



(b) STORAGE VEHICLES

At the present time no spare parts, as such, are required. It would be of great assistance however, if the following items could be released:

- (1) 3 x 15 cwt canopies and 1 x 3 ton canopy which are required for the corps on duty at check posts. Their vans are still present deficient.
 - (2) Only two tool-kits are held for the 15 British Vehicles on charge to the CO. A release is required for 1 Dodge 3 Ton tool-kit and 1 Ford 15 cwt tool-kits.
- None of these items are immediately available from 5 Territorial Command.

(c) PETROLEUM

Although oil is drawn through the 3 Alpine Posts on a monthly basis for cleaning weapons it is thought that this is a poor substitute for Brit. White Oil. An allocation of correct Brit. Pattern Rifle Oil sufficient for 3 months would be of great assistance.

(d) TORETTES

A release is required for 10 torches, hand pattern complete with batteries and bulbs. A number of torch batteries and bulbs were released by you recently. These are reported to be of the WRONG type and will be returned under arrangements this unit. A release of the above number of torches would allow for an issue of two torches to each of the 19 check points on the Venezia Giulia Boundary and 2 spare.

The most important deficiency in the Bn is signal equipment.

At the present time Hq 5 Territorial Command is unable to supply any Signal Equipment. This will only be possible when surplus stocks of British Signal Equipment have been handed over to the Italian Army by U.S.A. The following items of Signal Equipment are required to establish communications between the check posts on the Venezia Giulia border and Bn HQ:-

12 x Field Telephones
20 miles Field Cables

6 x V/T Sets with range approx 15 miles.

These V/T sets are required for communication between the check posts in the mountainous areas and their Coy HQ. It will be necessary for a course to be arranged by 5 Territorial Signal Company to train the necessary operators.

The Bn has been issued with 24 machine carbines surplus to U.S. The deficiency of heavy weapons such as 3" Mortars M1Cs to which the Bn is entitled does not handicap the Bn in its abilities on the Venezia Giulia Boundary.

4. The clothing situation is considered to be satisfactory. HQ 5 Territorial Command will give special attention to the issue of winter clothing by the time necessary.

5. Any assistance that you can give towards making good the above mentioned deficiencies would be greatly appreciated.

1. The supply of petrol to ITI(ITALIAN) units is the responsibility of the ITALIAN Government, irrespective of the fact that they may be serving under op cond of a BRITISH fmn HQ and operating BRITISH Army owned vehicles.

2. While it is fair that 13 Corps or a BRITISH HQ or unit nominated by 13 Corps should supply 5 BLU with the requisite information, further direct issues from BRITISH military stocks to the TOLMEZZO Bn should be made only when operational necessity arises which renders the minimum monthly quota inadequate. The failure of the ITALIAN Ministry of War to ensure an adequate quota of POL to permit this unit to carry out its normal role does NOT come into this category.

3. Finally you may care to reiterate to the ITALIAN War Ministry that the provision of POL for twenty one vehicles should NOT present any unsurmountable problem of either supply or distribution.

1. It is apparent that the procedure by which the Italian Army obtain supplies of P.L.I. is not fully understood. C.I. is primarily a commercial undertaking, which distributes P.L.I. to the retailers, carrying both civilian and military stocks.
2. The monthly requirements of the Army are the subject of a bid by the War Ministry through U.N.I.A. to the Combined Petroleum Committee. These bids are screened at this S.A. and reduced to the minimum considered essential. Even so, they are frequently cut to conform to available stocks. For this reason supplementary bids are difficult to negotiate with any prospect of success.
3. It is appreciated that in the case under discussion, the TANZICO ALBINO Inc. is operating in the interests of the Italian Government. They are, however, acting under Allied operational orders and have been loaned British vehicles for this purpose. Instruct options are being issued to the War Ministry to include their requirements in future bids, but it may not be possible to arrange delivery by the 22 Feb 46.
4. It is therefore requested that Allied assistance may continue if essential. If repayment is to be insisted upon, it is recommended that this shall take the form of debiting the Italian Government with the value of P.L.I. delivered, rather than the replacement in kind. The latter alternative will necessitate a supplementary bid by the War Ministry, which, as stated above, would be difficult to negotiate.
