Subject : Evacuation of ~~inxixx~~ Crown-lodgings on the property of the Animal Supply Centre of Lazio.

It has been brought to the notice of this Ministry that the "Toro" and "Arone" buildings on the "Casalnuovo" property held by the Animal Supply Centre of Lazio, are going to be evacuated. These buildings are at present occupied by Italian troops under the command of your Allied HQ. It seems that the buildings would be made available to German prisoners destined to the said H.Q.

Such news has created a feeling of discouragement among the workers employed by the said Centre, who thereby would see vanishing the opportunities of re-occupying their lodgings, and re-settling their own families. These people are at present, living, according to the size of the family, in one or ~~twoxxxxxx~~ at the most, two rooms.

If this information were true, the result would be that we should see the German prisoners well settled-in, while workers of the Centre were still forced to undergo the aforementioned ~~discomforts~~; discomforts which, without doubt, will be accentuated during the coming winter.

We therefore beg MMIA kindly to avoid measures which undoubtedly be of great harm to the personnel of the Animal Supply Centre concerned.

The owner, General Antonio Belotti, which he would not leave in the part and particularly during the Nazi-fascist domination, because its furniture, silver plate, carpets, pictures, etc., were Italian Government's property, and therefore would have been certainly taken to the North, either by the Germans or by the fascists.

General Belocco remained via Ciro Menotti and allowed his own apartment (on so private) to be occupied by the wife and daughter of Signor Reich, an Italian Jew, seized by the German authorities.

Information was given by General Belocco to Major John Watt, page interpreter at the reception of the property requisition note.

Since December 1944 the Italian Ministry of War ordered General Belocco (who has created a military service) to leave his apartment via Ciro Menotti; but this is not possible as long as the present Corso Trieste 155 is not released.

General Belocco would appreciate if you will assume the responsibility of the apartment in question being demobilized.

1°) - Owing to the fact that the premises at 19 Viale Angelico, at present occupied by the Special Transport Group, form an integral part of the Signal Office, we wish to point out ~~the~~ ^{that} ~~the~~ ^{is} absolute necessity of making these premises available in order to meet the growing needs of the said Signal Office, which is (for want of storing space for the large quantities of materials, which ~~arrive~~ arrive daily) in a critical position. (150 tons of materials from Sardinia alone arrive weekly).



Further to letter 1533 dated 3-4-45 from this office and ref to letter 1108 dated 2-4-45 from that Comune. In view of what ^{was} communicated to the Prefettura by the ROME territorial command with letter 6829 dated 14/4/45 and 7319 dated 22 April 45, we order that all the families of refugees, or indigents that are yet in those barracks be evacuated without fail before the 15th instant.

You are begged to examine the advisability of using the billeting places offered by this office by the Piceno Div and situated in CASTEL GIULIANO, CANALE MONTEVERDE and MONTEVERDE, selecting and arranging immediately the most suited from among those three, either for those

who have no roof over their heads or for
public administration.

Where it is absolutely impossible and inconvenient
you will provide, by any means including regulation
(according to art 10 of P.D.L 15-3-43 n°107) the application
of which we grant you power with this letter, the
billet necessary for the refugees of the concave, for
the war refugees, however, we advise you to return
them to their own residence contacting the territorial
Command which will provide transportation. In this
respect you will bear in mind that:

- 1) The refugees from North Italy and South Italy
will be sent to Rome where they will be taken care
of by the High Commissioner for War refugees, the HQ
of which is at Piazza Nicosia n°15.
- 2) the refugee from Crotone will be taken
there
- 3) the refugees from Veneto will be sent to Rome
at the Provincial Assistance for refugees situated at Lungo-
Tevere degli Anguillara n°9.

You will answer personally to me for the
carrying out of these instructions.

We would be grateful for a ^{timely and detailed} report
what ~~had~~ been done by that administration, when
evacuation carried out.

The matter has again been referred to Rome Area Allied Command.

It is not possible to release the race course of Tor di Quinto at present, nor is it likely that it will be available for some time.

In releasing buildings and land held under requisition, the Allied Authorities take into consideration the value which the accommodation in question represents towards the rehabilitation of Italy. Schools come in the first order of priority, buildings which provide accommodation for large numbers of people also take a high place.

There remain the many demands, including those of the War Ministry, for office accommodation. It is in order to find alternative accommodation for allied units displaced by the release of such buildings that the Tor di Quinto Camp may be required after its present employment is terminated.

It is pointed out by R.A.A.C. that the Galoppetoio has already been released and also the Capannelle Race Course, although no use appears to be being made of the latter. Further the Polo ground is about to be released, although this would have been useful to the Allies as a Cricket and sports ground.
