7. MEDICAL MATTER. It is proposed to establish at Bitonto (Bari) a central medical stores for supply to 3th Corps Area, 31st Corps (Calabria) and troops with Allied 8th Army.

All drugs at present held in the depots of the above mentioned areas, will be centralized and stored at Bitonto (Bari).

8. Malaria. Malaria service is regular.

Removal of patients arrived at Taranto on the Hospital Ship, has been carried out together with a hospital train and an Allied ambulance section.

9. TYPHUS. The typhus epidemic at TARANTO is practically over; also amongst the civilian population.

A few cases still exist in GALLIPOLI. None have been signalled amongst the Italian Forces, after 20 Feb. Instructions for the despatch of T.A.S. and U.S. vaccines to the various Corps, for inoculation (primary and maintenance) has been issued.

10. GENERAL. Due to lack of accommodation, there is a shortage of beds in Caserta. Sufficient equipment is available for a further 500, or 600 beds.

It is suggested that 61 Motor Ambulance Section, with 20 Ambulance Cars, be brought from Carlinia as soon as possible, to relieve the problem of medical transport.

Italian G.S. are arranging for troops in Carlinia to be moved to areas of low malarial incidence.

The position of medical supplies is our greatest worry, as we have responsibility for forward to H.A. 1.4. 20 stores are at present held of, supplies, collection, supply (despatch and delivery). Nowing in mind the possibility of the need for an anti-aircraft supplies, it is most urgent that we should maintain stores and adequate supplies of basic drugs, stores, drugs and gases etc., and suitable quantities of quinine salts and plasmas. Nearly all the drug industry is in Germany Italy and therefore inaccessible.

In the medical there are 53 stores, of which, only 70 are available. In Tunisia there are 40, of which, only 70 are available.

There are medical stores at Bari and in Italy belonging to the Italian Air Corps, but these have been requisitioned by the Allies.

Supplies submitted by the Ministry of War for the supply of other stores have so far been unsuccessful. The situation at present regarding medical transport is such, as to make it extremely difficult to carry out this service, and certainly an almost impossible over-burdening of the already scanty means available.

In some cases of port evacuation, it has been possible to collect the aid of the allied medical units. In this matter we should point out that evacuation would be made much easier if Italian ships carrying on H.A. 1.4. looked at Bari or Brindisi instead of Taranto.

9. HYGIENE.
The hygiene situation of our troops is not, on the whole, satisfactory. This Department has done, and will continue to do, everything within its means to improve it, endeavoring to better organize supervision on the part of Hygiene and Medical Officers of Units. Nevertheless, the problem is still greatly a matter of materials and is well known to the M.H.I. As requisitioning, by the Allies, of most of the best equipped barracks, which has forced our troops to fall back on improvisation.

In ALGERIA, 20 cases of typhus have so far been reported among Italian troops, of which, two were fatal. A new and important typhus epidemic has been reported among the troops of the "Cardinali" Division in MONTENEGRO. Inoculation of all Italian troops in Germany is now in progress with the aid of the Allies and will soon commence for the troops in Montenegro.

The malarial problem, especially in Sardinia, is also a great source of worry, as also is the problem of venereal disease, leading in mind the scarcity of medicines.

10. GENERAL.
The most important problems are those already put forward: lack of means of transport, which could be solved by the issue of an adequate number of motor ambulances in a reasonable condition. Further, the authority to use our Hospital Train would be of great value on the Berardo - hard line, coinciding with the arrival of hospital ships.

Hospital accommodation is sufficient to cover present requirements though equipment is insufficient in many hospitals and dissemination of accommodation a great drawback. This dissemination is due to Allied requisitioning (4000 beds on the hard line). This dissemination of hospital accommodation also increases transport difficulties. As far as medical supplies are concerned, it is hoped that in the near future, replenishment from Allied sources will become regular and adequate. As regards men and vaccines (with the exception of anti-typhus vaccine), requirements could be shortly met from National sources by the Instituto Siero-Tossino of Naples. No effort will be spared to facilitate the re-equipment of the Italian Chemical Industry of which, unfortunately, there is very little in liberated Italy.

The hospital situation in Casperia has improved considerably following the opening of a military hospital at Villa Ramon (300 beds) and the assignment of it a hospital train weekly to move the sick and wounded soldiers from Casperia to Agaña. However there is still a marked deficiency of bed spaces in the III Army Corps (Abilly 4) and the materials and equipment of 404 Army Hospital which were to be used on the island, have been requisitioned by the French authorities of Casperia.

7. MEDICAL DEPOTS. Large quantities of medicines and medical stores have been received from No 4 British Depot and have been taken on charge by the Medical Depot of Bitonto (Bard). This material is Italian material captured by the Allies before the Armistice.

8. M.A.C. 3 British Motor Ambulances have gone into service at NEPLIS to cover requirements of Armed Forces Campania.

9. HYGIENE Some cases of small pox among the civilian population + none among the Italian military - have been reported at Taranto, Triggiano (Bari) and Naples. Delivery of 100,000 doses of calf lymph for the re-vaccination of the troops has been received;

Anti malaria campaign measures are being carried out. Stocks of Italchina and Atebrin have enabled us to start treatment and large quantities of Mepacrine now allotted to us by the Allies will ensure the continuation of treatment.

10. GENERAL Continuous influx of troops from Sardinia has made the situation of hospital availability critical in spite of all efforts made to increase capacity.

In this respect it must be borne in mind that about 6,000 beds in Italian Hospitals have been ceded to the Allies in Campania alone. At present there is an availability of about 85% beds occupied and the remaining 15% is totally inadequate to meet transfers from the combat zone, frequent malaria relapses among the troops returning from Sardinia, and the danger of a greater extension of the epidemics. It would be advisable to transfer some of the long term cases to PUGLIA but the necessary means of transport is lacking. It is requested that

1) The Allies will examine the possibility of increasing the number of beds in Sicily, bearing in mind the present deficiency is 2,000.

7. MEDICAL STORES

Serious difficulties have been met in the storing and transfer to Sardinia of disinfectants etc., assigned to this region.

It is necessary to transfer directly the disinfectants destined for Sardinia from Allied Depot (Torre Annunziata) to the ships which are leaving without having them stay at Italian warehouses, whose capacities are insufficient. The Central Medical Stores Depot of Taranto (Cimino) has started to function.

10. GENERAL ITALIA has given precise orders for a reduction of rations in military hospitals, fixing a limit of 30 days for troops who are not from the combat zone or under direct command of the Allies.

Measures are being studied for the practical realization of these orders, which present great difficulties, owing to the fact that civil hospitals are not sufficiently equipped.

In particular, sick and wounded Italian military coming from Montenegro and the Balkans who are returning from a war full of inconveniences and sacrifices, should also be lodged in military hospitals beyond the 30 day limit, just as the Italian troops who were in the line or who are under direct command of the Allies.

We have received news of the order for the return to Italian Armed Forces of the Italian medical material which was captured in Sicily by the Allies before the Armistice.

We believe that these materials can facilitate the solution of the military medical problems on the island.

If the materials are transferred from Gardinia, it would be necessary to assign the coaches for re-equipping a new hospital train.
