Reference your letter 212594 /II dated 8 June 45.

1. Your interpretation of this Headquarters letter Q/8 8 Mar 45 is not agreed. The policy approved by the Supreme Allied Commander was to afford protection to War Ministry property against improper requisitioning by Allied officers.

2. Under the circumstances then existing cases were occurring of Allied Commanders and A.M.C. officers taking possession of Italian Army Barracks and stores in the same way as they requisitioned civilian buildings. Except in cases of operational necessity it was ruled that War Ministry property would be privileged and the printed notices were issued with the intention of assisting the Ministry to safeguard property of this nature.

3. While it is realised that a number of War Ministry Barracks are still occupied by Allied forces the number of such buildings is not likely to increase and when ever circumstances permit they will be de-requisitioned and thereafter protected.

While it is realised that a number of War Ministry Barracks are still occupied by Allied forces the number of such buildings is not likely to increase and when ever circumstances permit they will be de-requisitioned and thereafter protected. The same action cannot however be taken in the case of buildings which have been requisitioned by the War Ministry from their owners. It is considered that any dispute which may arise over the possession of such buildings must now be a matter for decision as between the Italian Government and the owner of the property.

4. If any building, not the property of the War Ministry, but which they desire to occupy has been requisitioned by the Allies the matter may, if of sufficient importance, be referred to this Headquarters who will ascertain whether or not the building can be released for the Italian Army.

Bari Military Territorial Command points out that the local M.M.I.A. Liaison Office has received instructions to only issue bilingual posters for buildings which are actually the property of the Italian Army.

This Cabinet, in circular 208100/II dated 5th. April last, (compiled in accordance with M.M.I.A.) had specified that the posters should also be applied to buildings which, although not actually belonging to the military administration, were at present being employed by various Commands, Units, and Departments, of the Army.

In order, therefore, to avoid wrongful interpretations, we beg of M.M.I.A. to be so kind as to specify as above to their outlying liaison offices.

2. It is noted that you have received Protection Notices Nos. 50809 and 50810 and that the property for which intended is at present occupied by the Allies.
3. In such cases the posting of the notice must be withheld until such time as it is possible to release the property concerned. The local Territorial Headquarters should be informed the approximate ~~period~~ the place will be required. Furthermore action should be taken to release such buildings as soon as practicable in accordance with A.F.H.Q. instructions.

Subject: Bilingual signs for buildings of the Italian military administration.

This is in pursuance and in partial amendment of circulars No. 305000/2/C.A. of November 21st and No. 300134/2/C.A. of January 5, 1945.

With reference to the new rules laid down by MMIA concerning the distribution of bilingual signs to be posted on buildings of the Italian military administration, I hereby order the following:

- 1) bilingual signs with no text and bearing a consecutive number will be sent by this Ministry to the above addressees who will fill them in as needed and distribute them after they are checked and signed by the respective MMIA Liaison officer.
- 2) the above addressees will - on or before the 25th day of each month - send to this Ministry (Cabinet - II Office) a list in duplicate of all signs approved and distributed, containing the following information:
 - number of sign
 - address
 - nature of building to which it refers (if barracks are involved, it will be necessary to indicate the number of men that can be quartered there)
 - type and amount of materials on hand in the building;
- 3) the above addressees will, furthermore, send to this Ministry (Cabinet - II Office) a list - likewise in duplicate - of all buildings owned by the Italian military administration, which were turned over temporarily to Allied authorities

for use by them, and will, thereafter, notify this Ministry of any changes from time to time.

- 4) whenever a building which is protected by a duly authorized bilingual sign is requisitioned by Allied authorities, immediate notice thereof will be given to this Ministry for transmittal of the information to MMIA.
- 5) the above addressees will inform this Ministry, by the quickest possible means, of the number of signs needed.

May I remind you that the signs in question are to be posted only on ~~some~~ buildings owned by the military administration which are now being used by Commands, Units and sundry organizations of the Royal Italian Army.

The above addressees will be held responsible for strict compliance with the foregoing.

TO: MINISTRY OF WAR

1. In order to implement the policy outlined in AFHQ Circular No. 28 Part 1 of 6 Dec 1944 with regard to the improper requisitioning of Italian Military buildings and stores, the following procedure will be adopted.

2. The Ministry of War have in their possession dual language (English-Italian) printed and numbered Notices. These notices show that the building to which they are affixed and/or its contents are Italian Military property and must not be requisitioned without reference to the proper authority, in this case HQ MHA.

3. The notices will be distributed by Ministry of War to Territorial HQ Italian Army who will complete forms as necessary and submit to the appropriate MHA LC for approval. In the case of buildings within HOME City limits application may be made direct to HQ MHA (Q2).

4. If satisfied that the building concerned is -

the property of the Italian Army, the Senior MHA LC of the formation concerned will sign the NOTICE and have recorded the following particulars :-

2. The Ministry of War have in their possession (English-Italian) printed and numbered Notices. These notices show that the building to which they are affixed and/or its contents are Italian Military property and must not be requisitioned without reference to the proper Authority, in this case HQ MHA.

3. The notices will be distributed by Ministry of War to Territorial HQ Italian Army who will complete forms as necessary and submit to the appropriate MHA LO for approval. In the case of buildings within Rome City limits application may be made direct to HQ MHA (Q2).

4. (a) It is further stated that the building concerned is -

the property of the Italian Army, the Senior MHA LO of the formation concerned will sign the NOTICE and have recorded the following particulars:-

Nature of Building

* If barracks, state number of men who can be accommodated.

(b) A return containing the above information will be rendered to HQ MHA (Q2) on the first of each month showing what NOTICES have been approved since last return. Nil returns are required.

6. Certain buildings, the property of the Italian Army, are temporarily in use by the Allied Authorities for other purposes. The Ministry is required to submit a list of such buildings to HQ MHA (Q2) and to notify any changes thereto. The list will contain information as in 4 (a) above.

7. If, in any case, a building protected by an authorized NOTICE is claimed by any Allied Authority the matter will be reported by the Ministry to HQ MHA.

The Ministry is required to improve on territorial and the importance of strictly controlling the issue of the NOVICES. The unauthorized use of a NOVICE will result in disciplinary action and will lead to the scheme being discredited.
