NAPLES Comm/to Directorate informs this Office that, because of the recent interruption of the railway line normally used for the supply of food to ROME, the dail despatch of food to the said place has been stopped while awaiting the repair of the line itself, a repair that seems to be foreseen only on 29 Jan. 45.

As the availability of the items at the ROME D.I.D. and particularly that of flour, is very nearly exhausted, will you please give urgent instructions to your Movements bodies so that sufficient amounts of food, particularly flour, be made to arrive at the ROME D.I.D. in any way, using, if necessary, the other railway line that functions between NAPLES and ROME, or authorising SMRE-Services Office- to give the vehicles asked for by ROME Territorial H.Q. for the road transport of the flour.

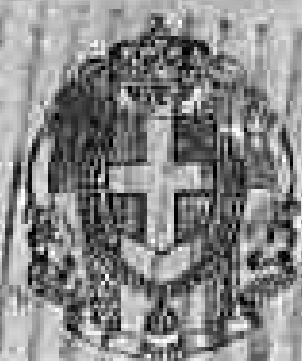
The same thing will have to be done for the supply of the PALIDORO D.I.D..
