It has been brought to the notice of this Ministry that the "German" and "Arabic" buildings on the "Camelherd" property held by the animal supply centre of Lado, are going to be evacuated. These buildings are at present occupied by Italian troops under the command of your office. It seems that the buildings would be made available to German prisoners destined to the said H.M.I.A.
