1. There are forwarded for your information a copy of the Executive
Commissioner's letter, reference 8255/205/EC of 3 June, together with this
Headquarters' reply thereto, reference C-5: 960.51 of 7 June 1946.

2. While it is agreed that the responsibility for the maintenance of
the Italian Armed Forces is a matter for the Italian Government alone, will
you please say whether 50% of the P.G.L. suggested in paragraph 6 of subject
letter could be made available ex British Theatre stocks should the need
arise?

3. The matter has been referred to G-4 this Headquarters who state that:-

(a) in the event of an emergency, issues of requirements in para-
graph 6 could be made available ex American Theatre stocks.

(b) repayment will be made in kind, in products of U. S. Military
specifications only, and/or, in dollar instruments.

4. In the event that you are in a position to issue 50% of the quantities
it is suggested that the question of settlement could be mutually agreed between
your Headquarters, MIA and the Italian Government.

SUBJECT : P.O.L. for Italian Army

TO : AFHQ

1. It is evident that without regional reserves under its control the Italian Army is dependent on G.I.P. for supplying its requirements of petroleum products in a regular and orderly fashion. In times of emergency when the internal security of Italy might be menaced it may be expected the G.I.P.'s ability to carry out its functions will be adversely effected owing to the possibility of its employees being involved in the general unrest.

Already the efficiency of the Army and CC.RK. has been hampered by a lack of mobility due to non-arrival or late receipt of essential supplies. The situation suffered a further deterioration due to the recent strike among the petroleum workers engaged in the civilian distribution of petroleum products. Industrial disputes will undoubtedly be fanned by extremists anxious to embarrass the Government.

2. The War Ministry is being pressed by Land Forces Sub-Commission to secure control of adequate supplies and similarly the attention of the Italian Government is being drawn by me to their responsibility in the matter.

3. Under the terms of para 5 of AFHQ Directive of 2 November 1945 the S.A.C. reserves the right to re-assume command, at any time, of any part of the Italian Army. Even before such a step was taken the S.A.C. might be deeply concerned as to the ability of the Italian Armed Forces to function under Italian Command. It is therefore felt that AFHQ may wish to make provision for an adequate supply of P.O.L. in case this emergency does arise.

4. At Appendix "A" is listed the Italian Army Depots on which both Army Units and CC.RK. could be based together with the estimated consumption of P.O.L. for one month. If you concur you are requested to forward instructions as to the appropriate method of obtaining emergency supplies with the minimum of delay should the need arise in one or other of the localities mentioned.

TO : Chief Commissioner,

Reference 8255/204/EC, 3 June 1946.

1. It is the responsibility of the Italian Government to provide PGL for the Italian Armed Forces.

2. The Italian Military, in conjunction with the Italian Government must decide the size and location of the stocks needed to meet any situation which the Italian Army, in its internal security role, may be called upon to deal. Therefore, the provisioning of the depots listed in your Appendix "A" is the responsibility of the Italian Government and if they consider that these are the most suitable locations to hold reserves of PGL action to implement them should be taken forthwith.

3. As the maintenance of internal order is of primary interest to the Allies, you should encourage the Italian Government by every legitimate means to institute adequate and timely procedures for the maintenance of its armed forces by the establishment of reserve depots and other well recognized methods.

4. Maintenance of Italian Armed Forces in any circumstances other than that envisaged above would be a matter for decision when such circumstances arise.

ALLIED orders.

3. A case in point is TOMEZZO (Alpini) Bn of 8 (Alpini) Regt,
employed on frontier control in UDINE area.

4. To carry out the role allotted by 13 Corps this Bn requires
equipment (e.g. No 19 sets, field telephones, cable) in excess of G 1098
or SEL for an ITALIAN Inf Bn and it requires POL in excess of the monthly
ITALIAN allotment to an ITALIAN Bn.

5. It is the opinion of this HQ that in these circumstances such
requirements in excess of normal ITALIAN allotments should in fairness
be met by the ALLIES.




Ref. your letter No. 8255/205/20 of the 5 June '46 to the President of the Council, I inform you that the Ministry of Industry and Commerce, after investigating the question of the supply of fuel to the Italian Army, has stated that the delay complained of does not take place at the time of consignment, but at the time of its removal. An earnest request has therefore been made to the Ministry of War in order that this inadvertent state of affairs may be remedied.

As regards the charging of private firms with the distribution of the fuel available in Italy, which before was dealt with by the C.I.P., the Ministry of Industry has stated that such a measure appears indispensable, in view of the deficiency found in the service of the C.I.P., and in order to ensure the necessary care for the normalization of the petroliferous trade and industry, eliminating for reasons of economic and social order, all monopolies no longer justified by the exigencies of war.



1. It is the responsibility of the Italian Government to provide PCL for the Italian Armed Forces.

2. The Italian Military, in conjunction with the Italian Government must decide the size and location of the stocks needed to meet any situation which the Italian Army, in its internal security role, may be called upon to deal. Therefore, the provisioning of the depots listed in your Appendix "A" is the responsibility of the Italian Government and if they consider that these are the most suitable locations to hold reserves of PCL action to implement them should be taken forthwith.

3. As the maintenance of internal order is of primary interest to the Allies, you should encourage the Italian Government by every legitimate means to institute adequate and timely procedures for the maintenance of its armed forces by the establishment of reserve depots and other well recognized methods.

4. Maintenance of Italian Armed Forces in any circumstances other than that envisaged above would be a matter for decision when such circumstances arise.

1. It is the responsibility of the Italian Government to provide POL for the Italian Armed Forces.
2. The Italian Military, in conjunction with the Italian Government must decide the size and location of the stocks needed to meet any situation which the Italian Army, in its internal security role, may be called upon to deal. Therefore, the provisioning of the depots listed in your Appendix "A" is the responsibility of the Italian Government and if they consider that these are the most suitable locations to hold reserves of POL action to implement them should be taken forthwith.
3. As the maintenance of internal order is of primary interest to the Allies, you should encourage the Italian Government by every legitimate means to institute adequate and timely procedures for the maintenance of its armed forces by the establishment of reserve depots and other well recognized methods.
4. Maintenance of Italian Armed Forces in any circumstances other than that envisaged above would be a matter for decision when such circumstances arise.

1. It is evident that without regional reserves under its control the Italian Army is dependent on C.I.P. for supplying its requirements of petroleum products in a regular and orderly fashion. In times of emergency when the internal security of Italy might be menaced it may be expected the C.I.P.'s ability to carry out its functions will be adversely affected owing to the possibility of its employees being involved in the general unrest.

Already the efficiency of the Army and C.I.P. has been hampered by a lack of mobility due to non-arrival or late receipt of essential supplies. The situation suffered a further deterioration due to the recent strike among the petroleum workers engaged in the civilian distribution of petroleum products. Industrial disputes will undoubtedly be fanned by extremists to embarrass the Government.

2. The War Ministry is being pressed by Land Forces Sub-Commission to assume control of adequate supplies and similarly the attention of the Italian Government is being drawn by us to their responsibility in the matter.

3. Under the terms of para 5 of A.F.H.Q. Directive of 2 November 1945 the S.A.C. reserves the right to re-assume command, at any time, of any part of the Italian Army. Even before such a step was taken the S.A.C. might be deeply concerned as to the ability of the Italian Armed Forces to function under Italian Command. It is therefore felt that A.F.H.Q. may wish to make provision for an adequate supply of P.O.L. in case this emergency does arise.

4. At Appendix "A" is listed the Italian Army Depots on which both Army Units and C.I.P. could be based together with the estimated consumption of P.O.L. for one month. If you concur you are requested to forward instructions as to the appropriate method of obtaining emergency supplies with the minimum of delay should the need arise in one or other of the localities mentioned.

My dear Mr. Prime Minister:

1. I am informed that although the Italian Army has been allotted adequate supplies of motor fuels and lubricants that there has been a delay in delivering to certain Units the quantities which have been allotted to them.

2. The Minister of War has been informed of the need for economy but even so I consider he will be unable to meet his various commitments unless he is assured that his requirements of petroleum products will be punctually and regularly supplied especially during June and July.

3. The deficiency has no doubt been accentuated by the recent strike of G.I.P. employees and this has demonstrated to what extent, in the absence of regional reserves, the Italian Army is dependent on a regular and adequate supply being maintained.

4. I understand that it is intended to prolong the present status of G.I.P. to the 31st August and that after this date the distribution of petroleum products will revert to commercial companies whose pooled facilities have been pooled and are now being used by G.I.P. It would appear that this latter course might result in a certain confusion and possible breakdown in the planned and orderly distribution of P.O.L. rendering still more difficult the supply of the Army's needs.

5. I therefore request you to

insist that provision be made for the immediate needs of the Armed Forces to be met without delay in order to avoid a further deterioration of the necessity for military control to be established over the storage installations.

re-examine in the light of what is truly practicable the intention to hand over to competitive commercial concerns after 31 August the distribution of the limited quantities of petroleum products available for use in Italy.
