In reference to ~~the~~ the above quoted letter and in respect of this Ministry's letter 6/2003/2445 dated 22nd. March 1945, we notify that, of the 5 Field Baths received from Naples and at present stored at No. 1 Repair Unit, two (265 and 338) have been drawn, completed with all parts previously missing, for issuing to H.Q. ~~210~~ Division.

231

It has not yet been possible, however, to arrange for the dispatch of the above mentioned two field baths to H.Q. ~~210~~ Division because of the fact that the baths were found to be somewhat defective upon testing because of the poor condition of many of their fittings and therefore requiring a careful thorough overhaul.

The firm of Ranieri, Rome, specialist in this kind of work have been instructed to carry out a ~~speedy~~ speedy check on the two baths in question, which will be dispatched to their destination as soon as they are ready.

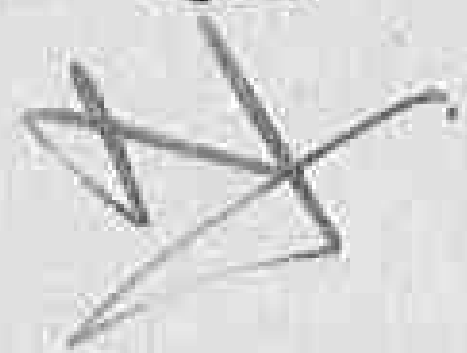

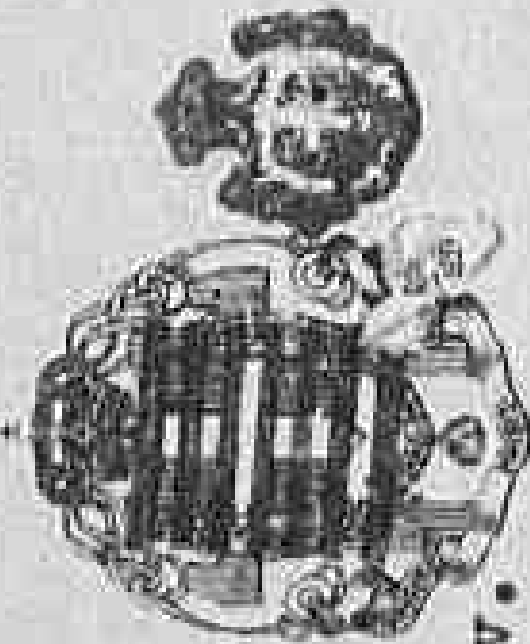

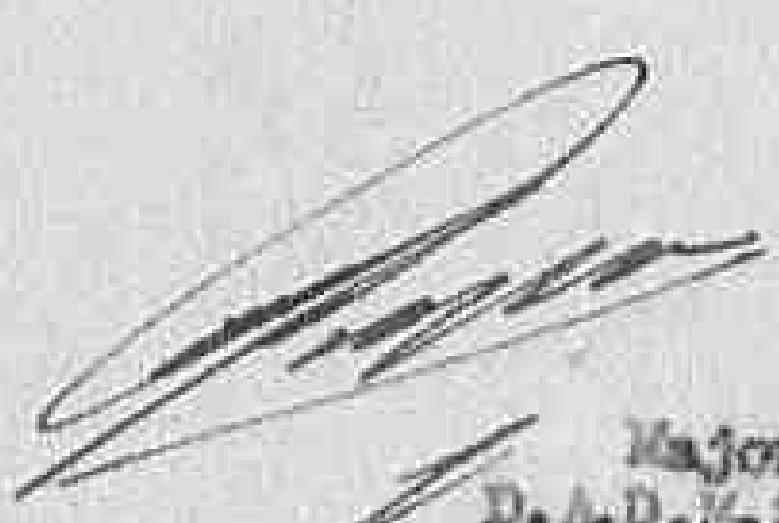

The present Senior Medical Officer of the FRIULI Group is a young and inexperienced Captain. Recent inspections of this unit both from hygiene aspects and medical operational aspects indicate that this officer is unsuited to the position of Director.

The hygiene of the division is bad and little has been done by the Director to improve it. During a recent exercise in which the medical units took part, the siting of medical installations was carried out without reference to the Director who had to go out to ascertain where they had been placed. By reason of his rank he had no authority over the other medical officers of his formations. It is doubtful that even with higher rank this officer would have the personality to get things done.

The medical services of this formation are in URGENT need of a strong and active Director.

The War Establishment of an Italian Combat Group NA/523/1 shows two officers of the Medical Services on the Divisional HQ staff - one a Lieut-Colonel or Major and a Staff Officer, a Captain or Subaltern.

In view of the urgent requirements of this formation from the medical aspect and the weakness of its present administration, it is strongly recommended that the present Officer - Captain D'ANGELO be replaced at a very early date and that the War Establishment of a Senior Officer and a Staff Captain - both with Battle and Administrative experience be implemented as soon as possible.
