MMIA will accept Slovenes and demobilize them at a point to be designated by MMIA west of the TAGLIAMENTO River. Repatriates will be carefully screened for Doublets to avoid releasing west of MORGAN line those whose homes are in fact east thereof.

13 CORPS will provide necessary transportation from point of demobilization to homes for those living west of MORGAN line and to points of transfer to be arranged by 13 Corps through Yugoslav Mission for those living east of MORGAN line.

These men will be received and demobilized at the rate of 500 every day.

MMIA will provide the necessary facilities for the drying of present clothing worn by this personnel prior to demobilization.

This personnel will not be used for bargaining purposes with BELGRADE.

MMIA will notify this HQ place of demobilization and when rail movement from USFET can begin.

MMIA will coordinate all details with Commander 13 Corps.

Subject : Formation of a Rear-party Office.

The Military Territorial H.Q. of Udine, in its letter of the 15th Aug 45 (No. 1180/O/M/), subject "Directorate of Artillery - Trieste", has pointed out that, foreseeing the possibility of reforming, at Trieste a detached Directorate or Section of Artillery, the H. of War has ordered at Trieste, the formation of a Rear-party Office for the winding up of the previous administration, and to take inventory of stocks still existing, and those taken away.

I therefore beg the Directorate:

- 1) To make an agreement with the NMIA for the setting-up and functioning of the rear-party office;
- 2) To let me know the personnel who will be needed for the said office, and the date on which it will commence to function;
- 3) Kindly to compile and send me, two detailed lists on which will be shown, respectively :-

a) Money, documents, and materials left behind;

b) Money, documents and materials taken away. - For these last, there should also be detailed, the circumstances under which the destruction or carrying off of the things happened, indicating if possible, by whom they were destroyed or taken away, giving the date etc. etc., and -above all- making clear whether the responsibility was on the part of the consign-

3) Kindly to compile and send me two detailed lists on which will be shown, respectively :-

Subject: Request for authorisation (Opening of the Rear-party Office of the Artillery Directorate of Trieste).

The writer, substituting the Director of the former Directorate of Artillery of Trieste, wishes to communicate the following:

Before the 1 May 45, there existed at Trieste a Directorate of Artillery, under the command of the Italian M. of War, with the task of storing and ~~maintaining~~ ^{preserving} arms and materials of various types and services. ~~Those~~ ^{regular civilian employees} ~~served with the above-named unit~~ ^{casual employees} and labourers.

On the 1st of May 1945, ~~Trieste was occupied by Jugoslavs~~ ^{occupied Trieste} troops and therefore the premises - offices and workshops belonging to the Directorate of Artillery - On the 15 May 1945, the employees were sent away from the offices by order of the Jugoslavs M. of War but returned again following the agreement of the 12 June 45, when the said premises were occupied by the New Zealand troops, and then, as at present, by the 925 Coy RASC - Rhinoceros.

With this in mind, I will point out the aims laid down for the acid test-party office :

- 10- To liquidate the previous administration : We are re-examining the position of about 200 persons, between civilian clerks and labourers;
20- To provide for the payment of salaries to those having right to them;
30- To reorganize the correspondence left behind in the offices, especially that regarding the personnel;
40- To compile inventories of materials taken away by the Germans and subsequently by the Yugoslavians;
50- To compile inventories of the materials left behind in the offices and stores.
