1. The conservation of hard equivalents to fresh items is now of paramount importance and every effort will be made to ensure that issues are reduced to a minimum.

SUBJECT:- Food Rations.

Further to recent alteration brought to the food ration by issuing 200 gms of fresh or frozen meat (bone in) instead of 84 gms of P.Meat, this Ministry instruct that, in order to variate as much as possible the troops' meals, other items in lieu of meat be issued during each fortnight, i.e.:-

- 2 days 60 gms cheese in addition to the 24 gms stated by the scale in force.
- 2 days various items to be bought by units by the allowance of 30 lire per man in addition to the 15 lire for the improvement of meals.

Therefore the troops' food during the fortnight will be as follows:

- 11 days - fresh/frozen meat or p.meat/fish.
- 2 days - cheese
- 2 days - free purchases

Forwarded herewith is the ration scale, to become effective w.e.f.
 1 June 1946.

In order to avoid any errors in interpretation we point out that all rules issued hitherto for the withdrawal of food rations are not altered and the ~~inter~~ foregoing instructions are only an internal matter for the units. They must be distributed to all units and affixed in the "Order of the day" board.
