SUBJECT : Accommodation for the artillery Directorate of Naples

1. The Artillery Directorate of Naples is at present accommodated in cold and very damp caves situated at Fondo di Capodimonte which:

- are most unhealthy for the workers who have to stay in during working hours. (several deaths have been caused through TB).

- cause the daily working hours to be cut down to six and a half whereas nine hours of work per day should be given in accordance with rules laid down. (hence: a loss of two and a half hours per day paid without the state receiving the corresponding work).

- cause the material stored there to deteriorate very quickly (rust, moss, etc) with loss and large depreciation of value.

Recently, dangerous falling in the framework of the upper caves have been caused on account of the first rains and it has been necessary to evacuate several premises in order to avoid painful accidents. With the forthcoming bad weather, it is to be born in mind that other inconveniences of the kind could happen and these could affect the functioning of, if not also, the work of the establishment with repercussions on the employees.

2. In view of giving suitable accommodation to the said Artillery Directorate, I shall be very grateful to you if you would kindly examine the possibility of handing over to this Administration the barracks in Naples which is most suitable for the purpose.

In case said barracks cannot be absolutely handed over, Naples

In case said barracks cannot be absolutely handed over, VICENTIA barracks, which is located in the same city and which is also occupied by the allies, could be used temporarily. Said barracks, however, would not permit any large scale works to be carried out and hence, the use of same would not help in solving the serious problem of re-employment of the large number of workers still unemployed.

SUBJECT: Woodcutting on the Persano Royal Estate.

56th. Area (English) appointed Mr. Manlio TIZZANI to cut - over a period of 3 months - a total of 10,000 tons of hard firewood on the grounds of the Persano Animal Supply Centre (Salerno).

In view of the harm which the cutting of thousands of trees would cause to the wooded part of the property, more serious because the foals in training in a wild state would be deprived of natural shelter from inclement weather (insofar as - as is known - the larger part of the stables and barracks are occupied by 812 base - English Remount Depot), the Inspectorate General of Hippic and Veterinary Services submitted to M.M.I.A. the serious inconveniences which said cutting would cause.

Following this approach, M.M.I.A. verbally informed us that the matter had been reviewed and that, consequently, the work would be suspended.

However, since Mr. Tizzani received no order countermanding the

part of the stables and barracks are occupied by 812 Base - and
Remount Depot), the Inspectorate General of Hippic and Veterinary
Services submitted to M.M.I.A. the serious inconveniences which said
cutting would cause.

Following this approach, M.M.I.A. verbally informed us that the
matter had been reviewed and that, consequently, the work would be

However, since Mr. Tizzani received no order countermanding the
instructions given him previously, he commenced felling forthwith and
is continuing to do so.

Upon being approached afresh, M.M.I.A. gave assurance, telephonic-
ally, that the work would be stopped as soon as it became possible to
obtain the wood elsewhere and that instructions had been issued for
the speedy location of another forest.

Since it must be presumed that the locating of an area for a new
cut will take some time and that therefore the damage complained of
above will not be avoided, with the consequent repercussions which have
already been stressed, I beg of you to kindly order, with the urgency
which the case requires, the revocation of the order for the cutting
of wood on the Persano estate.

The matter has been investigated by our Liaison officer at Naples, who informs us that the British authorities make their demand for wood to the "Forestate" office, who in turn engage this contractor, Manlio Tizzani, to provide it. Consequently, if the Forestate office informs the British that the wood is available at a given place, the British authorities make out the necessary authorization for it's collection.
2. In view of this, it appears that the matter rests between the Italian Military authorities and the Forestate office.
3. Territorial Command Naples, who do not know about this, are investigating the matter and no doubt will report to you in due course.

The Director of the Center, in agreement with the C.I. of said Remount Unit, has in the meantime postponed the start of work while awaiting instructions.

It is deemed advisable to point out that the said property occupied by said Center is part of the properties of the Center is on charge to the Military Administration. Any measures must, therefore, be authorized by the Ministry of Finance through the Engineer General - Directorate of the HQW.

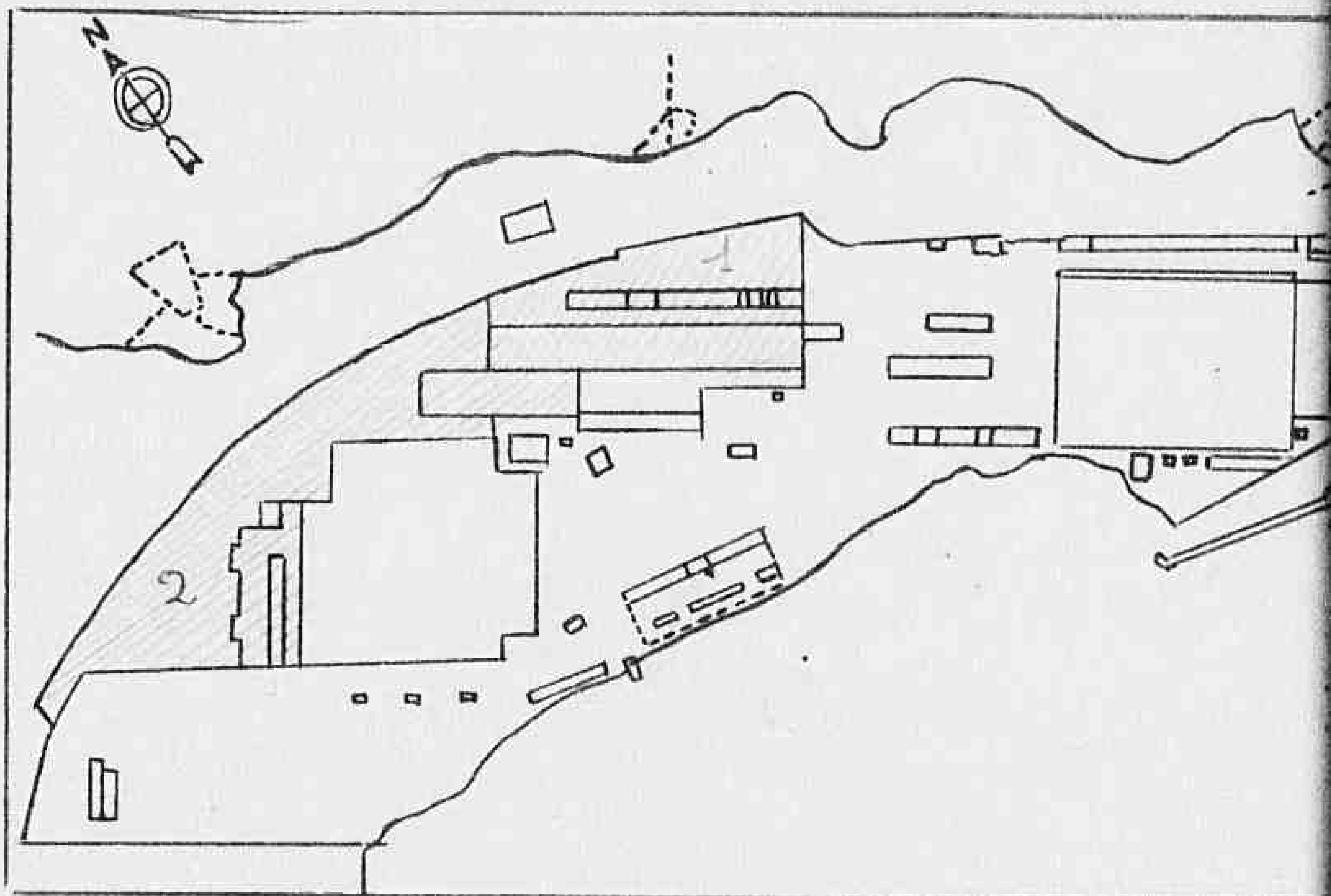

1. Reference the attached application for the above property to be made available for use as an Italian Army Ration Depot.
2. As already explained to C.G. Peninsular Base Section, Southern District this property is most urgently needed. Existing storage facilities have for some time proved inadequate. The recent AFHQ decision that Italian "Patriots" in the newly liberated areas shall be supplied with Army rations has still further increased the problem of provision.
3. In Naples is located the main Base Supply Depot of the Italian Army from which the needs of more than 200,000 troops have to be met. In Naples the ration items of Italian origin such as olive oil, wine, nuts, cigarettes, etc. (for all three categories III-III, US-III, and BR-III) have to be collected, stored and distributed. For this purpose it is essential to possess adequate covered storage space and railroad siding facilities.
4. It is therefore requested that the attached application may receive your approval and that instructions be issued for the property to be reserved for immediate occupation by Comando Territoriale de Napoli when vacated by GH Depot 5879.

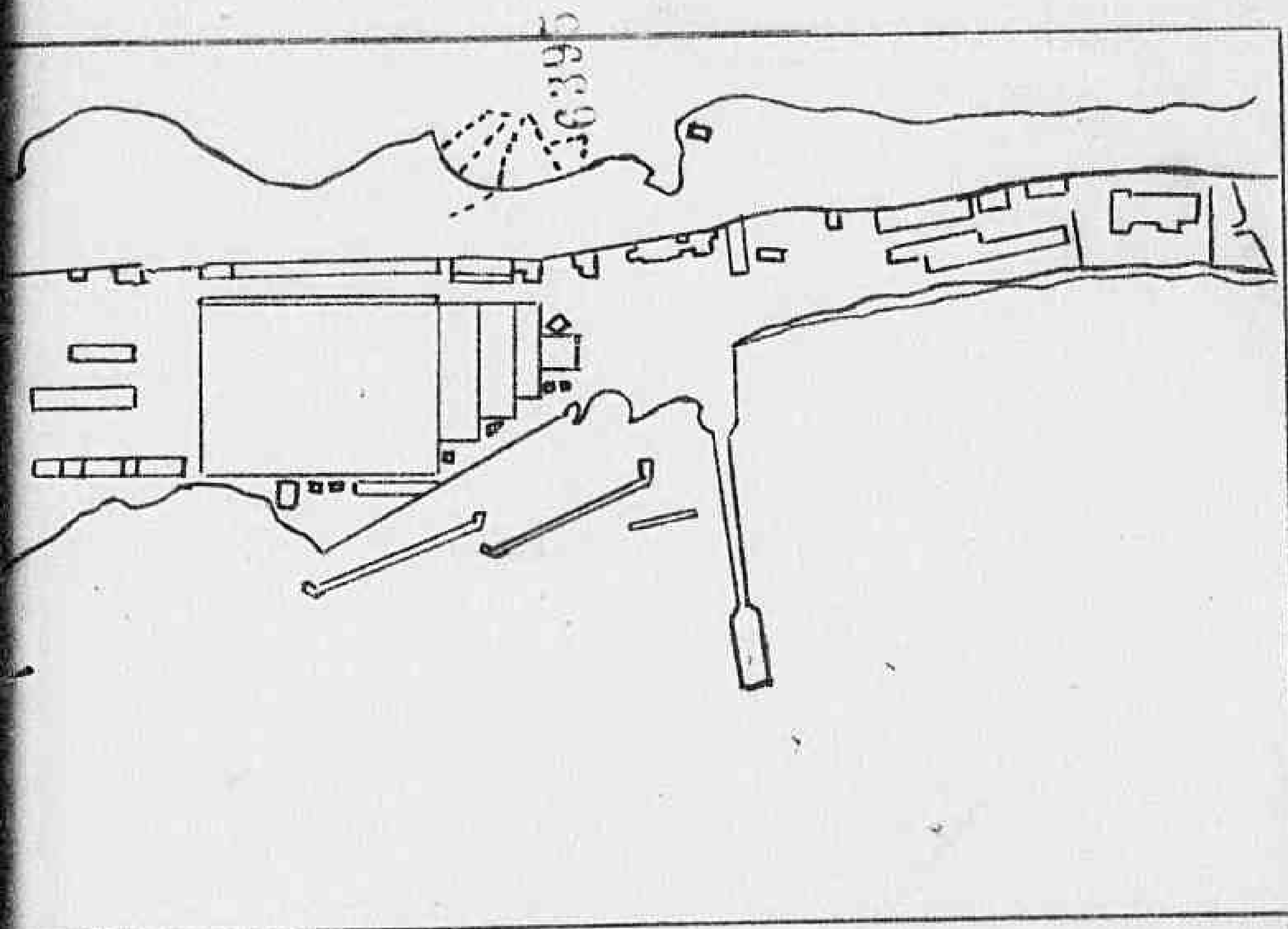

1. The attached application refers to the requisitioning of property urgently required by the Territorial HQ Italian Army NAPLES to accommodate an Italian Army MT workshop.
2. This Unit known as No. 2 Repair Unit is one of three at present operating exclusively on Italian Army transport, the others being located at ROME and BARI. It is fulfilling an indispensable part of the task of reorganising the Italian Army transport and has to date repaired and put back into commission over 150 vehicles.
3. In addition to being responsible for the 2nd line repairs of a number of Italian Army Units the C.O. is required to recondition and make available for service the very large number of broken down vehicles which have been collected in an adjacent "Inefficient Vehicle" Park.
4. Since the formation of this Unit in February last they have been severely handicapped by lack of suitable accommodation. Extensive inquiry has failed to reveal any buildings which could be made available. Those described in this application are the only ones which could be made available. They are suitable in every way for the purpose.
5. The application has been rejected by P.B.S. HQ although the buildings are vacant and have remained empty since they were requisitioned last November.
6. As the output of this Repair Unit will contribute directly to the Allied cause by reducing the demands at present made on Allied transport for Italian Army Units it is strongly recommended the property in question be released immediately.
7. In view of the volume of work waiting to be done it is requested the matter be treated as urgent and if approved a decision given by signal.

1. The *release* of Italian Barracks still occupied by the Allies has been carefully considered but it is regretted that at present it is not possible to release this accommodation. Territorial HQ Naples should *be* instructed to keep in touch with the MIA LO, who will notify them as soon as the position improves.

2. With reference to your 207896/II, of 1st of April, please give more details as to the use to which the Artillery Barracks at Nocera will be put. It has been represented to the Allied *Commander* concerned that when evacuated by the Italian Army Signal School, the War Ministry wish to make use of it for another purpose ; but as the Allied demand is pressing, it may not be possible to obtain *an* agreement to this remaining at your disposal. You should therefore give full reasons why the retention of these barracks is necessary.
