In the case under reference action was being taken on our letter and NOT until the ruling by telephone was received was it realized that this was in any way the incorrect procedure.

Application is made on behalf of the above-named Officer, for sympathetic consideration for early Release, as soon as possible during the next weeks, on the grounds as stated below.

(a) Details of Service, etc., relevant.

Age: 34 yrs, 9 mths.

A/S. Release Group: 21.

Date of Embarkation Overseas: 13 March, 1945.

NO period of LIAP has been granted.

(b). Domestic.

My father, Rev. E. R. MONCK-MASON, is a retired clergyman, aged 83 years, who lives alone with two elderly ladies, my aunts, the one aged over 70, the other over 85, at 10. Inglis Road, COLCHESTER, Essex. He is in failing health, and extremely deaf, and has repeatedly expressed the hope that I would be able to return as quickly as possible after the cessation of hostilities, in order to discuss family matters and put in order his financial affairs. My younger aunt, referred to above, manages the household, together with intermittent domestic help. The elder aunt is practically an invalid.

I am the only son, with one sister, who is married with two small children, one aged 4 yrs, the other aged 5 months. She, therefore, is unable to look after my father and aunts, as her husband is also, overseas with the R.A.F. in DENMARK.

I have not seen any of these my relations since New Year, 1943, and am informed by my sister that my presence is most urgently required, to sort out family affairs and business matters, for which she has no head. The fact that they had all been led to believe, by Govt. announcements in the Press and elsewhere, that I would be home sometime near the end of November, has undoubtedly come as a bitter shock.

Another factor, which has considerably influenced me to make this application, is that I had hoped to gain the hand of a lady, with whom I have been in the closest correspondence before and during my service overseas. This young lady has waited a long time, and any further deferment for me would naturally be a great disappointment to her and to myself, not to mention the complete disruption of plans made with a view to my anticipated marriage.

(c). Business.

Before the war, I was an Estate Agent. I had not intended to continue in this occupation, having had the offer of a more lucrative job in the commercial world in East Anglia, which would enable me to live at home with my father until such a time as I might get married. This post was offered to me on the assumption that I would commence work at the beginning of January, 1946, at the latest, and I cannot expect it to be kept open for me after that time. Naturally I am extremely anxious not to jeopardise the future and the welfare of my family by losing this appointment.

If necessary, all the above statements can be substantiated and corroborated by the parties concerned.

It is understood that the W/E of 33 Military Mission is being changed, and that possibly certain officers may become surplus to operational requirements.

I therefore respectfully submit this my application for Release.

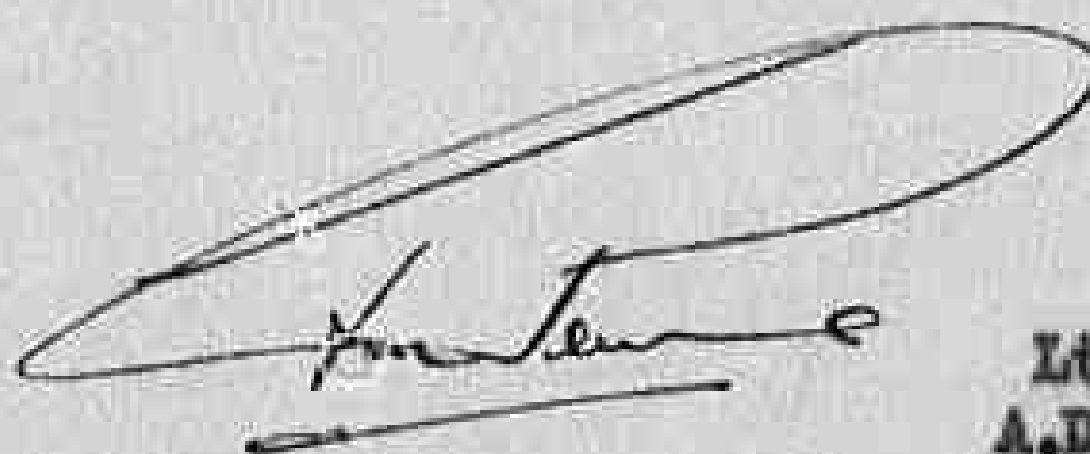
