7. ~~Hospital Officer.~~ It is proposed to establish at Trieste (Italy) a central medical stores for supply to 3rd Corps Area, 3rd Corps (Garrison) and troops with Allied 8th Army.

All drugs at present held in the depots of the above mentioned areas, will be centralized and stored at Trieste (Italy).

8. ~~Medical.~~ Medical service in regular.

Removal of patients arrived at Trieste on the Hospital ships, has been carried out together with a hospital train and an Allied ambulance section.

9. ~~Medical.~~ The typhus epidemic at Trieste is practically over; also amongst the civilian population.

A few cases still exist in Genua. None have been signalled amongst the Italian forces, after 20 Feb. Instruction for the supply of Lederle and U.S. vaccine to the various Corps, for inoculation (protection and maintenance) has been issued.

10. ~~Medical.~~ Due to lack of accommodation, there is a shortage of beds in Genua. Insufficient equipment is available for a further 500, or 900 beds.

It is suggested that 61 Motor Ambulance Section, with 20 ambulances cars, be brought from Genoa as soon as possible, to relieve the problem of medical transport.

Italian GHQ are arranging for troops in Genoa to be moved to areas of low material incidence.
