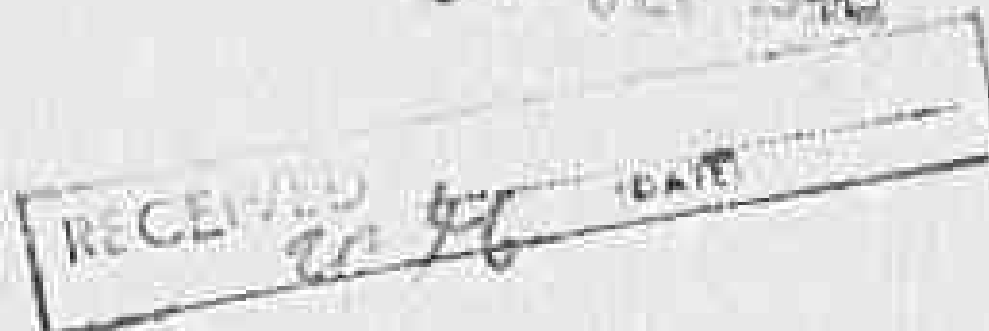

RECOVERY OF ALLIED WAR MATERIALS - AIRCRAFT.

Further to our letter of even reference dated 20th June, 1946 and your Q.120 dated 21st August 1946.

2. Reports received from the M.R.E.S. section confirm that certain firms are still carrying out salvage operations under the direction of the Italian Army and the attached copy of a report submitted by one of the Allied searches gives names of firms and name of the authorising officer.

3. As has already been pointed out these salvage operations considerably hamper the searches in their work and destroy valuable clues in the tracing of missing aircrew personnel. Therefore it would be appreciated if further enquiries could be made at the War Ministry re the names of firms and personnel quoted in the above-mentioned report with a view to their being stopped from moving or salvaging crashed aircraft until the area has been declared clear.

4. It has also been requested by M.R.E.S. that a notice be inserted in local newspapers to the effect that personnel be restricted from removing any material from the scene of accidents or crashes of aircraft and this suggestion has the approval of this Sub-Commission therefore your comments on the above after investigations with the War Ministry would be appreciated.

A visit was made to the organization known as Soccorso Materiale Bellico whose Manager is Francesco Grasta, and the following information was obtained:

- 1) The Italian war Ministry offered the task of clearing all German war material from certain specified areas which contain considerable quantities of this material, to the contractor who agreed to do it the most cheaply.
- 2) In areas where there was little fighting and therefore very little wreckage the task of clearing has been undertaken by local Italian military organizations.
- 3) In the case of the civilian contractors their duty is to recover any war material the whereabouts of which they have been informed, and transport it to certain military dumps which are under the direct control of the Italian Army (Artillery).
- 4) At these dumps the wreckage is categorized, and in certain cases of Allied materials a note must be sent through the Artillery H.Q. to the Allied Control Commission; however Francesco was not certain on this point and the circumstances governing the rendition of such a report are not known.
- 5) A list of civilian contractors and the areas in which they are operating is given in appendix A, together with a list of inspectors with name and rank of the Officer commanding the area.
- 6) The Italian military inspectors, one of whom is attached to each contractor, are responsible for checking the material before it leaves the firm's H.Q. on its way to the military dump. The inspector makes an inventory of the material of the material on a delivery note which he signs and orders the driver to hand it in at the military dump where the material delivered is checked against the delivery note by the H.Q. H.Q. The H.Q. signs the form and returns it to the H.Q. of the firm at Ravenna.
- 7) The inspectors make periodic checks, to ensure that in a specific instance none of the material has been left behind by the firm's employees.
- 8) Controller of the first 4 areas and also area 7 listed in Appendix A together with their contractors, is General Pasquale Arturo of the Italian Artillery. Controllers for Rome and Florence are not known. Controller of areas 8, 9, 10, 11, is Gen. Postaghe.
- 9) The contractors gain their information as to the whereabouts of all types of war material, from all sources, but say that their best information are small boys.
- 10) Although Francesco states he has finished the Province of Ravenna and is ready to move down to Bologna Province, he has so far only recovered 2 A/C wrecks from

- 5) In the case of the civilian contractors, those who are to transport the material the whereabouts, of which they have been informed, are transported to certain military dumps which are under the direct control of the Italian Army (Artillery).
- 6) At these dumps the wreckage is categorized, and in certain cases of Allied materials a note must be sent through the Artillery H.Q. to the Allied Control Commission; however Francoschi was not certain on this point and the circumstances surrounding the rendition of such a report are not known.
- 7) A list of civilian contractors and the areas in which they are operating is given in Appendix A, together with a list of inspectors with names and rank of the Officer commanding the area.
- 8) The Italian military inspectors, one of whom is attached to each contractor, are responsible for checking the material before it leaves the firm's H.Q. on its way to the military dumps. The inspector makes an inventory of the material of the material on a delivery note which he signs and orders the driver to hand it in at the military dump where the material delivered is checked against the delivery note by the W/O I/c. The W/O signs the form and returns it to the H.Q. of the firm at Rovigo.
- 9) The inspectors make periodic checks, to ensure that in a specific instance none of the material has been left behind by the firm's employees.
- 10) Controller of the first 4 areas and also area 7 listed in Appendix A together with their contractors, is General Pasquale Arzuffi of the Italian Artillery. Controllers for areas 8, 9, 10, 11, is Gen Rostagno.
- 11) The contractors gain their information as to the whereabouts of all types of War Material, from all sources, but say that their best informants are small boys.
- 12) Although Francoschi states he has finished the Province of Rovigo and is ready to move down to Bergamo Province, he has so far only removed 2 1/2 trucks from the Rovigo Province.
- 13) One of these was at Canaro and the other at San. 63, 112, San. 65. The latter was the wreckage of a Mustang P.3. 600 flown by Lt. Muir who was buried locally and concentrated to Rimini.
- 14) In the case of the two engines at Canaro referred to in S.S.F. / 087/11. it is definitely known that both engines were removed from the firm by Francoschi's employees, but only one engine arrived at the dump.
- 15) A specimen of the delivery note together with translation mentioned in para 6 is enclosed for your perusal. It will be noted that in the column headed "Type of wreckage" the wreckage is described fairly clearly, but in the case of some of these wrecksages including those of 4/0, the material is not accurately described, and in one particular case was referred to as "iron, wreckage". Furthermore the record held by this firm are not kept in an efficient manner, and the delivery note describing the wreckage removed from Canaro could not be found.
- 16) It appears feasible therefore that between the time when the wreckage was collected from Canaro, and its delivery at the dump, one of the engines was mislaid or lost. Either it was disposed of between Canaro and Rovigo, where it should have/.

have been inspected by the military inspector, or failing this inspection may have been disposed of between Herby and Porto Mungara.

12) When there is no suspicion between the time of collection of the material and the arrival at the firm's H.Q. is in Jordan that there is no further flight disposal of some of this material by the firm's employees.

13) It is to be hoped that when your H.Q. corresponds with the Italian authorities on this matter, it will suggest that there is taken to prevent the loss or disposal, in future, of the wreckage of allied war materials.

14) It is further suggested that as this Material is still allied property, steps be taken to prevent its removal by anybody, until it has been inspected by a member of the H.Q. H.Q. and passed on being of no further value to our organization.

1. Herewith are 5 bills of lading and one receipt in respect of a consignment of salvage machinery which was shipped from the Middle East to Italy.

2. The bills of lading designate your Sub-Commission as the consignee, but part of the materials, by some mischance, were shipped from Naples to the Public Works and Utilities Sub-Commission and have been handed over on receipt by them to Genio Civile and they are warehoused by them in the Farnesina yard of Genio Civile, which is located next to the Mussolini Forum in Rome and also at the Contin Airplane Factory on Route 5.

3. The status of this material is not known by this Agency. It has very little value and it is not quite clear why it was sent to Italy. The important thing to do at the moment is to make quite sure it is properly accounted for and that it is properly disposed of, and from the bills of lading it would appear that your Sub-Commission, being the consignee, should be responsible for disposing of the salvage.

4. It is suggested, other things being equal, that the salvage at present held by Genio Civile be declared a global surplus by GHQ and be officially handed over to the Italian Government by the British Ministry of Supply.

5. It will be appreciated if you will let us know if you agree to this course of action and whether you will take steps to bring it into effect.

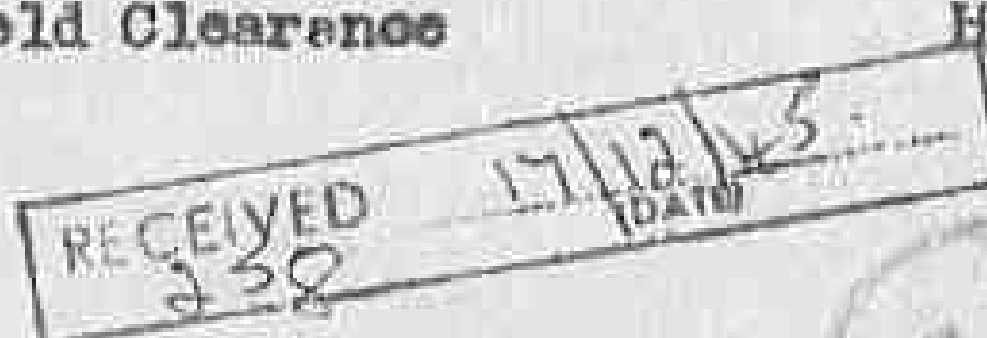

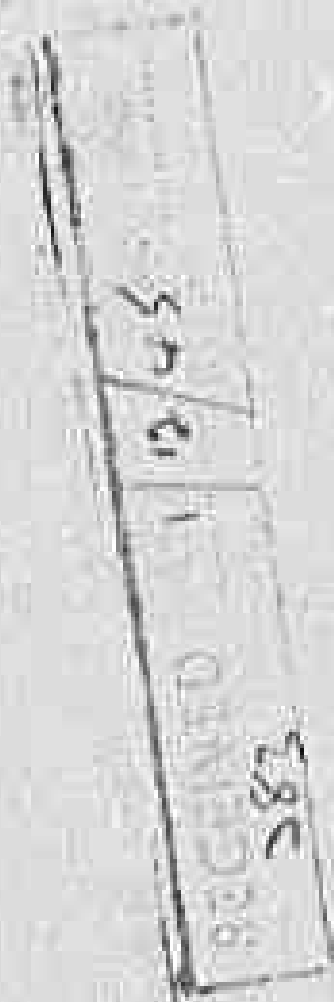

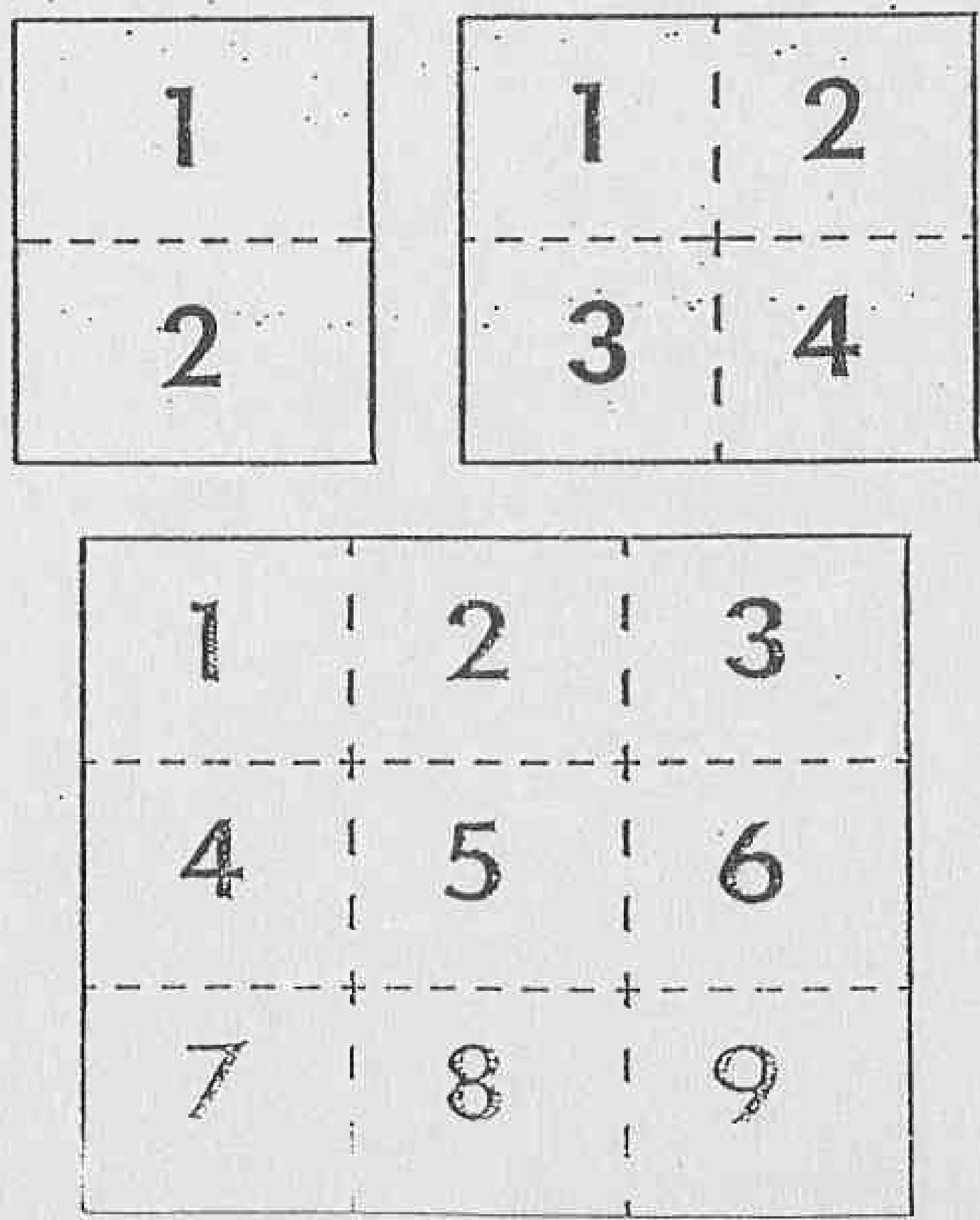
