Mighal,
 - considered that as is shown by the attached documents (statements of the Turin Questura) the vehicle has never been handed over to any fascist or nazi authority or person, which fact I state against any other declaration,
 - considered that the technical report of Alfa Romeo, manufacturers through their agency at Turin, can specify that the vehicle entrusted to them by the Questura of Turin for its servicing before being handed over to the above mentioned officers in view of the fact that the vehicle was practically dismantled, was new with a maximum of 300 Km. run, which distance was covered at the time of testing of the technical details made by me to the said vehicle (change of speed on the dashboard), and that the said consignees of the vehicle until July 1945 can confirm the above if requested,
 - considered that no Italian or Allied requisitioning law is in force or can justify eventual requisitioning claims; 5354
- all the foregoing being so, since I have personal need of the said vehicle, ~~whose~~ the value of which is such as to constitute one of my main worldly possessions, and since my reasons of right cannot be excepted, I take the liberty of asking, as I ask your respected Ministry, for the restitution of vehicle Alfa Romeo 2500 as described above in its present condition.

It has, on the contrary, been discovered that during the clandestine period, Dr. Ansaldi carried out patriotic activities as a member of the Franchi organisation and on the strength of H.Q. Special Force, Berne centre of activities. No legal action has ever been taken against Dr. Ansaldi by this office.

SUBJECT: Statement.

In June last this Questura received a charge against Dr. Ansaldo Michele Oscar which had been brought by a relative of his Count Revelli Beaumont Mario, in which charge Dr. Ansaldo was accused of having placed at the disposal of the ex Chief of the Fascist Government his car Alfa Romeo 2500, engine No. 923054, chassis No. 913018. We consequently proceeded to the confiscation of the above mentioned vehicle and it was handed over to the Allied H.Q.

In the meantime this Office initiated careful enquiries which were intended to establish the guilt of Dr. Ansaldo and the proof of his relative's denunciation. It was thus brought to light that it had actually been made to appear by Dr. Ansaldo as handed over to the ex Chief of the Fascist Government but only in order to prevent German forces from stealing it as war booty. The dispute thus being clarified and considering that Dr. Ansaldo belonged to the Franchi organisation and on the strength of the Special Force H.Q., Activities centre of Berne, this office does not hesitate to recognise that Dr. Ansaldo is entitled to all the rights of legitimate ownership of the vehicle in question and there should be no difficulty therefore in its being handed over to Dr. Ansaldo.

1. The above car has an interesting history, particulars of which are given below:

The owner - Sig. Ansaldi of Torino - lent the car to Mussolini by whom it was used for some months in 1944 and 1945. Sig. Ansaldi recovered the car, but he was later arrested and the car was seized by the Questura of Torino, who passed it to an Allied Officer for the latter's personal use. Sig. Ansaldi was later released and is now in Torino.

2. It is understood that the owner would prefer to have the car requisitioned from him, on condition that it is returned to him at some later date. The alternative is that it be returned to the Questura of Turin, from which the owner may, or may not eventually secure possession.

1. In accordance with G.R.O. 1271, a number of vehicles at present surplus to the W.R. of M.H.I.A. are being withdrawn. Remaining vehicles are, without exception, mechanically unreliable. It is understood from A.F.H.Q. that, with the exception of 8 ext. Heavy Utility Chevrolet type, no new vehicles can be released in replacement.

2. In these circumstances, it is anticipated that A.F.H.Q. approval will be obtained for requisitioned civilian cars to be held against the W.R. of M.H.I.A. As it is contrary to policy to requisition cars now in the hands of civilians, the only source from which reliable civilian cars can be obtained is from those which are now becoming surplus to the needs of A.C.

3. It is, therefore, particularly requested that you will inform this Sub Commission before any action is taken to release a passenger vehicle which it is proposed to release to the Ministry of Transport. If, after inspection, the vehicle is found to be mechanically efficient, A.F.H.Q. covering approval will be obtained to retain the vehicle on requisition to the British Military Authorities.
