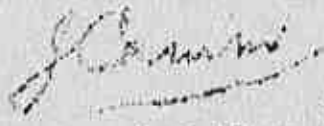

The following information on the above subject has been received from FLAMEO via No. 2 District under the reference 15/LAB dated 12th March 1944.

1. It has been confirmed that all civilians employed by the Allied Forces are covered in respect of injuries or death sustained through enemy action while at work, and that compensation will be paid to them or their dependants in accordance with the scale laid down under the Italian Workmen's Compensation Act.

2. It is difficult to give more details of the compensation payable, as the Act covering such compensations is a very voluminous document. Civilians may be advised that the same compensation will be payable as that granted under the Italian Workmen's Compensation Act for ordinary accidents at work. Detailed information can be obtained by them at the branch office of the Istituto Nazionale per l'Assicurazione contro gli Infortuni Lavoro.

As soon as information is to hand a copy of a list showing locations of the branches of the Istituto will be forwarded.

Attention is directed to G.R.O. 664 of 1943 dealing with Injuries to Civilian Employees.
