Subject : Provisions for Naval Units in transit in Sardinia.

1. With reference to your letter No. HSC/2924 of 12th July last, forwarded herewith are copies of the communications received from Maricomai La Maddalena, from which it appears that the M.M.I.A. in Cagliari not only requires to give prior authorisation for every issue of provisions to warships in transit at Sardinian Ports but also gives notice that in future approval will be given only in cases of emergency.
2. Since one of the principal reasons for authorising I.R.N. Provision Stores to hold a reserve stock is to make possible the provisioning of naval vessels in transit it would be appreciated if the Navy Sub Commission would take up the matter with the M.M.I.A. in order to obtain the withdrawal of the restrictions imposed by the M.M.I.A. Office at Cagliari, thereby avoiding the resulting inconveniences and the delay which may be caused in the ships' itineraries.
3. In respect of the above it is considered desirable to observe that the provisioning of vessels in transit is a normal occurrence, and not an emergency, since those ships in particular which have no store of provisions being authorised to retain on board only the stock necessary for their time at sea, must necessarily embark provisions in other ports than that on which they are based and on the victualling estimates of which they are normally included.
4. On the other hand, in the following fortnight the base to which their provisions are allocated deducts those stores which were not issued to the ship owing to its sailing, and thus does not form a surplus reserve which it is not permitted.

With reference to the Ministry of Marine's letter No. SM. 21223 dated 27th September, 1945, owing to the shortage of shipping, there are no ample facilities for the shipment of food to Sardinia. To offset this, a strict control has been instituted to curtail the issuance of food rations in Sardinia as much as possible, and it is considered that the Italian Royal Navy could materially assist if Italian warships calling at Sardinian ports, whilst reserving the right to draw rations in cases of emergency only, did not draw provisions there, but obtained a sufficient quantity of victuals for the round trip from the mainland.

2. The procedure for the issue of allied rations to Italian warships in transit at Sardinian ports is followed by the Military Mission Italian Army Liaison Officer, Sardinia, therefore, has the approval of the Land Forces Sub Commission (M.M.I.A.) and the full concurrence of the Navy Sub Commission, Allied Commission, observing that the period a ship is away from the mainland on a trip to Sardinia, is normally under a week, for which rations can easily be ~~had~~ <sup>148</sup> obtained in Italy, thereby avoiding any delay that may be incurred in sailing the ship should she have to draw rations, and obviating any further accounting mentioned in paragraph 4 of the Ministry of Marine's letter under reference.

1. Enclosed herewith by Appendix "A" is a report of rations received on the S/S Abkhazia 16 October 1945.

2. Your attention is invited to the fact that the amounts reported by Naples Bulk Depot Escort was not the same as shown by signal 228 STW/23 from M.M.I.A. LO Naples dated 16 October 1945.

*Mol 100% 14.*  
 3. A large number of cartons were broken in the ship, before unloaded, especially the fish items. There was a great leakage in barrels of wine and many were only partially filled, a few barrels had large holes in them.

4. There was some looting on the dock here of meat and fish at night time after unloaded due to the Italian Military Guards not performing their duty. This matter was brought to the attention of the Commanding General, Italian Forces in Sardinia for disciplinary action.

5. Your attention is invited to notes in Appendix "A" regarding cartons containing stones. It is not probable that this could have been done enroute by sea.

6. A representative from this office was at the dock during *27/10* the unloading and at the depot during the weighing.

SUBJECT:- Supplies to SARDINIA.

As you know, the sea movements bids for the supply of commodities to SARDINIA, as you instructed, are forwarded every 10 days for each 10 days period. Therefore 3 requests are forwarded in each month.

While transport to SARDINIA, which has become normal by now, is made with ships running a fortnightly service with departures on the 15 and 30 of each month.

The fact that the request periods do not agree with the actual despatch periods has made it several times to cumulate in one despatch the despatches requested for in 2 consecutive 10 days periods, with subsequent increase of work and difficulties of ~~prompt~~ transport of commodities for shipment due to the bad situation of vehicles at the disposal of the NAPLES Commissariat. Besides that it also happens that not all the supplies can be loaded, due to the limited shipping space allotted.

In order to ease the work of the above mentioned Commissariat Directorate it would be necessary that the movements bids be forwarded fortnightly 12 days before the actual despatch, that is the 3rd and the 18th of each month, as shown in the attached.

1. MILIA LO SARDINIA has advised this Headquarters that the wine ration is not being made available to troops in SARDINIA.
2. An inspection of the 59th Infantry Regiment on 17 Aug indicated that the unit was receiving one (1) litre of wine per week (representing two days' ration) and fifteen (15) lire per day monetary allowance for remaining five (5) days. A similar situation exists for all units in SARDINIA.
3. It was further reported that the average price per litre of wine in SARDINIA is sixty (60) lire.
4. It is obvious from the above that the War Ministry has not complied with its responsibility of supplying the established ration of wine.
5. This situation can not be tolerated.
6. Your alternatives are:
  - a. increase monetary allowance for purchase of wine in order that each soldier will receive his full entitlement of one half litre daily;
  - b. procure, by requisition, sufficient wine on the Island;
  - c. arrange shipment of wine from the Mainland or Sicily to meet requirements.
7. Failure to make wine available to your troops is a failure of contract to comply with the provisioning of your portion of ~~the~~ <sup>2/4</sup> Division.

To compliance with instructions received, we certify you that the items unloaded from the above vessel were escorted by Capt. Georges Faureau of the 700th Supply Unit of AFAC.

The discrepancies between what was manifested and actually received are the following:

The personnel on ship when the items were loaded in Lusaka made the following petitions which received 2386. One box of flour had two missing, one flour sack with holes, was half of flour not full. He presented the proper documents but stated that the sacks were packed in boxes or bags and not by weight. The unloading of the flour was checked without intervention by Capt. Georges Faureau. The flour and other supplies were weighed at the port and were rechecked after arrival. The flour was unloaded and loaded on trucks and transported to the depots where the weight was checked and marks remaining on the bags were accurately matched to the proper box and truck marking sufficient so as to be accurately matched in the process of unloading and checked the same from Lusaka. The following officers and the escort who came from Lusaka, the following were found:

Vlours:- A shortage of 123.002 kgs due to holes in 54 sacks and to 150 sacks which had been damaged and caused again by hand. In these sacks there was a shortage of 360 kgs of flour.

Coconuts:- Shortage of 223.271 kgs due to differences of weight in the manifests. Shortage of 923.271 kgs due to differences of weight in the sacks received all manifested apparently intact except those which were not completely full. These were about 122.004 kgs of coconuts.

The escort could not be blamed for the shortages because he had made notes on the manifest of the above conditions of the sacks.



Regarding signal M.M.I.A. Sardinia about the load of foodstuffs on  
S.S. Campidoglio, I beg to inform what follows:-

1. The integrity of packs moved from Deposito Speciale Viveri for shipping is carefully checked by the personnel of the same Depot. Same verification is carried out by the escort personnel encharged for the movement from the Depot to the Port, they refuse to receive any pack which is not in perfect condition. The third control is carried out by Ufficio Imbarchi e Sbarchi, by the personnel of the ship, whose Captain has signed the Bill of Loading without reserves.
2. In consideration of that above, there is no doubt that the packs loaded on Campidoglio, have been consigned to the ship in perfect condition, without holes or losses, and if there have been found losses and pilferages on the arrival, they have been carried out by accident or by fraud during the unloading and stowing operations.
3. Sestiere Commissario di Cagliari has only reported the condition in which they received the foodstuffs, without undertaking any proper ascertainment in order to settle the responsibilities of the Captain of the ship.
4. In para 3 we have dealt with; Dried Vegetables, Rice and Macaroni.
5. Regarding Coffee we point out that a deficiency of 446 lbs equal to 202.038 kilos must only have been caused by pilferage or many sacks. That would explain the statement that "almost all sacks are not well closed on the top, so that there is a loss". These losses have not been noticed whilst loading, and all operations were normally carried out without any complaint on behalf of the agents encharged for the movement to and for the reception on the ship.
6. Regarding the pack of Meat Extract we confirm that Deposito Speciale Viveri has actually loaded an original pack of 2/4 items by 48 lbs, and not a pack of Corned Beef. This is confirmed by Lieut. Sontorelli who has personally attended to the delivery. In this regard we point out that the weights of the various types of cases of Corned Beef available at Deposito Viveri are the following - 36 lbs, 24 lbs, 40 lbs, 72 lbs. Consequently even the possibility of a material mistake of Deposito Viveri, sending a case of Corned Beef by 48 lbs (which they did not have) instead of one of

This is confirmed by Lieut. Santorilli who has weights of the various types of cases of Corned Beef available at Deposito Viveri are the following - 36 lbs, 24 lbs, 40 lbs, 72 lbs. Consequently even the possibility of a material mistake of Deposito Viveri, sending a case of Corned Beef by 48 lbs (which they did not have) instead of one of Meat Extract of the same weight, is to be excluded.

7. From that clearly explained in para 6 we suspect that all deficiencies noticed on the arrival of the ship, are due to some facts happened after the loading of the foodstuffs and anyway after the signature of the Bill of Lading, the Loading Unit (Deposito Speciale Viveri) is no more responsible for the quantities shown in the same Bill.

This Directorate, on the basis of information received from the 500th Bulk Depot and from the Military Office for Embarkation and Disembarkation can only confirm the amounts shown in our 10674/1 of 6/5/45 as being <sup>sent</sup> to Sardinia on S/S Samleyte.

The rice - 65 sacks of 50 lbs - was sent to the port on the truck N.R. 3661, (ticket number 2006) at 20.45 hrs on the 27 February, and during the night it was loaded on board and placed in hold number 4 under the supervision of the Office for Embarkation and Disembarkation.

As for the flour, 22 trucks were used - ticket numbers 1960 to 1981 of the 27 Feb - for a total of 5924 sacks at 100lbs each. Under the supervision of the same office the sacks were loaded on board on the night of 27th/28th Feb and during the day of the 28th, and put in hold no 4.

The office did not have time to give the shipping documents to the escort, since the ship left too soon and before the time arranged, but instead in an urgentissimo signal it informed Cagliari Transportation Delegation of the arrival of the goods, showing the number of bales sent for each item.


