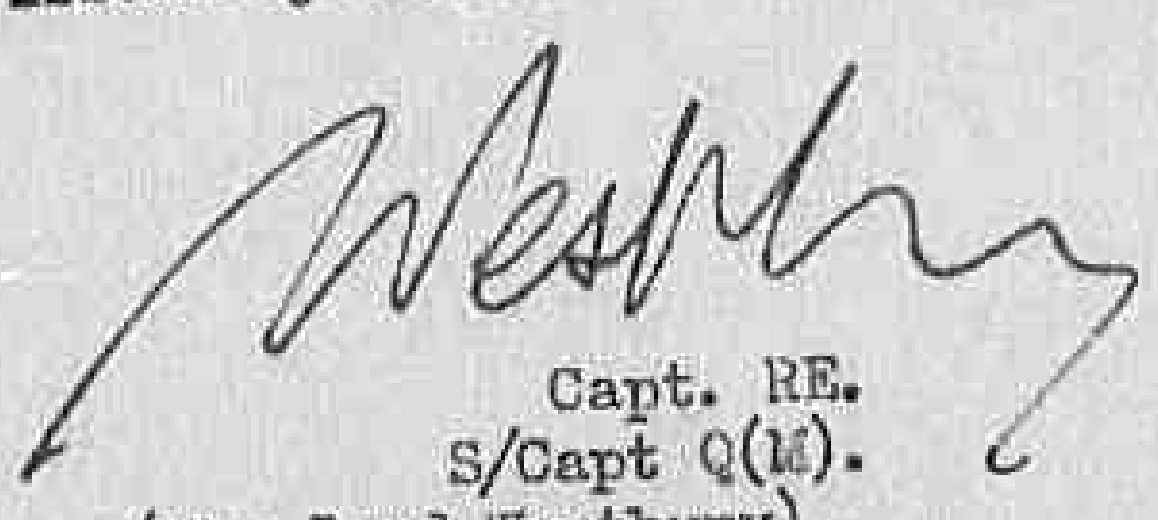

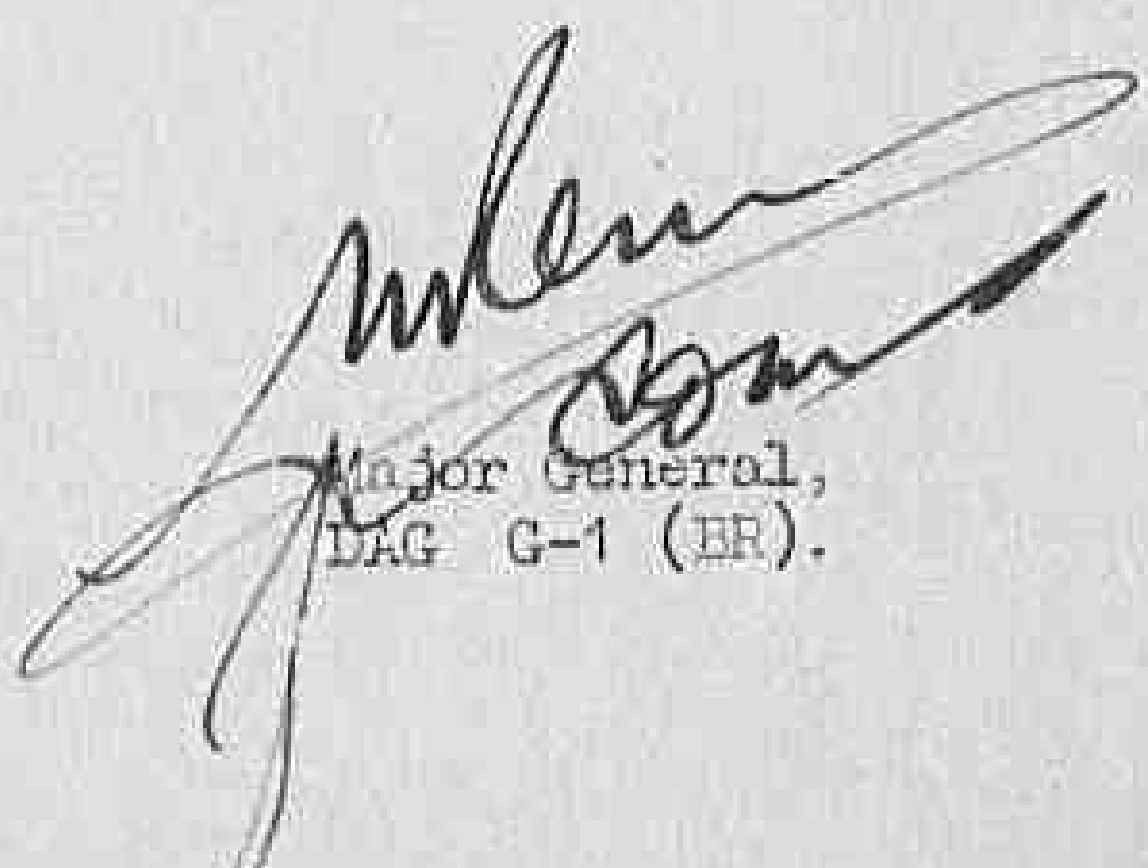

## EXTRACT FROM ADMINISTRATION INSTRUCTION FOR LIAP

### 1. ASSEMBLY.

Personnel proceeding on leave will, before entrainment, be organized into drafts of not more than 100, and officers detailed to conduct the draft.

Officers i/c drafts will be responsible for discipline and for ensuring compliance with movement instructions, ect.

They will remain in charge until released from responsibility by OC NAPLES Transit Camp, or OC Troops on the ship or by superior authority on arrival in UK.

### 2. DRESS AND KIT.

All ranks will travel in FSMO less arms, ammunition and respirator which will be left with the despatching unit. Two blankets will be carried one of which will be withdrawn in the NAPLES Transit Camp and reissued on return. No baggage other than that which can be carried by the owner will be taken on board ship. Very limited left luggage accommodation will be available at the NAPLES Transit Camp where officers may leave camp kit (which will be required until embarkation) at their own risk.

No issues of clothing can be made at the NAPLES Transit Camp.

### 3. RATIONS.

Units will issue sufficient rations for the journey to railhead, or in the case of units outside ITALY, for the journey to first embarkation.

Under no circumstances will rations be taken on board ship.

### 4. DOCUMENTATION.

The following documents will be prepared by OC unit for each officer and other rank.

(a) AF W5133, or manuscript copy in lieu. If the latter, the following particulars are required: -

(i) Army number.

(ii) Rank.

(iii) Named initials.

(iv) Post or Corps (if RA state Branch)

### 3. RATIONS.

### 4. DOCUMENTATION.

The AF W5133 or manuscript form in lieu, will be handed to each officer and man prior to leaving the unit.

(b) A nominal roll signed by a Medical Officer, certifying that all personnel proceeding to port of embarkation are free from infection.

OSC units will ensure that the grant of 28 day's leave in UK is entered in AEs 439 (officers) and ABs 64, Part I (other ranks).

### 5. FFI INSPECTIONS.

All personnel proceeding on leave will be medically inspected in accordance with para 1168, KRs 1940,

(a) Not more than 24 hrs prior to leaving their units.



(b) Immediately prior to embarkation.

6. PAY.

(a) Prior to Embarkation.

- (i) ORs will be given 2 weeks advance of pay before leaving their unit. Special arrangements have been made for further advances of pay on arrival in UK. (See para (b) (i) below).
- (ii) All ranks should be warned that no lire can be taken to UK and that under the Defence (Finance) Regulations no person may take into the UK more than L.10 sterling. Amounts in excess of L.10 sterling (4,000 lire) must be surrendered to the Paymaster effecting exchanges at the Transit Camp at Port of embarkation, in accordance with para (iii) below, for subsequent remittance to the individual's account in the UK. Individual's who already hold excess amounts over 4,000 lire and who wish to have use of this money in UK are particularly warned to hand it to the Paymaster at the Transit Camp as above and NOT to their own unit Imprest holder.

(iii) Exchanges of currency will be effected in bulk with the Paymaster at the Transit Camp before embarkation.

Officers i/c drafts will collect all lire from personnel on their draft.

(e) Arrangements in UK.

(i) Special arrangements have been made by the War Office for other ranks to be paid an advance of 14 days' pay (net rate) and ration allowance at the Dispersal Centre on disembarkation. A further payment of 14 days net pay and ration allowance will reach the soldier by the 15th day of this leave. Soldiers should be instructed to notify the Paymaster at the Dispersal Centre in UK whether they require the whole or part of their credit balances remitted to their leave address. Regimental Paymasters will remit these credits to the soldier immediately on receipt of the necessary notification.

(ii) Officers not in possession of cheque books should apply to their bankers as soon as possible after disembarkation. Field Advances cannot normally be obtained in UK.

8. IDENTIFICATION.

Officers will carry their AB 439 and their identity document or card. They are NOT, however, required to carry two extra photographs.

Other ranks will carry their AB64, Parts I and II. **1029**

9. POSTAL AND SECURITY.

When a man is detailed for leave he may notify this fact to the UK. He will not mention the date or approximate date of embarkation or arrival.

10. CENSORSHIP.

No mail or parcels will be carried by personnel, except under the conditions laid down by the Appendix to GRO 99/44.

A base Censor will be available at the Transit Camp.

Infraction of these regulations may result in cancellation of leave in addition to normal disciplinary action.

11. ALCOHOL

No alcohol will be carried. Any man who becomes drunk will be returned to his unit and his leave will be cancelled.

12. V.D.

Any man found to be suffering from VD will be returned to his unit and his leave will be cancelled. RMOs will, however, comply with AFHQ MAF 37 Serial 4 1944 except that AF 11247 will be retained by the unit.

16. ARRANGEMENTS, IN UK.

Men will be told by their COs before despatch AND by the OG Transit Camp that they will have to go to dispersal centres behind the ports for the issue of ration cards, warrants, etc. This is necessary and quieter in the long run, and they will have 23 days at home.

17. NAPLES TRANSIT CAMP.

For the purpose of administration it will be necessary for men to be confined to camp for 48 hrs before embarkation.

18. ABSENCE IN UK.

Any man who absents himself in the UK will, on arrest, be returned to CMF/ENAF for disciplinary action. He may be charged with desertion.

If a man fails to return with his leave party he will count against his unit's leave quota until he disembarks in ITALY/NORTH AFRICA, unless it is established that his absence is unavoidable (e.g. due to sickness).

If there is an appreciable number of absentees the whole scheme may have to be cancelled.

23. DISPERSAL ON RETURN TO CMF.

Men will be returned to their units by the most direct means possible after disembarkation.

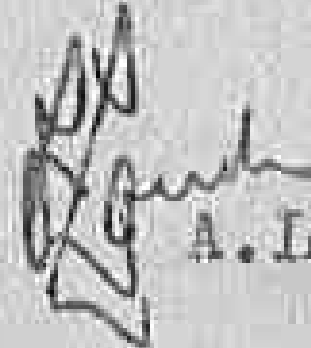

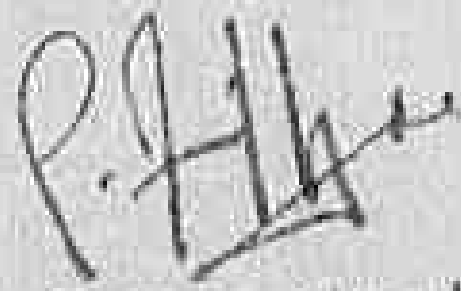
