4. The future 'target figure' for the "Iti-Iti" Central Depot of Medical Stores should equal three times that Depot's average monthly issue rate. To maintain that figure, two months stock is to be held in the Depot and one month on demand.

1. The attached monthly maintenance indent No. L. 4130/9 for the Italian Armed Forces is forwarded and recommended for supply during April, 1945.

2. It is requested that the stores be addressed to:

* ICI - ICI - MARINE.

3. To allow for an interval of 5 months between the production of indents and the receipt of stores, and for the maintenance of a 30 day working margin, L.M.I.A. has been instructed to to indent monthly that the sum of the stocks in the Central Italian Depot and the amounts on order are brought to six times one average month's issues.

Build up will not be at a greater rate than 1 day in 2.

Indents for supply from U.S. are, of course, adjusted according to availability of captured stocks.

It is anticipated that, as the expansion of the Italian army proceeds, and as captured stores, requisitioned by the Italian army, become exhausted, demands on U.S. will increase, but this will be offset to some extent by the gradual restoration of the Italian pharmaceutical industry.

2. It is requested that the stores be addressed to:

"IMI - III" ROOMS.

3. To allow for an interval of 5 months between the production of indents and the receipt of stores, and for the maintenance of a 30 day working margin, M.M.I.A. has been instructed so to indent monthly that the sum of the stores in the Central Italian Depot and the amounts on order are brought to six times the average monthly issues. Build up will not be at a greater rate than 1 day in 2.

Indents for supply from U.S. are, of course, adjusted according to availability of captured stocks.

Reference the attached undated indent for the supply of Medical Equipment from the U.K. to the Italian Armed Forces for the month of November 1944, forwarded to this office through the D.M.S., H.Q., A.A.I.

Your attention is directed to the instructions issued under this office letter M. 4130 dated 3 May, 44, regarding the compiling of indents.

Column 3 of A.F. I. 1209 must show 'Stock on hand plus dues in', the heading of the column must also be amended.

The quantities demanded in column 5 do not compare with the 'average monthly issues' in column 4, i.e.,

Item No. 1 - 'Stock plus dues in'	=	80 lbs.
'Average monthly issue'	=	4.3 lbs.
'Number or quantity required'	=	20 lbs.

The stock to be held should be one month's maintenance, the amount on demand "Dues in" should be for a period of three months only.

It would appear that many of the items demanded are not required in view of the large quantities shown as 'stock on hand plus dues in'.

Items on the indent numbered as follows must be omitted, as these are not being supplied by the War Office :-

13, 49, 70, 100, 101, 102, 93 and 94.

Plaster of Paris is put up in 1 cwt. drums, the A.F. I. 1248 must be strictly adhered to when future indents are submitted.

Will you please submit an amended indent direct to this office for such items within A.F. I. 1248 scales, that are required for maintenance of the Italian Armed Forces during the month of November 1944.
