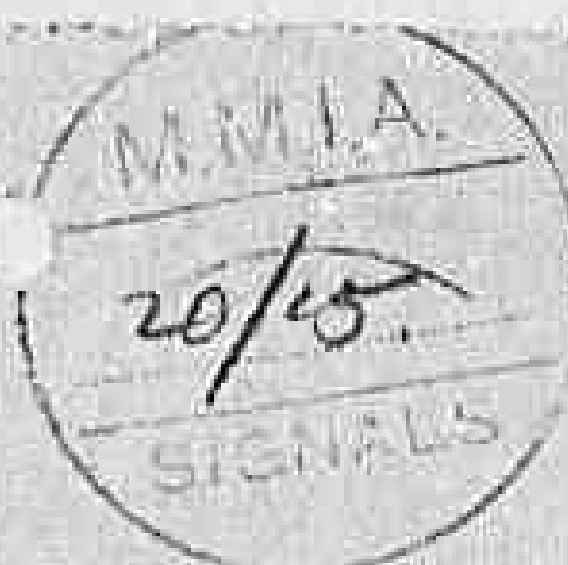

With the liberation of northern Italy the strength of Partisans to be fed is continuously increasing.

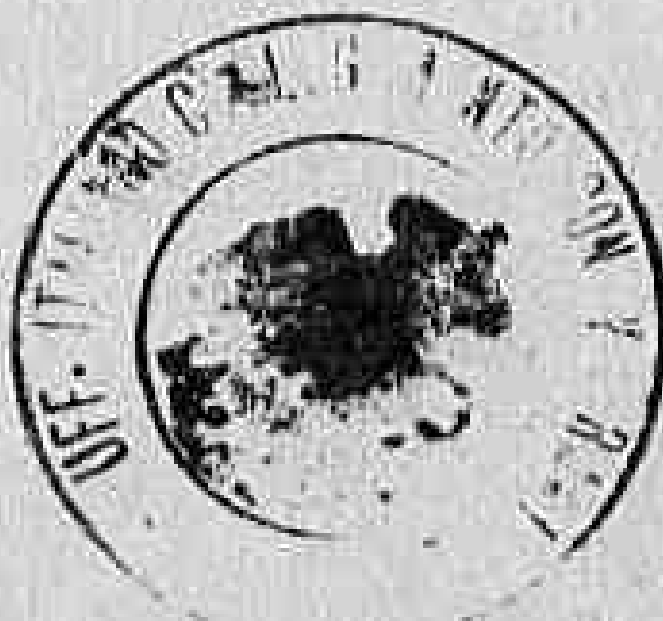

With 210th Division request of additional items for May maintenance 2000 daily rations for Partisans were already included.

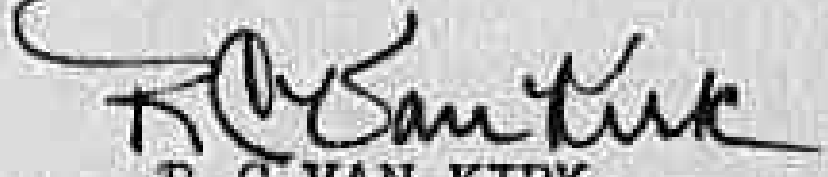

1 (a) (i) Naples reports that NO soap has been issued from Italian depots for 240th Div, and NO demands for soap have been received by Naples office from P.B.S.

Presumption is that 5th Army have been issuing soap from their own stocks.

Is it desired S2T assume responsibility for provision and distribution of soap, which is a British Ordnance responsibility? This fact is reason for my scanty knowledge of the matter.

(ii) Cigarettes have been demanded by 5th Army to P.B.S. and have been released from Italian Depots at Naples to P.B.S. for forward shipment. I am checking quantities actually released and will report further.

1 (b) (i) Stocks in Naples at 28 Oct were 10,695 kilos of cigarettes and tobacco combined.

(ii) I have no knowledge of soap stocks, nor have Cominsarinto at Ministry of War as this item is handled by another Department.

1 (c) I have no knowledge of these arrangements. Items are released to P.B.S. on demand and all subsequent arrangements are made by that HQ. Statement is not entirely correct.

2. About 2500 Forms K were despatched to Delegazione 'I' through MIA Signals Office on 13 Oct 44. Signals DR's Docket No 5 refers. These were received by Signals RA40 at 1312 hrs same day and received and signed for by Delegazione 'I' on 17 Oct.

3. Traced as above, but suggest Major van Kirk in best position to determine whether Delegazione 'I' have distributed to units of 240 Div. Forms K have been received from 5th Army however, so it would seem units are in possession.
