

Subject : T/Os of ITI-ITI Medical Units in Florence, Leghorn and Lucca.

To : Maj R.C. VAN KIRK, MMIA L.O., Fifth Army.

Attached is the Status report of ITI-ITI Medical units, requested by you on April 4 inst.

As far as civilians are concerned (last column of attached report), it is pointed out that :

- the 59 civilians, at Main Military Hospital, Florence, and the 49, at Military Hospitals at Leghorn and Lucca, are still employed because they are technicians and are training military personnel for their task. They will be dismissed shortly.
- the 223 civilians, Military Chemi-Pharmaceutical Institute, Florence, are technicians (in charge of the boilers, chemical and vials sections workshop, etc.) who have also in the past been employed by said Institute and are part of it's T/O.

No rations are issued to civilian personnel.

SUBJECT: Base Reinforcement Depots BR-ITVI  
Function and Duties of British Cadre.

GENERAL

1. The Italian authorities are responsible for supplying reinforcements for all BR-ITVI Service Units through B.R.D.'s in accordance with MMIA letter SD/42 dated 14 Feb 45.

FUNCTION

2. The Function of the British Cadre attached to each B.R.D. is three fold.

- (a) Liaison
- (b) Supervision and advice
- (c) Control

DUTIES OF THE O.C. CADRE

3. Liaison

- (a) Represents the British District Commander. Transmits British orders to the B.R.D. Italian Commander and ensures compliance. Passes to District HQ with his recommendations, requests of the Italian Commander, through generally the Italian Commander will employ normal staff channels i.e. HQ appropriate Adm. Div.
- (b) Is the link with HQ MMIA directly, or through local MMIA LO.
- (c) Keeps close contact with local Movements, District HQ and HQ MMIA, for moves into and out of the camp.

4. Supervision of and advice on:

- (a) Camp organization to meet requirements incl selection of personnel according to their qualifications.
- (b) Documentation as ordered.
- (c) TRG incl liaison with IMT (later C(TRG) MMIA) and supervision of TRG programmes.
- (d) Allocation of rfts.
- (e) Formation of units.
- (f) Discipline.
- (g) Hygiene.
- (h) Welfare.
- (i) Standing Orders.
- (j) Watch weekly strength return to be rendered by Italian Depot Commander.
- (k) Watch strength demands submitted by HQs Adm. Div. and obtain priorities as necessary.

5. Control

- (a) Drafts moving out.
- (b) Personal equipment and clothing.

- (b) Is the link with HQ MMIA directly, or through local MMIA LO.
- (c) Keeps close contact with local Movements, District HQ and HQ MMIA, for moves into and out of the camp.
