On the 28th. April 1945, two senior officers of your Ministry (S.M. - Services office) reported to this H.Q. at Crotone to point out that w.e.f. 1st, May 1945, the 294 A.A. "Light M.T. Unit would assume the new denomination of the 4th. Special Transport Company with the following war establishment :

- PERSONNEL	165
- MOTORCYCLES	10
- CARS	5
- LORRIES	110

They stated, moreover, that the said M.T. unit, w.e.f. the date stated above, would definitely change over to the BR-ITI category and that the personnel and vehicles short of war establishment would, as before, be sent to complete the war establishment shown above and laid down by the High Commands concerned.

On the 28th. April 1945, the 294 Light M.T. Unit was formed as follows :

- PERSONNEL	191
- MOTORCYCLES	10
- CARS	6
- LORRIES	76

The said vehicles and personnel were employed by English and American Allied Commands since December 1943 for the transport of tree trunks and timber and since that date the unserviceable vehicles handed in have never been replaced.

Further, in compliance with Ministry of War circular - Cabinet No. 20800 - dated 5.4.1945, the following unserviceable vehicles were handed in :

6 September 1945

Cars	2
Lorries	5

30 November 1945

Cars	2
Lorries	10

On the 4th. August 1945, with M.M.I.A. order No. N/83, 2 lorries were assigned to the 4th. Special Transport Company from the 2nd. Serviceable Vehicle Park, Naples. Of these lorries, one reached Crotone unserviceable, having seized up, and the other had to be towed from Sala Consilina because of defect of the injection pump.

Consequently, the 4th. Special Transport Company, which is working very hard under the command of this H.Q., is, at today's date, formed as follows :

LORRIES	63 (6 of which are waiting to be handed in)

Even though it does not possess a proper workshops and suitable skilled personnel, in order to maintain the largest number of efficient vehicles possible, the H.Q. of the 4th.S.T.C. has, with a simple repair squad and workshops material fitted out on its own initiative, worked untiringly, to the point of being commended by this G.H.Q.

After such as has been set out above, I request your Ministry to kindly assign to the H.Q. of the 4th.S.T.C., either the number of vehicles for employment to replace those handed in or the completion of its war establishment.

Since the 4th.S.T.C. has practically all vehicles of the Fiat 626/B type, the assignment should be of vehicles of that type.

Should there be serviceable vehicles in the Serviceable Vehicle Parks which cannot be employed due to lack of tyres, etc., this G.H.Q. will arrange in this respect.

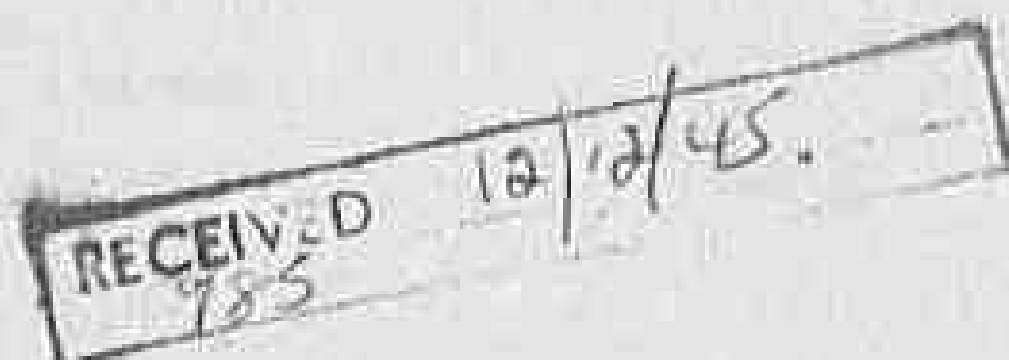
