The return of the medical officers (regular army) in ~~all~~ the medical establishments of all the Military Terr. Commands shows the following deficiencies in relation with the W/Es:

Said shortage is attributed to the great number of officers not re-employable through being punished after screening and to the unavailability of many others who are physically unfit.

This Ministry has evened out ~~in~~ the above stated deficiencies with temporary medical subalterns and a few senior officers of the reserve: for the units of the Bolzano Military Territorial Command further assignments of newly appointed officers ~~are~~ being made.

Major difficulties are met to assure the services of specialists, as Regular Army specialists cannot be replaced with newly appointed subalterns who do not possess titles and experience;;at the moment the Military Territorial Commands are using the services of civilian practitioners.

The return will suffer further reductions with the discharge of other regular army medical officers, ~~be~~ who have been screened and discharged but held temporarily due to the urgent requirements of their services. -

SUBJECT : Medical Service at CAPs

The policy of increased strictness in physical sorting of yearly recruits will further improve health conditions at CAPs.

On account of this fact, it doesn't appear necessary for the moment to increase WB strength of such service, bearing also in mind that Territorial Military Hqs and GAR Hqs never laid forth any special needs as regards this service.

In the case of exceptional needs GAR Hqs will have certainly taken measures strengthening the Service's personnel with some other elements belonging to dependent units.

It will nevertheless be this Ss's care to scrutinize the problem and do away with the trouble complained about improving the training standard of personnel allotted to the service (HCOs and hospital orderlies).

The DADMS of this HQ recently visited nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 Territorial Commands.

From his report it appears that there are deficiencies in Medical Staff in certain places as follows:-

GENOA Deficient of 8 Field Officers and 7 Capts, these include many specialists.

TURIN Deficient of 6 Regular Officers.

MILAN On the strength 34 Officers. Unfit for duty or on sick leave 9. Absent on temporary duty 7. On duty with District 5. Awaiting discharge 8.

BOLZANO Deficient of 14 Officers.

From the above figures it appears that there is a serious deficiency. Will you please inform this Headquarters what the overall position is, regarding deficiencies in Medical Staff throughout the Territorial Commands.

I visited the a/m Hospital on 23 July. It is clean and appears to be efficiently and conscientiously run, although, as it is at present the only Red Cross Hospital for the treatment of returning P.O.W. in Eastern Sicily, it is overcrowded especially in the T.B. wards.

The premises, which are admirable, are normally used as a Training College for priests and I understand that considerable pressure is being applied to the Ministry of War by the Principals to recover the premises for their original purpose.

I think that it would be most unfortunate for the Italian Red Cross if this building were to be given up as no other suitable premises for a hospital could be found.

The Principals of the College have regained possession of one large room which the Hospital in the past used as a theatre (holding 200 - 300 persons) on the pretext that they only wished to use it for a very short period and now their refusal to give it back robs the Hospital patients of a very excellent Welfare facility.

I would recommend that the Ministry of War be asked

- i) To permit the continued occupation of the premises by the C.R.I.
- ii) To apply pressure on the Principals of the College to hand over the part of the premises previously used by the Hospital for Welfare purposes

I think that it would be most unfortunate for the Italian Red Cross if this building were to be given up as no other suitable premises for a hospital could be found.

I was recently informed that mattresses and other clothes, property of the Hospital, were transferred to another place and that, owing to a breakage of water-pipes, several rooms of the Officers quarters were flooded. Some days ago, on the authorization of a British IGO and a female interpreter( see enclosed report) an engine was taken away.
5. I would be very grateful to your HQ if you could draw the attention of the competent authorities to these inconveniences and submit to them the proposal, already made by me, to hand over the Hospital to the Italian Military Authorities, keeping reserved for the Allies exigencies the infection ward, which is isolated and independent.
6. It would then be possible for us to watch over such a complicated organization, on which we have to count for the future.

Regarding the report made by the 11st B.L.U. Commander during his inspection of Palermo Main Mil. Hospital, we would inform you.

- a) Difficiency of men has been overcome by using recruits;
- b) The difficulties caused by the insufficient supply of coal has been fully explained to your Ministry in letter 3742/03 dated 27/6/46. We would add that the large kitchen steam copper is not being used at present because it is in need of repair, a list of repairs is being drawn up.

Moreover the TERMO kitchen "DALL ORTO" belonging to the a/m hospital is burning wood, and is causing a lot of unnecessary smoke.

This kitchen also requires repair, (Plan is being drawn up).

Coal required for the secondary hospital at MESSINA which is being repaired may be limited to (3) TONS;

- c) The 11th B.L.U. Commander has verbally explained that for the lack of "mosquito nets" he meant the lack of Wire Mesh at the windows. In fact part of the Palermo Hospital windows and all the MESSINA Hospital windows lack this protection. Engineer Departments will be approached to purchase the a/m material, providing the competent ministry finances the purchase;
- d) Neither of the (2) hospitals are supplied with Mosquito Nets (BED);
- e) Light tasks for bed ridden patients are being organised;

f) Neither of the hospitals have a specialised ward for rehabilitation of wounded when necessary after surgical treatment, patients are transferred to other specialised hospital Centres.

It is thought that the isolation wing might be sufficient for present requirements.

The Italian Army is very short of hospital accommodation in the Milan area, and if part of the RAGGIO hospital can be released it will be very much appreciated.
