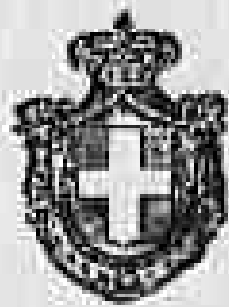

Ref our 16233 /S/1, dated 3 Sept 1945, we inform you that, notwithstanding the action taken by MMIA and the fact that in our letter 17312 of the 22 Sept we told the Ministry of Transport of the decisions made by AFHQ, The Compartimento of State Railways at Bari has not allocated the cistern wagons for transporting wine to depots in the North.

337
Furthermore, the Bari Commissariato Directorate informed us by signal (copy attached) that supplies of wine do not come to depots in Central and Southern Italy with the necessary punctuality, since the Bari Railway Compartimento always allocates a number of wagons less than that requested. For the period 24 - 30 September, out of the 27 cistern wagons requested by us in the movements bid, only 12 wagons were allocated.

If the transportation of wine to the North continues to be hindered and the number of wagons requested weekly to be reduced, the supply of wine in general cannot be assured, resulting in grave damage and discontent among the troops who see themselves deprived of a necessary commodity, particularly now that the cold months approach.

In order to assure the above supplies we ask MMIA to kindly see that the Military Administration receives the 40 wagons weekly which correspond to its effective requirements, and also to see that the wine is sent up to the North as quickly as possible in the cistern wagons.

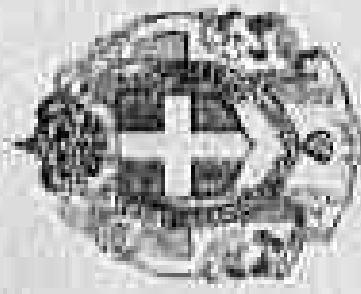

SUBJECT:- Cistern wagons for sending wine to the North.

Regarding our letter 16233/S/1 of 3 Sept, concerning the availability of cistern wagons for transporting wine to the North, we inform you that the Allied Command has confirmed the necessity for such transport and has directed that all cistern wagons used for this must be returned without fail to the original depots, this is to supply wine regularly to Italian units in the north.

In order to facilitate their return it would be opportune to place labels on the wagons, showing where they must be sent back.

We therefore ask you to see that the Bari Compartimento Ferrowiario satisfies all requests made by the Bari Commissariato for the above transport, within the authorised limit of 40 wagons weekly, taking into account the fact this is an urgent matter in order to assure a continuous supply of wine to the North.

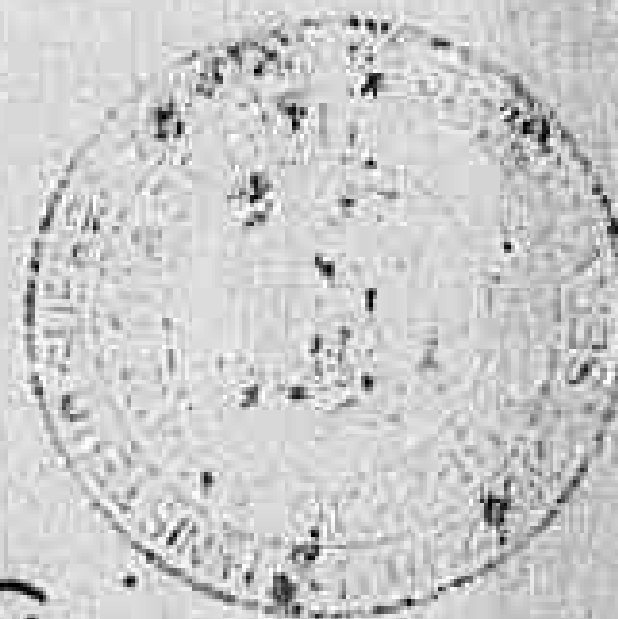

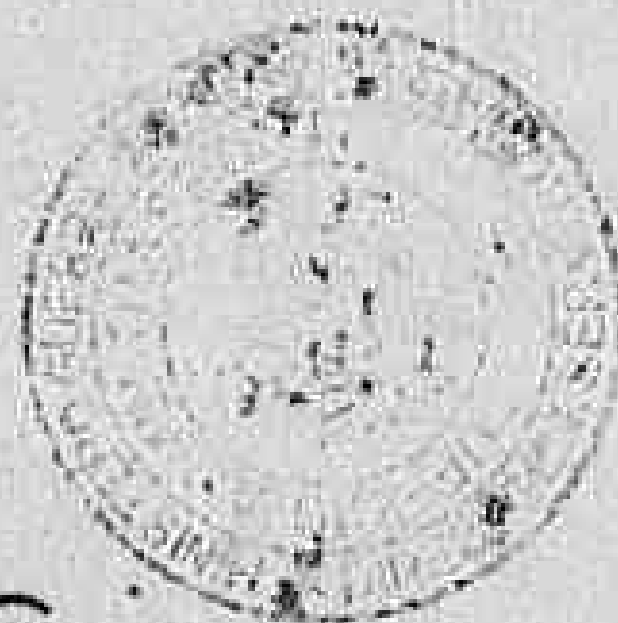

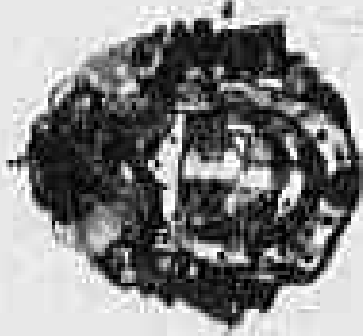

Ref phonogram 2928-T dated 28 Aug, owing to the fact that this Ministry has no trace of any agreements having been reached with MMIA, I inform you that during last month, from 23rd July to 26th August, 131 cistern wagons have been put at the disposal of Italian Military Authorities for transporting wine from PUGLIE, which is a very high figure in respect of the availability of such type of wagons ~~and of requests of such type of wagons~~ and of requests either by Allied Authorities or by others.

SUBJECT:- Cistern Wagons for supplying wine in North Italy.

Bari Commissariat Directorate has announced that it is impossible to send wine in cistern wagons to Distribution Depots in the North, since the General Directorate of State Railways does not allocate wagons for such transportation.

In reply to the letter from us, the General Directorate of State Railways, has said that only practical difficulties prevent this transportation taking place, since once the cistern wagons arrive in the North, where there are no laws of requisition and where the General Directorate has no authority at all, they are not returned to the original depots but are used for other purposes.

Naturally, the failure to return these wagons results in a gradual reduction of their availability in the South, thereby increasing the difficulties of transporting wine.

In order to ensure continuity of supplies, we ask MMIA to give appropriate orders to units under its command, in order that all cistern wagons used for transporting wine to distribution depots in the North should be returned to the original depots at once.

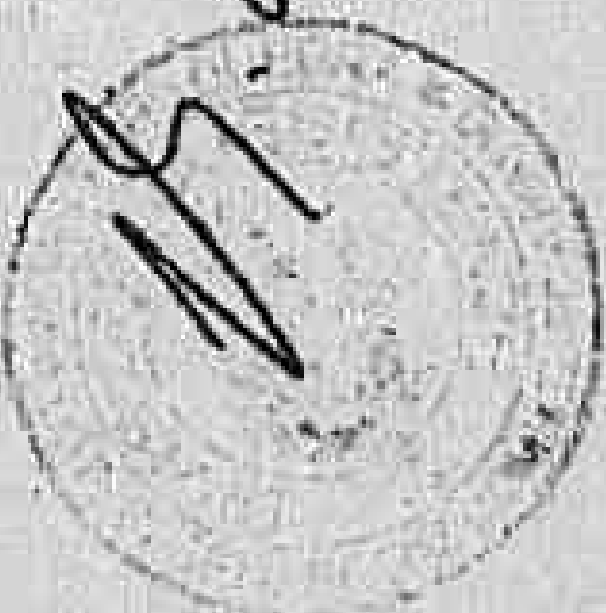

- Considering that the wine production of Sardinia is insufficient to supply the island's interior requirements, the wine needed by the troops stationed there was supplied in the past by Naples Special Food Depot;

- When M.M.I.A. order, regarding the stoppage of shipping from the ~~mainland~~ ²⁴³ arrived, (Letter ST/63 dated 26 March 1945), instructions were temporarily issued so that the supply of wine to the units and organisations in Sardinia, was carried out by local ~~purchase~~ ^{Purchase}, by Cagliari Commissionariat Section.

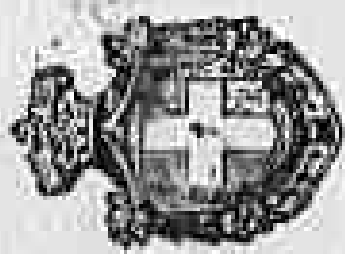
- In order that the soldier may be at all times regularly supplied with his ration of wine, corps and units have been granted the authority, furthermore to buy the wine from the local trade at the prices prevailing locally, should military depots be at any time out of stock of said commodity.

- The payment of the quota in cash is only foreseen in exceptional cases when for instance the wine is not available in the depot, and the corps are unable to purchase it on the market.

- Immediate investigations have been ordered, to find out the reasons which hindered the application of the Ministry directives, and we will inform you of the result of said investigations.

- In as much as the near future is concerned, we believe that the ~~483~~ ⁴⁸⁹ matter could be solved by:

a) increasing when possible the agreed purchases, not being advisable to carry out requisitions, in as much as said measure will bring the concealment of wine and will thus reduce the limited availability for the civilian population, without reckoning that the said measure could be hindered by the local Civilian authorities.

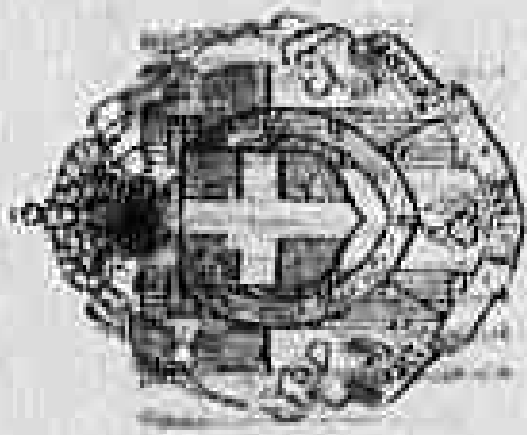

1. MIA IO SARDINIA has advised this Headquarters that the wine ration is not being made available to troops in SARDINIA.
2. An inspection of the 59th Infantry Regiment on 17 Aug indicated that the unit was receiving one (1) litre of wine per week (representing two days' ration) and fifteen (15) lire per day monetary allowance for remaining five (5) days. A similar situation exists for all units in SARDINIA.
3. It was further reported that the average price per litre of wine in SARDINIA is sixty (60) lire.
4. It is obvious from the above that the War Ministry has not complied with its responsibility of supplying the established ration of wine.
5. This situation can not be tolerated.
6. Your alternatives are:
 - a. increase monetary allowance for purchase of wine in order that each soldier will receive his full entitlement of one half litre daily;
 - b. procure, by requisition, sufficient wine on the Island;
 - c. arrange shipment of wine from the Mainland or Sicily to meet requirements.
7. Failure to make wine available to your troops is a failure of contract to comply with the provisioning of your portion of the ration.

3. Commissary Section Sardinia informed us that Ministry of War directed them to ship to mainland the 350 unusable barrels as well as the 200 usable.

3. By 1st Indorsement of 31 March 1945 to your ST/63 to Ministry of War, subject Shipment of Wine to Sardinia from Mainland, dated 28 March we forwarded same to Commanding General Italian Forces in Sardinia for information and necessary action, on 31 March 1945.

4. Inspecting the 59th Infantry Regiment 17 August, I discovered that they issue 1 litre of wine per week or for 2 days, and 15 lire per day monetary allowance for other 5 days. The average price for wine is 30 lire per litre, therefore for 5 days per week they only have sufficient money to buy $\frac{1}{2}$ the amount allotted. I advised them that the men were entitled to $\frac{1}{2}$ litre per day.
