 following the institutional change, instruction is hereby given  
 in order that the letters CC.RR. of the a/m vehicles are modified  
 to CC. by hammering out the letters RR. and leaving the number  
 unaltered.

Instructions regarding licence plates, given in  
 the above mentioned circular, will remain unchanged.

CC.RR. Tel: Repeated Liuzzi if there had been a change in policy regarding MM for the Carabinieri, in view of the small number of load carriers allocated in June. Liuzzi said that apart from the scaling down of ests which had been agreed with Gen. BRIGANTI there had been no change that he knew of.

On being sent for, Meloni and Aldois produced the following figures for veh deliveries to CC.RR during the past three months:

Meloni explained that the big fall in the load carriers was due to the failure of manufacturers to effect further deliveries of new vols, nor was he in a position at the moment to say when further consignments could be expected. In reply to the writer's question it was stated that in June 66 load-carriers were delivered to the Army. Meloni thought this a fair proportion.

It was stated that in addition to the above the CC.RR were holding numerous vols unofficially, particularly army, which had been requisitioned from civilians etc. Figures corresponding to the above for the Army were NOT available, but Meloni promised to have them prepared for comparison purposes.

The moral of all this appears to be the same old story of lack of co-operation and so on or liaison between CC.RR and the War Ministry.

There has been allotted up to date 198 jeeps to the various CCRR Legions.

Under to day's date 2 jeeps have been allotted to the Legion of Palermo which will be immediately sent to destination. This Legion is now at complete scale as given in the W.E.

The Legion of Bolzano has actually a surplus in respect of W.E.

The Legion of Messina is at full scale with W.E.

On the other hand there remains to be completed to W.E. nearly all the Legions and it is therefore necessary that priority be given to the Legions in deficiency in respect of Messina, Palermo and Bolzano Legions.

Once cleared of these deficiencies it will be possible to re-examine later the position of Bolzano, Messina and Palermo Legions.

Subject: Repair of CC.RR. Vehicles.

- (1) It is essential, particularly at the moment, that the vehicles on issue to the HQ's and Units of the CC.RR. Corps are held in the most serviceable condition possible.
- (2) It is therefore ordered that priority be given to repair works on these vehicles whenever they are brought in to the Repairs Units for servicing.
- (3) The necessary orders will be given.

SUBJECT: Repairs to Vehicles belonging to the CO.RH.

- (1) Due to the particular situation and the special service requirements of the CO.RH. the necessity often arises that they have to strange quickly for small and average repairs to the vehicles allotted to them.
- (2) Therefore, in accordance with the instructions in the circular from the Cabinet No. 268.000 dated 5/4/1945 CO.RH. HQ's which have vehicles located at repair units H.Q.s, have been authorised to have small repairs carried out by civilian firms; whilst HQ's which have vehicles outside the repair unit H.Q., plus the small repairs, may also have the larger repairs carried out by civilian firms.
- (3) Examination of the estimates and the authority for the relative expenses is the responsibility of the A/A repair vehicles, to be carried out sending their own representative to the place.
- (4) Repair Directorates are also responsible for checking the unserviceable vehicles, check of works and the check of repaired vehicles, to inspect 5 or circular 1500 dated 24/7/1942.
- (5) Approval will not be given for the estimates unless the Loonee & and name of the unit which has the vehicle & charge is shown. If these are not shown, this information will be requested from the unit concerned, sending for information the letter enclosed to the Gen. HQ, or the CO.HQ.- Admin. Directorate- and to this Ministry - M.L. Division.
- (6) HQ's will receive directly for the purchase of tyres from the open market, checked by a General officer, who will be in charge of the purchase Commission with the procedures laid down in Circular 2450 and 25400 dated 30/12/40 and 10/12/41.

HQ's, HQ's own Service vehicles located at depots referred out by civilian firms, whilst HQ's which have vehicles outside the repair unit HQ, plus the small repairs, may also have the larger repairs carried out by civilian firms.

- (3) Examination of the estimates and the authority for the relative expenses is the responsibility of the A/M repair directorates, and will always be kept within the limits referred to in para 5 of circular 15400 dated 24/7/1945.
- (4) Repair Directorates are also responsible for choosing the unserviceable vehicles, check of works and the check of repaired vehicles, to be carried out sending their own representative to the place.
- (5) Approval will not be given for the estimates unless the license No. and name of the unit which has the vehicle charge is shown. If these are not shown, this information will be requested from the unit concerned, sending for information the letter concerned to the Gen. M. of the O.S.M.- Admin. Directorate and to this Ministry - M.T. Division.

Each car repair Directorate will therefore take care of the repair of vehicles on issue to C.S. Units located in territory under their own jurisdiction.



1. High priority is at present being given to the C.R.C as regards clothing, equipment, arms, ammunition and transport. A special section of A.C.A. has been authorised by A.C.A. to examine the present C.R.C organisations, advise on measures needed to promote efficiency and assess priorities of available equipment.

2. The meager resources of the Italian War Min are insufficient at present to meet the requirements of the C.R.C in full in addition to the Italian Army.

This is particularly so in the case of transport the gravity of the position being well known to A.C.A. An attempt is being made to augment the number of British vehicles available by securing the release of US Army surplus vehicles. If successful this will confront the War Min with the task of maintaining British and American vehicles as well as Italian vehicles requiring a vast number of spare parts, resultant to cost of origin.

It follows that at the earliest possible date strengthening of transport must be achieved and that vehicles of Italian manufacture are of primary importance to the Italian Army.

3. From the contents of the Letter 201/A/1/162 dated 28 Dec it appears that 2nd hub C.R.C are receiving disposal instructions on a considerable number of Italian passenger vehicles. They are required to remove 36 Fiat 1500 and 115 Fiat 1100 for C.R.C and may dispose of the remainder if "surplus to military requirements". The present difficulties in this type of vehicle are as under:

Therefore, as our Command urgently needs these 2 cars, we beg your Supreme Command to kindly issue a renewal of this release note.


