




The information given is much appreciated.

As the Medical Directorate at the War Ministry do not concern themselves in the subject of ambulance transport, a reply to the queries raised in the above quoted letter is based entirely on personal opinion.

It is considered that:

1. An M.A.C. of two platoon convoy strength (50 ambulance cars) is more than adequate for the needs of the Interim Army.
2. A half platoon of ambulance cars with each Division is very adequate ambulance car cover in consideration of present commitments.

It is believed that control of the ambulance cars on loan to D.P.&S.C. will pass to the Ufficio Autonomi Reduci Prig. di Guerra of the Italian War Ministry on 1 Jan. 46 with the handover of certain commitments from the one to the other on this date.
