SUBJECT:- Alpini Auxiliary Troops.

In our 17060/Ord/1 dated 23 Sept 45, it was proposed that the three Territorial Brigades of Turin, Bolzano and Udine should be composed of Alpini.

In view of the particular conditions in which these units will be located, it would be necessary to allocate a certain number of mules - both for normal supply requirements, and for transporting arms, munitions and materials.

Therefore, in compliance with the request of M.M.I.A. it is proposed to form a W.E. for an auxiliary pack unit to be attached to the W.E. of each brigade.

The W.E. of these units would be as per attached and they could be formed into the following units :-

- 266 Pack Tpt Coy
- 267 Pack Tpt Coy
- 268 Pack Tpt Coy.

Each of these has a W.E. (CM/800/1) of :-

- 10 Officers
- 485 N.C.Os and ORs
- 320 mules
- 22 horses.

which could be amplified in time so as to equal the numbers shown on the proforma attached.

The proposed W.E. differs from CM/800/1 in that the pack Tpt Coy as above could be used for supplying various units without specific reference to a particular War establishment and for a temporary situation caused by the War.

The formation of these units would be necessary to ensure the permanent self-sufficiency of these Alpine Units in mountainous areas, both as regards supplies and arms and ammunition.

The personnel required will naturally be taken out of the total ceiling authorised for the Italian Army.
