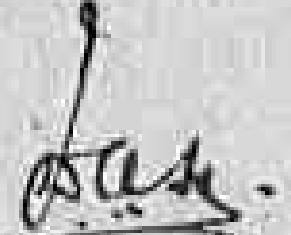

1. Consideration must now be given to a policy to be adopted in the reduction of officers to their War Substantive ranks.
2. Disbandment of units continues, whilst it has been necessary to DOV officers who would otherwise have left the Theatre. This situation will make it increasingly difficult to absorb officers in their temporary ranks.
3. Reduction must be on a Theatre basis by date of seniority subject to the necessity of ensuring that movement of officers and subsequent wastage of their services is reduced to a minimum. The "life" of units and of the officers concerned in this Theatre must also be considered.
4. The following policy is therefore issued for the guidance of DDSST.
 - (i) Reduction from Acting rank to Temporary or War Substantive rank will be effected within commands, e.g. no Acting Major will be offered for absorption by another command.
 - (ii) Where a junior officer due for reduction is in command of a unit which is due for disbandment within six weeks he will be allowed to retain his higher rank until disbandment, even though it may mean the reduction of an officer senior to him. Such officers will revert v.e.f. date of disbandment of the unit. 1228
 - (iii) Reduction should normally be within the type of employment, i.e. Tpt, Sups, POL, Staff.
 - (iv) Bearing in mind the above, DDSST will notify A9 GHQ the name of any officer who is surplus in his Temporary rank. This GHQ will then view the position from the Theatre angle, and
 - (a) decide whether that officer shall be reverted to his War Substantive rank, or

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 - (ii) Where a junior officer due for reduction is in command of a unit which is due for disbandment within six weeks he will be allowed to retain his higher rank until disbandment, even though it may mean the reduction of an officer senior to him. Such officers will revert w.o.f. date of disbandment of the unit. **1248**
 - (iii) Reduction should normally be within the type of employment, i.e. Tpt, Sups, POL, Staff.
 - (iv) Bearing in mind the above, DDsST will notify A9 GHQ the name of any officer who is surplus in his Temporary rank. This GHQ will then view the position from the Theatre angle, and
 - (a) decide whether that officer shall be reverted to his War Substantive rank, or
 - (b) decide by seniority and in consultation with DDsST of other commands which officer shall revert in order that the surplus officer may be absorbed in his higher rank.

(v) In making this decision the following factors will be taken into account:

(a) Whether, because of the continued run-down of the Theatre, the surplus officer is likely to retain his higher rank for six weeks. If, within this period, his seniority is likely to be eligible for reduction,

he will be ordered to revert under his present DDST.

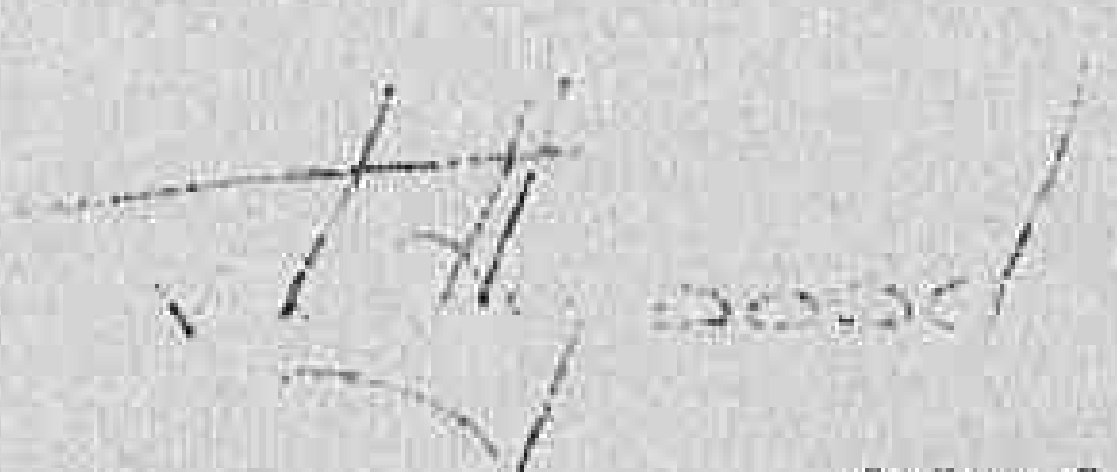
- (b) If the junior officer of the same rank in other formations has a seniority within 4 weeks of the surplus officer, the surplus officer will be ordered to revert in his present command. It will be appreciated that movement of officers to accommodate seniority within narrow limits is not in the interests of the service.

5. It will be the policy that all officers will be treated on an equal basis. Officers on Gentlemen's Agreements or Deferred Operationally Vital, and officers of Other Arms, will be eligible for reversion according to their seniority.

6. The X4a List will not be made use of to preserve the Temporary rank of officers surplus in their higher rank.

7. Officers reverted to lower rank under these instructions will take their place on promotion rosters according to the date of promotion to the lower rank, e.g. an Acting Major who is reverted would take seniority according to his date of Temporary Captain, and a Temporary Major according to his date of War Substantive Captain.

8. Action addressees will forward to this GHQ a nominal roll of Majors under command in seniority according to date of attaining War Substantive, Temporary, and Acting rank of Major. Nominal rolls to reach this GHQ not later than 1 June 46.

1. A.C.I. 311/46 is republished hereunder for information:-

"1. Officers who have been awarded the General Service Medal under Army Order 247 of 1939, and who have not yet received it should write to the Under-Secretary of State, The War Office (A.G. 4 (Medals)), Droitwich, stating the address to which they wish the medal to be sent. Officers serving abroad are strongly advised to nominate a person at home to receive and take charge of the medal.

2. The medals of other ranks have been forwarded to Os. i/c records for disposal to:-

- (a) those still serving at home;
- (b) those discharged or released from the Service;
- (c) the next-of-kin of those who have not lived to receive them.

Applications should NOT be made to the War Office.

Medals of other ranks will not be forwarded to personnel serving overseas but will be held by Os. i/c records until recipients return to the United Kingdom.

3. The medals of other ranks commissioned after the award should be applied for as laid down in para. 1 above."

1. As from today January 16th, Italian drivers will be taken on long distance runs. There is not enough British personnel to deal with the number of long distance demands to be met.
2. The Italian drivers will be entitled to a subsistence allowance of 125 lire per day for the period they are away on detail. No claim for this allowance will be accepted from an Italian driver without an officer's signature confirming it.
3. Officers will be responsible that adequate arrangements are made for Italian civilian drivers when away from Rome.
4. British drivers will only be specially detailed when the officer is not making the return trip with the car and when it would mean an Italian returning alone in a W.D. vehicle.

1. A recent survey of inoculation states has shown that the state of protection amongst officers of this HQ is not in many cases up to the required standards.
2. With the knowledge that cases of smallpox and typhus are being notified in this country, and that the inoculation requirements in personnel returning to UK have been tightened up, it is considered that officers due inoculation and vaccination will wish to remedy the matter.
3. Accordingly arrangements have been made with the British M.I. Room in the basement of this building for officers in need of these inoculations to attend there at 1730 hrs tomorrow 17 Jan. '46, and it is requested that those attending report with their A.B. 439.
4. For information standard requirements are :-
 - i. Vaccination every two years.
 - ii. Tab. and Tetanus inoculations every twelve months.
 - iii. Typhus booster inoculation every six months.

1. The reasons why an American car was instructed by me to take Cpl. BROWN to ROME are as follows.
 - (a)- My FORD-15.cwt, which was originally detailed to take him and his kit on 25 Oct. to ROME, was found not to be road-worthy, and on 25th had to be sent into W/Shops for repairs.
 - (b)- Telephone call on 25th to Camp Commdt's office, ROME, elicited the information that he had to report by the evening of the 26th, at the latest.
 - (c)- Two telephone calls to Lt. RODINO on this subject were made. In the first instance, he was asked to obtain permission to use this car, which in Capt. HAMILTON's absence on leave, was not being used. He stated that he could not authorise it, without the approval of higher authority, and he was then asked to obtain this approval.
 - (d)- In the meantime, MOV. BARI was contacted, but they could offer no transportation, except Rail. As this would have taken at least 2 days, and would have delayed Cpl. BROWN's arrival till after 26th Oct., this method was abandoned. Air Tpt was of necessity out of the question owing to Kit, etc.
 - (e)- A second call to Lt. RODINO was then made to explain the circumstances. He then stated that he personally could not authorise the use of this car, & that he had been unable to contact either Col. KERR or Col. ROSE, but that the authority rested with the Senior IO. Being the only IO available, I therefore authorised it.

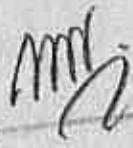

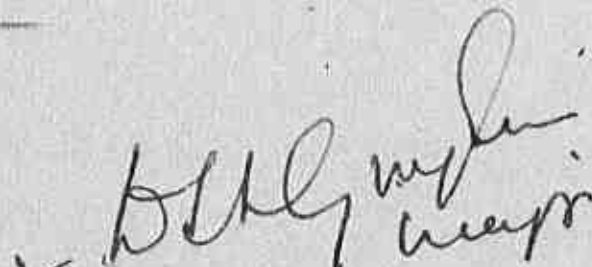

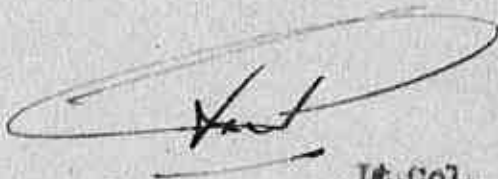

These modifications will appear in the forthcoming ACI.

There are a few operational Commands, mainly in the Pacific in addition to those mentioned above, which will also be included in the ACI.

5. (a) To qualify for the award of the Italy Star, Burma Star, or France and Germany Star recipients must have previously qualified for the 1939/45 Star under either Para 3(a) or (b) above. They then qualify for the appropriate theatre Star by entry into operational service (i.e. service of one day or more in the operational Command).

(b) An exception to the rule stated in (a) above is that individuals who entered into operational service for the first time during the last six months of the war in Europe, will be awarded the Italy and/or France and Germany Star, the prior award of the 1939/45 Star under para 3 (a) or (b) not being required. Such personnel will not be eligible for the award of the 1939/45 Star until they have fulfilled the conditions of para 3 by later service elsewhere.

6. The campaign stars will be worn in the following order of precedence :-

1. 1939/45 Star
2. Atlantic Star
3. Air Crew Europe Star
4. Africa Star
5. Pacific Star
6. Burma Star
7. Italy Star
8. France and Germany Star

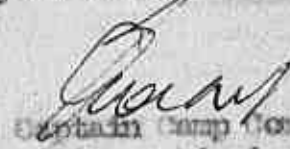
