In reply to ST/19 dated 6 Dec 45.

1. During the alluvion of 29 Oct 45 in GENOA the Food Depot at GENOVE CORNIGLIANO was flooded.

After the inspection carried out by an Analysis Commission some of the commodities stacked therein, among which 79.79 qls of sugar were found damaged and therefore unfit for human or animal consumption. They were considered fit for industrial uses and it was decided to sell them.

2. The selling of the a/m commodities, authorised by dependent Commissariat Directorate in accordance with MMIA LO, took place by invitations sent to all firms concerned in the area and the adjudication has been effected, in accordance with current rules, on 24 Nov 45, at the presence of an appropriate commission and of the representative of State Financial Administration.

3. Since the article published in "IL LAVORO NUOVO" is not exact, the Prefect of GENOA has been asked to intervene in order to obtain the publication of a rectificative article on this matter, recalling the director of the paper to a greater objectiveness in his comments.

The following have been received from our readers:-

Sugar at Black Market Price.

The IVth Section of the Direzione Commissariato of the Military Territorial HQ of Genoa put up for sale large quantities of essential commodities which were damaged during the flood occurred a month ago. It will be a sale by auction, and only a few dealers have been informed through private letter, while it should have been published on the newspapers. What it would happen now is quite clear: those businessmen will purchase such commodities, among which there are 40 quintals of white sugar, of which the population is being without for many months, they will pay an higher price for it in respect to the one paid by the Military Administration, and they will sell it again on the Black Market. In that way a double illegal speculation will be carried out: the first one by the Command who should have given commodities in question to the SEPRAL at an under-cost-price, since it concerns bad items (or at the most at the same cost-price); the second one by the purchasers who, certainly, will not give up the idea of making a good profit out of it. The population will have the worst of it, since they will continue to remain with lean hands but with the consolation to see the candy-stores full of candy, cakes etc.

We are able to document, anyway.

La vendita avverrà all'asta e l'invito è stato diramato a pochi commercianti a mezzo di lettera privata, mentre avrebbe dovuto essere pubblicato sui giornali. È chiaro ciò che succederà: Quei commercianti acquisteranno le predette merci, fra cui figurano 40 quintali di zucchero bianco, pagandolo un prezzo superiore a quello che fu pagato dall'Amministrazione Militare e le rivenderanno alla borsa nera. Verrà così a determinarsi una doppia illecita speculazione: La prima da parte del Comando che avrebbe dovuto cedere le derrate in questione alla Sepral a prezzo di sotto costo, trattandosi di merci avariate, (o tutt'al più allo stesso prezzo); la seconda parte degli acquirenti, che non rinunceranno certo ad un congruo guadagno. Chi ne farà le spese sarà la popolazione, che continuerà a rimanere a bocca asciutta, con la consolazione però di vedere le vetrine dei pasticceri colme di confetti, pasticcini, canditi, ecc. Tanto siamo in grado di documentare.

Subject : Distribution of coffee substitute.

The Allied Sub Commission for the Army, having been informed of the considerable stocks of coffee substitute obtained from the stores of the armed forces of the so-called Social Republic, has instructed that these shall be distributed, until reserves are exhausted, to all the Italian Armed Forces without distinction to the amount of 6 grammes per man per day, in place of an equal quantity of coffee.

In consequence this Ministry has given instructions to that effect and has ordered - in order to hasten its consumption - that the existing quantities of substitute shall be redistributed among all the depots in the northern areas, including those of Leghorn, Florence and Ancona.

While noting the content of the above letter this Ministry regrets that it can not exclude Italian Air Force Units from the distribution, as it is not considered fair that only Army and Navy Units should partake in consuming a supply of this kind, since also the latter have been subjected to restrictions similar to those suffered by Air Force units in order to liquidate stocks in their own depots.

As a result of agreements reached with Lt.Col. PENROSE, it was fixed that the following stocks should be held in the various sectors (excluding the islands and Calabria).

- Bulk Depot 30 days reserve and 15 days for distribution
- Distribution Depots 15 days reserve and 15 days for distribution

In the northern sectors the above stocks have not yet been constituted, thus making some uncertainty as regards the regular supplying of rations.

In some sectors, such as Leghorn, the situation is even more precarious, since the 7th Bulk Depot is not yet operating. For safety reasons its stocks have to be stored with Distribution Depots under its command.

We therefore ask MMIA to kindly examine the possibility of constituting the authorised stock holdings in every sector, so that the necessary stability may be given to the service - which is indispensable on account of the difficult transport situation.

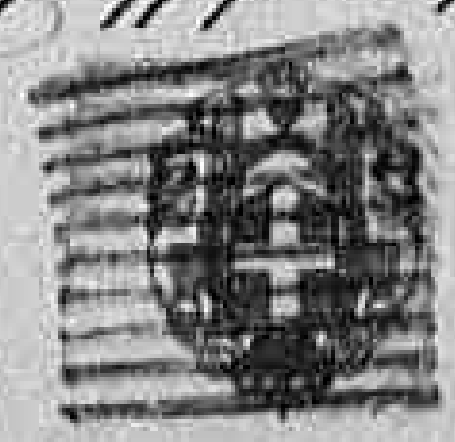

During inspections carried out by MMIA's officers it appeared that at the Bulk Distribution Depots in the NAPLES, BARI, TARANTO, SICELY, FLORENCE and ROME areas, and at Unit Depots there are considerable stocks of dehydrated vegetables exceeding normal requirements.

This is due to the fact that a/m vegetables have not been withdrawn by the units and that the units who withdraw some vegetables do not eat them, probably because these foodstuffs are not appreciated by the soldiers.

In order to avoid a waste of foodstuffs and *unnecessary* expenses to the Italian Government MMIA have asked the Military Administration if they intend or not to continue to withdraw dehydrated Allied vegetables or if it is possible to improve the taste of these items by a different way of cooking.

Before answering to a/m Authority we beg the units to whom this letter is addressed to give us their opinion on the matter.

It should borne in mind:-

1. that suggestions concerning the cooking of dehydrated vegetables (particularly carrots) that do not suit the taste of the Italian soldiers, are contained in circ. 11750/S/1 dated 28/10/44 (copy attached), addressed to FLORENCE, BOLOGNA, MILAN, UDINE, BOLZANO, TURIN, GENOVA, Military HQs and Commissariat Directorates under Command.
2. that no other item will be supplied by the Allied Authorities to replace dehydrated vegetables if these vegetables are no longer withdrawn.
3. that in view of a future reduction of the British ration also the Italian rations could be reduced: anyhow this reduction would probably affect some items other than dehydrated vegetables.

During my recent tour of Bulk and Distribution Depots in the Areas, Naples, Bari, Taranto, Sicily, Florence and Rome, and on inspection of certain unit ration stores, I am convinced that, either Dehydrated Vegetables are surplus to your requirements or, that insufficient trouble has been taken to experiment in palatable dishes, and in turn to demonstrate to units how to use this valuable food.
2. Whilst there is no alternative to offer to this portion of the ration scale, to avoid waste and expense to the Italian Government, will you state as to whether you would like to withdraw all Dehydrated Vegetables, or, alternatively, propose to put some system into operation to ensure that they are made palatable and consumed.
3. It should be born in mind that as a reduction is contemplated in the British Army ration scale, a similar reduction may be found necessary in Italian Army scale. But the cut, if any, would probably be in some other commodity.
