NEW LEAVE REGULATIONS AS FOLLOWS WILL BE INTRODUCED WEF 1 JULY 46. FOR THIS PURPOSE CMT DIVIDED INTO 2 PARTS (A) AUSTRIA AND NORTH ITALY WHICH INCLUDES XIII CORPS AND 217 AREA 59 AREA AND 211 SUB AREA OF 3 DISTRICT. SOUTH ITALY WHICH WILL BE RAAC AND 3 DISTRICT LESS 217 AREA 59 AREA AND 211 SUB AREA.

1. LEAVE TO U. AUSTRIA AND NORTH ITALY. 38 DAYS PRIVILEGE LEAVE ANNUALLY TO BE TAKEN IN TWO PERIODS OF 19 DAYS EACH. ONLY 2 PERIODS OF PRIVILEGE LEAVE WILL BE GRANTED IN 12 MONTHS.

ELIGIBILITY 4 MONTHS CONTINUOUS SERVICE OVERSEAS OR 4 MONTHS FROM DATE RETURNED FROM LAST PRIVILEGE LEAVE OR LIAP AND 6 WEEKS USEFUL SERVICE OVERSEAS TO GIVE FROM DATE OF RETURN. SOUTH ITALY AND ATNA.

1 LIAP ONLY OF 30 DAYS DURING THE OVERSEAS TOUR. ELIGIBILITY 456212

MONTHS CONTINUOUS SERVICE OVERSEAS AND NOT LESS THAN 4 MONTHS USEFUL SERVICE OVERSEAS TO GIVE FROM DATE OF RETURN.

2. LEAVE IN LIEU OF LIAP AND PRIVILEGE LEAVE MAY BE TAKEN

IN COUNTRIES OTHER THAN U. FROM DATE OF RETURN.

1. LEAVE TO UK. AUSTRIA AND NORTH ITALY. 30 DAYS
LEAVE ANNUALLY TO BE TAKEN IN TWO PERIODS OF 15 DAYS EACH. ONLY 2
PERIODS OF PRIVILEGE LEAVE WILL BE GRANTED IN 12 MONTHS.
ELIGIBILITY 4 MONTHS CONTINUOUS SERVICE OVERSEAS OR 4 MONTHS FROM
DATE RETURNED FROM LAST PRIVILEGE LEAVE OR LIAP AND 6 WEEKS USEFUL
SERVICE OVERSEAS TO GIVE FROM DATE OF RETURN. SOUTH ITALY AND AUSTRIA
1 LIAP ONLY OF 30 DAYS DURING THE OVERSEAS TOUR. ELIGIBILITY 450212
MONTHS CONTINUOUS SERVICE OVERSEAS AND NOT LESS THAN 4 MONTHS
USEFUL SERVICE OVERSEAS TO GIVE FROM DATE OF RETURN.
2. LEAVE IN LIEU OF LIAP AND PRIVILEGE LEAVE MAY BE TAKEN
IN COUNTRIES OTHER THAN UK. FREE TRAVEL ADMISSIBLE WITHIN THE COST
OF RETURN FARE TO UK FROM OVERSEAS COUNTRIES CONCERNED.
3. DISSEMINATION LEAVE APPLICABLE TO THE WHOLE OF CUP ON
SLIDING SCALE. FOR PERSONNEL WITH MORE THAN 12 MONTHS OVERSEAS
SERVICE. 28 DAYS DISSEMINATION LEAVE WHERE 29 DAYS LEAVE OR LESS
HAS BEEN TAKEN IN UK DURING OVERSEAS TOUR. 21 DAYS DISSEMINATION
LEAVE WHERE BETWEEN 30 DAYS AND 59 DAYS LEAVE HAS BEEN TAKEN IN UK.
14 DAYS DISSEMINATION LEAVE WHERE OVER 59 DAYS LEAVE HAS BEEN
TAKEN IN UK. WHERE AN INDIVIDUAL HAS BEEN OVERSEAS FOR LESS THAN
12 MONTHS 14 DAYS DISSEMINATION LEAVE ONLY. WILL BE ADMISSIBLE EX-
PYTHON

PERSONNEL WHO ARE POSTED OVERSEAS TO BAOR FRANCE OR COME AGAIN IMMEDIATELY WILL BE GRANTED A TOTAL OF 42 DAYS LEAVE IN UK. THIS TOTAL COVERS BOTH EMBARKATION AND DISEMBARKATION LEAVE.
