~~In regard~~ to what was ordered with letter ST/62/10 dated April 5, regarding the supplying of foodstuffs granted for Italian troops to be evacuated from Yugoslavia, we beg you to assign 10,000 lbs. of macaroni, 10,000 lbs. of rice, 12,000 lbs. of canned meat, 1100 lbs. of tomato paste, and to authorize the drawing of 500 kilos of cigarettes and 10,000 boxes of matches.

1. Reference telephone conversation (CURTIS - GURRIS), forwarded herewith is a copy of a letter received from Brig Q (Maint) No. AFHQ/4181/3/ Q (Maint) dated 30 March 1945.
2. As you are aware, 22 G.R.A.S.C. has had instructions to dispatch 25000 rations, approximately to the Italian scale, to Rear HAGNIS. Of these rations, you are to supply ex-Bari Bulk Depot, 25000 x 5 (singles) free type cigarettes and 25000 rations of matches.
3. It will be observed from para 3 of the attached letter that for the purpose of accounting, these supplies will be considered a BR-III commitment and, therefore, it is suggested that the following procedure should be carried out :-
 - (a) Italian Bulk Depot officer signs A.F.G.1033 prepared by 22 G.R.A.S.C. acknowledging receipt of supplies and retains one copy. He should check quantities delivered at quayside.
 - (b) Italian Bulk Depot takes supplies signed for on charge in normal way.
 - (c) L.O. prepares ST/3 (Acceptance Note) which should be signed by Italian officer and L.O. and disposed of in normal manner.

- (b) Italian Bulk Depot takes supplies signed for on charge in normal way.
- (c) L.O. prepares ST/3 (Acceptance Note) which should be signed by Italian officer and L.O. and disposed of in normal manner.
- (d) Prepare ST/8 to clear Depot Accounts.

After the move of the GARIBALDI division from DURROVNIK a considerable number of Italian military stragglers are still congregating there.

It has been ruled that food supplies will be despatched for these personnel. Will you please arrange dispatch of 25,000 rations to approximately the Italian Army scale as early as possible. They should be consigned to Bear MACCIS and MACCIS informed of despatch details.

For the purpose of accounting these supplies will be considered a BR-IFI commitment.
