1. Information has now been received from G.M.A., G.M.P., that the Allies are not importing electrolyte into this theatre, but are fulfilling their own requirements by local purchase.
2. In consequence no electrolyte will be available for issue to the Italian Army or the Carabinieri.
3. It is therefore strongly recommended that the Ministry of War take immediate steps towards making a contract with a civilian firm for the supply of electrolyte. Until this is effected almost all the batteries recently issued to the School of Signals Cassignola, the Ministry of War for the Italian Interim Army, and to the Carabinieri must remain out of use.
4. The present requirements of the School of Signals and the Carabinieri are as follows:-

School..... 150 gallons
Carabinieri..... 1250 "
