1. Inclosure #1 hereto is complete list of items currently being shipped to Italian Army by PBS Quartermaster.
2. Inclosure # 2 hereto is DD # 7615 listing the items being shipped to Rome. The balance of the items on Incl # 1 are being shipped to Florence.
3. A further list of Remount Equipment for shipment to Florence will be forwarded when "up-to-date" list is obtained.
4. Shipment commences today to both Florence and Rome. Italian checkers are on hand to check loading and receipt for shipments will be obtained here. Expect to send 5 cars per day to Florence and 8 to 10 per day to Rome. Suggest that if Rome depot cannot handle 8 to 10 cars per day, they make arrangements to re-route the cars to Naples for unloading. PBS is anxious to clear thier depot and go HOME.
