1. Reference is made to the proposed road constructions and repairs in CEBANO.

2. 1st attachment

2. With effect from the 1st Nov, the Italian authorities assumed full responsibility for all road repairs in ITALY. A copy of A.E.M.I. letter 6320/3/Q (Mint) dated 19 Oct which refers is attached. From this it will be seen that the Military bitumen allocated for road maintenance up to the 31 Dec 45 is available on demand to the Genio Civile. After the 31 Dec provision of bitumen is a civil responsibility, and stocks in British Army depots are only adequate for current British commitments.

3. Consequently action to improve roads in CEBANO and to construct parade grounds etc now has to be taken by you in conjunction with the Italian authorities concerned.

1. You are notified that with effect from the 15th Nov, the British Military Authorities can no longer take any responsibility for either supervising or assisting with the maintenance of roads in Italian Govt territory.

2. In consequence, on the 15th Nov, the following action will be taken by British Military Comds concerned:

- (a) British RE teams set present supervising road maintenance will be withdrawn.
- (b) WD vehicles at present on loan to the Italian Civil Authorities for road maintenance, will remain on loan to the appropriate civil authority, but the RASC maintenance teams will be withdrawn.
- (c) WD engineer plant at present on loan to contractors, etc, engaged on road maintenance, will be withdrawn. In any case where alternative civil plant is not immediately available, the local CES will be authorised to extend the loan up to 31 Dec 45.
- (d) Bitumen held as Military stocks and ⁴⁴⁸⁵ for road maintenance up to 31 Dec, will be released to the Genie Civile monthly on demand. After the 1st Dec, no bitumen will be available from Military sources.

It is requested that you notify the Italian Govt of the above arrangements. In addition, it is requested that you inform them that the roads listed in AFHQ letter AG 611/531 A(Maint)--C dated 25 July 45 Appendix "A" are of MILITARY importance and must be maintained in an efficient state of repair. These roads include

- (a) British EE team's present presence will be withdrawn.
- (b) WD vehicles at present on loan to the Italian Civil authorities for road maintenance, will remain on loan to the appropriate civil authority, but the RASC maintenance teams will be withdrawn.
- (c) WD engineer plant at present on loan to contractors, etc, engaged on road maintenance, will be withdrawn. In any case where alternative civil plant is not immediately available, the local CME will be authorized to extend the loan up to 31 Dec 45.
- (d) Bitumen held as Military stocks and ⁴⁴⁸⁵ for road maintenance up to 31 Dec, will be released to the Genio Civile monthly on demand. After the 31st Dec, no bitumen will be available from Military sources.

It is requested that you notify the Italian Govt of the above arrangements. In addition, it is requested that you inform them that the roads listed in AMHQ letter AG 511/531 A (Maint)-C dated 25 July 45 Appendix "A" are of MILITARY importance and must be maintained in an efficient state of repair. These roads include the majority of main trunk roads and are therefore possibly of even greater importance to the civil economy.

In addition to roads listed in above quoted letter, the HQ of Districts and Areas will, from time to time, indicate to the local Genio Civile, certain other roads which are of local military importance, requiring a high priority for maintenance. It is requested that the Italian Govt be asked to issue the necessary instructions to ensure that the Genio Civile take appropriate action on receipt of these requests. In addition the instructions to the Genio Civile should cover the question of providing the local Military with advance information of any intention to close any road.

Subject:- Water Supply - Cesano.

Q.163.

1. 2,600 gallons per day is pumped from ~~ESTIA~~ ^{PAOLO} water main which takes water from lake BRACCIANO to ROME.
2. A further 4,500 - 6,000 gallons per day is pumped from various wells in the area. The output of these is likely to increase after some rain.
3. Another well with a small output has just recently been put into operation.
4. The Medical Directorate of the ROME Territorial Command state that the water supply as above is fit for drinking.
5. Various schemes for the improvement of the water supply have been initiated and a full report is being prepared by Maggiore Bucchi Direzione Lavori Genio, which will be ready this week.

2. With effect from the 15 Nov, the Italian authorities assumed full responsibility for all road repairs in ITALY. A copy of this HQ letter 6320/3/Q(Maint) dated 19 Oct which refers is attached. From this it will be seen that the Military bitumen allocated for road maintenance up to the 31 Dec 45 is available on demand to the Genio Civile. After the 31 Dec provision of bitumen is a civil responsibility, and stocks in British Army depots are only adequate for current British commitments.
3. In consequence you will appreciate that any action to improve the access road to CEBANO or construct a parade ground must rest with the Italian authorities.

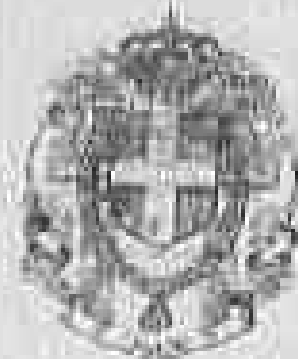
