1. The matter has been carefully considered at this HQ. Unless a case can be made out for resisting the General claim, on the grounds that he benefited financially by letting his property to hostile or enemy agents, there can be no chance of a successful appeal to the American Authorities.
2. You are advised to
 - (a) retain a claim on the alternative premises and prepare to occupy them.
 - (b) urge 217 Area to adopt a firm attitude with the General and to defer the release of the property until a request is received from the American authorities.
 - (c) collect any evidence available to justify an appeal being made to the American Authorities.
3. It appears that no pressure has yet been brought to bear on the British Authorities to grant the early release of these premises.
