1. It is regretted that the certificate is not available.
2. According to PWIB ME Records, DAREVSKY, when captured at TEGIESAN on 31 Mar 41, was suffering from a Gun-Shot Wound in left eye, and was admitted immediately to 14 Combined General Hospital, where the eye was removed. DAREVSKY was interned in 14 Combined General Hospital until 19 Jun 41, when he was discharged to HAIYA Camp. DAREVSKY was admitted to 16 (B) General Hospital on 29 Aug 41 for five days, whilst awaiting transfer to INDIA. He was transferred to India on 10 Sep 41 and repatriated to ITALY on 23 Jul 46.

Was repatriated from camp no.10 on the 13.7.1946.

He was buried at sea at 5 hrs on the 12.6.1946.

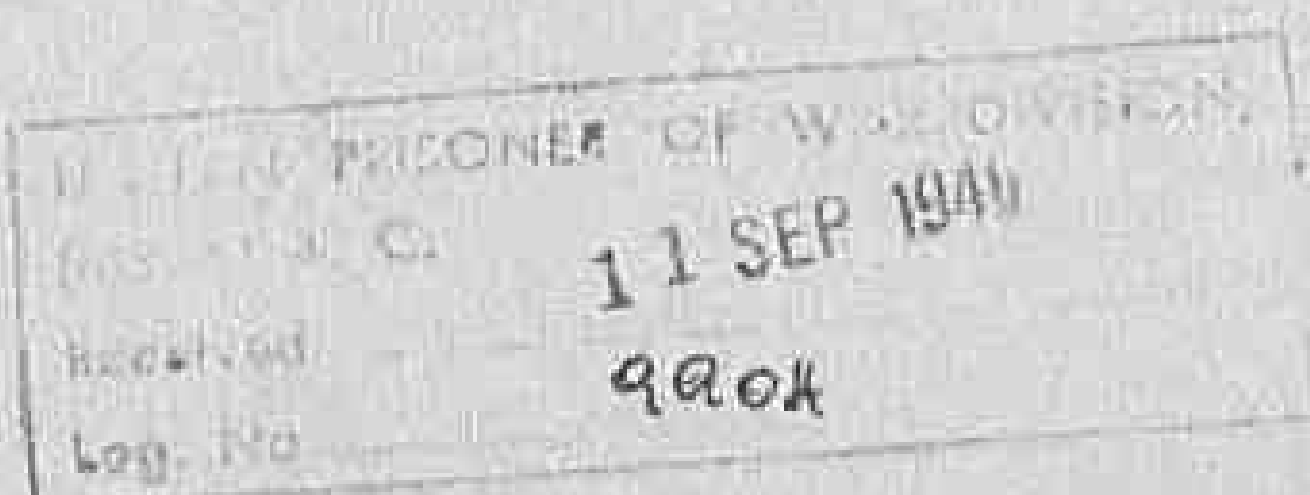

1. The General Directorate of the medical Corps, Ministry of War has not in its records the Field Hospital 257 and cannot give information regarding it.
2. S.M.R.E. informs that also on the date mentioned (October 1945) the Field Hospital 257 did not exist and therefore we do not know the mobilisation Centre to which the eventual documents could have been sent after the disbandment of the unit.
3. The military position of the Capt. Brocchi Aldo (who is assumed by the family to be a Capt. Arty., reserve) is not clear. In the records of the General Directorate of the Personnel (Officers) does not exist the Capt. Brocchi Aldo.
4. In the same time when the message arrived to the family of Capt. Brocchi, another like message was consigned by the same person to another family of an officer once prisoner in Germany.

Since also this family has not received any more news of their relative, we doubt of the authenticity of the a/m messages and of the sincerity of person who brought the news. This is also the opinion of the relatives of the relatives of Capt. Brocchi.

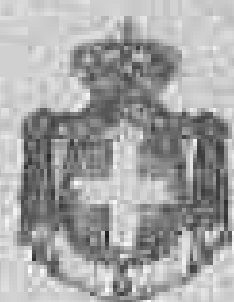

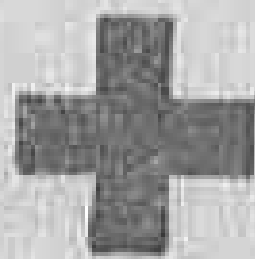

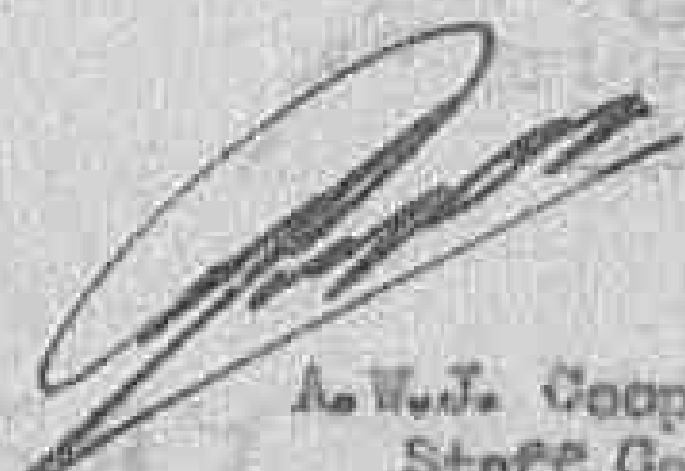

1. Attached is a translation of a letter received from Medical Directorate, Ministry of War and represents certain difficulties which have arisen due to the increased hospitalization of Italian casualties in ALLIED hospitals.
2. It is suggested that an extra copy of the casualty form AF W 3014 in respect of Italian casualties should be forwarded by British medical units to the Groups (for combat troops) or Admin. Div. (for US-ITL or MILIT service troops) concerned.
3. The record possesses a copy of AF W 3014 and the original AF W 3148 and I 1283 should continue to be sent to this office for onward transmission to Ministry of War.
4. The hospital cover for all categories of Italian troops in 8th Army area is approximately 35% and with the arrival of 470, 522 and 575 Provisional Hospitals a similar cover will be provided for all categories of Italian troops in 5th Army area (this includes EPL-ITL hospital accommodation in Florence and Lucca but does not include the "divisional" medical units of the Groups).
5. As the hospital cover provided by Italian units is now fairly adequate the necessary, as a general rule, no longer exists for hospitalization in British units and as far as is practical it is considered that Italian casualties should be evacuated through Italian medical units. Assistance from Allied ambulance cars would be necessary.
6. The suggestion in para 4 is made without any knowledge of local conditions and is put forward for your consideration as a possible measure.

3. For record purposes a copy of AF W 3034, and the original AF W 3048 and I 422) should continue to be sent to this office for onward transmission to Ministry of War.

4. The hospital cover for all categories of Italian troops in 5th Army area is approximately 35% and with the arrival of 470, 522 and 576 Division hospitals a smaller cover will be provided for all categories of Italian troops in 5th Army area (this includes IFF-III hospital accommodation in Florence and Isona but does not include the "divisional" medical units of the Group).

5. As the hospital cover provided by Italian units is now fairly adequate the necessity, as a general rule, no longer exists for hospitalization in British units and as far as is practical it is considered that Italian casualties should be evacuated through Italian medical units. Assistance from Allied ambulance cars would be necessary.

6. The suggestion in para 4. is made without any knowledge of local conditions and is put forward for your consideration as a partial remedy to the difficulties stated in Ministry of War letter.

Subject: Italian Military Personnel admitted to Allied Military Hospitals.

1. Many sick or wounded soldiers from Combat Groups or Italian Divisions in the rear of operational Allied armies, are being admitted to Allied Military Hospitals.
2. Some of these casualties are later evacuated to other Allied medical units without notification thereof to the units to which such personnel belong.
3. On other occasions Italian military personnel in need of protected care are evacuated from Allied hospitals to Italian Territorial hospitals without notification thereof to the respective parent organizations.

This procedure has led to difficulties of an administrative and disciplinary nature, since Italian Commands are not able to trace their men from the time they are evacuated, because of sickness or wounds, from the battle lines.

Accordingly, may we request you to issue instructions to the Directors of Allied medical units accommodating Italian military personnel, to notify as soon as possible, in writing, the Command of the unit to which the soldier belongs, both at the time he is hospitalized and at the time he is discharged because of recovery or because of evacuation to other medical units.
