1. Having been informed that the Italian War Office is contemplating the withdrawal of the 519 Auxiliary Hospital from Forli, I would like to point out that at the present time this hospital is essential for the care of refugees in UNRRA camps.

2. It is therefore requested that steps be taken to retain this hospital until at least 1 May 1946. It is hoped that by that time sufficient equipment will be available to UNRRA to replace the stores of the present military unit.

3. It is further requested that on the 15th of April we shall be allowed to make a definite statement as to whether or not this Italian Military Unit will be needed after 1 May 1946.
