GABRIELE VITTORIO MARCONI SINDACATO DI SAVOIA

1. The above buildings are located at GSEDA and comprise a total of eight barrack blocks.

It was understood a request made by the Provincial Commissioner direct to the Territorial Command GSEDA had been refused. It was desired that this military accommodation should be made available for civil offices and thus release other buildings for displaced persons. You requested the matter be investigated.

2. It appears that a Major GABRIELE approached General PROVINE on the matter and that the latter offered to make available six out of the eight barracks concerned.

This offer was rejected on the grounds that the only barracks suitable were the two reserved by the Military Command.

No further action is proposed as the barracks in dispute are required by the Italian Army. Should however it be desired to make use of the six barracks already offered the MMIA IO should be informed.

1. The Italian Military Hospital building in GENOA has been completely destroyed by Allied Air action during active operations before the surrender.
2. The present temporary building is neither suitable nor large enough. It is most uneconomical to find and open another small building to provide the necessary bed space owing to the inevitable duplication of staff, equipment, medical stores, etc.
3. The building "PRINCIPE DI PIEMONTE" in VIA dei FIATANI-MARASSI-GENOA is however most suitable and will take the necessary 250 beds with all the "usual offices" of a main hospital.
4. 23 M.T. Coy of 3rd M.F. Bn at present occupy the building but this unit is being demilitarised this month and all tps will be posted to other army units.
5. In view of the urgent necessity to establish efficient Italian hospitals in N. Italy in order to prevent any necessity to use Allied bed space, it is most strongly urged that this building be allotted for an Italian Military hospital wef 1 Sep 45.
