Subject: INEFFICIENT VEHICLES.

To: Repairs Direction of Comando Territoriale - Naples

Information to : M.M.I.A. - L.O. - Naples

I, Capt. VOLPATI GEROLAMO, Director of the 2nd Mobile Park and ex-Director of Laboratorio Principale del 1 Parco Mobile at Abbasanta up to 26 April 1945, referring to the complains about the inefficiencies of the vehicles arrived from Sardinia to 2nd Repairs Unit in Naples, I wish to point out the following:

- (a) - all vehicles dumped in Laboratorio Principale of 1st Mobile Park at Abbasanta (Cagliari-Sardinia) or in workshops depending from it, have been put in perfect efficiency of work, and properly tested.
This may be confirmed by 5th E.V.P. of Cagliari, receiving Unit which had to provide for the subsequent shipping to Mainland.
- (b) - Tyres were so particularly attended to, that they might guarantee a life from a minimum of 5 to 6000 Km. Tyres not corresponding to this require were definitely changed. I also point out that, being afraid the tyres might be substituted after the efficient vehicle left the Workshop, I ordered on about 1st March to record the Nos. of tyres for each vehicle and to hand the record over the receiving Unit (5th E.V.P.) for any inspection.

Besides that, M.M.I.A. Officer (Maj. HALL previously and Maj. AUSTIN after), who was permanently at the Workshop of the Park, personally used to inspect the vehicles in all details before the shipping.

Lately only, owing to shortage of materials and spare-parts we had to:

- (1) - reduce to a minimum of 70% the required efficiency in the revision and in the setting of the fuel injection pumps.
- (2) - ship some vehicles either without batteries or with batteries not completely efficient, and without bulbs. Anyway the electric plant was completely inspected and efficient.

I ensure, however, that the vehicles moved always from Abbasanta-Park to Cagliari (Km. 130) on their own power and that was a second test of the vehicle.

Referring to situation herewith enclosed, about 15 vehicles coming from Sardinia and dumped in this Park by 1st I.V.P. for repairs, I beg to inform:

- from a/m situation it appears in a very clear way that the nature of inefficiencies is due mostly to incidents while loading and unloading the vehicles from the ship. About this matter, I have been personally present to such operations while I was transferring to Mainland, and I noticed that the personnel doing the work of loading stowing and unloading at Cagliari and Naples Docks, do not do their job properly and carefully as it is necessary. I myself, on 7 May night, was compelled to intervene and have the hooking for unloading done by my own personnel, to avoid further damages, being the civilian gang for that work, composed mostly with boys from 15 up to 17 years old incompetent and negligent.

- regarding the mechanical inefficiencies found out by 2nd Repairs Unit about the a/m vehicles when arriving to the Park, I can only inform that:

- (1) whilst dumped at 5th Repairs Unit of Cagliari the vehicles were used for various duties: (transport re-called personnel from Centri Raccolta - transport of material...)
- (2) almost all vehicles lately arrived from Sardinia and drawn from the Docks by 2nd Repairs Unit, Capt. BORSO being present, got to the destination Park on their

own power.

The only complain was that some vehicles started being towed, owing to the above mentioned inefficiency of batteries.

However, to avoid the most part of the troubles already exposed, I think it is wise that each vehicle leaving the 5th Park of Cagliari be escorted by a clever driver who, besides looking after the vehicle during the operations of loading, unloading and stowing, attends also the movement from the Docks to the receiving Unit and its proper delivery to the same Unit.

FOR: Land Forces Sub-Commission.

1. Reference is made to your AG/5 dated 5 October 1944, requesting early allocation of shipping to move Italian Army MT vehicles and stores from CAGLIARI, Sardinia, to NAPLES.
2. This problem has again been examined by the Movement and Transportation section of this headquarters, who agree to the provision of shipping for this purpose.
3. However, the port capacity of CAGLIARI is at present fully occupied and does not permit the positioning of a ship for loading the vehicles, according to priority list 7, until approximately 1 November 1944.
4. On or about 1 November it is possible to provide one ship to load 150 vehicles, and additional ships later to effect the clearance of these urgently required vehicles.
5. This headquarters will keep you informed as, and when, additional shipping becomes available for these vehicles.

1. This letter confirms arrangements made in Naples reference above.
2. Vehicles are expected to arrive recently in Naples in U.S. Headquarters approximately in accordance with list attached (H.S. this list was provided by Major MURPHY from General Sordani and having been made out ~~by~~ loading was completed, vehicles eventually arriving may be different).
3. As agreed with Capt. Thrupp, national vehicles in the list assigned to stored national units for which MILA Naples has received specific destinations will remain in possession of the units concerned and subsequently proceed with the units to destination. These vehicles will be staged either at General MURPHY or at Afragola Camp as Capt. Thrupp may decide.
4. If any national vehicles arrive in U.S. Headquarters not attached to specific units, they will be taken into Naples Munitions Park (see para 7 following) pending further instructions.
5. Non-national vehicles arriving in U.S. Headquarters irrespective of whether assigned to stored units or not will be frozen, and turned into Naples Munitions Park, except that as provided in M/5 of 18 Aug 41, stored units will be allowed to retain such vehicles as are necessary for their minimum housekeeping needs. Power of decision on this point is vested in MILA 10, Naples.
6. The Bridging Workshop and the two Artillery Workshops in list attached (Serials 100 and 167) will probably constitute special cases not susceptible of treatment as under para 5. When it is known exactly what personnel and vehicles have arrived against these serials, details should be reported by telephone to MILA, MILA for immediate clearance and decision with other

2. Vehicles are expected to arrive presently in Naples in 3.3. RECONSTRUCTION units in accordance with list attached (N.B. this list was provided by Major MARCHELLI from Comando Sardegna and having been made out ~~there~~ loading was completed, vehicles eventually arriving may be different).
3. As agreed with Capt Turry, national vehicles in the list assigned to formed medical units for which MIA Naples has received specific destinations will remain in possession of the units concerned and subsequently proceed with the units to destination. These vehicles will be staged either at Genoa FALMARE or at Afragola Camp as Capt Turry may decide.
4. If any national vehicles arrive in 3.3. RECONSTRUCTION not attached to specific units, they will be taken into Naples Runners' Park (see para 7 following) pending further instructions.
5. Non-national vehicles arriving in 3.3. RECONSTRUCTION irrespective of whether assigned to formed units or not will be frozen, and turned into Naples Runners' Park, except that as prescribed in 4.5 of 18 Aug 44 formed units will be allowed to retain 'such vehicles as are necessary for their minimum housekeeping needs'. Power of decision on this point is vested in MIA 16, Naples.
6. The Bridging Workshop and the two Artisan Workshops in list attached (Serials 180 and 167) will probably constitute special cases not susceptible of treatment as under para 5. When it is known exactly what personnel and vehicles have arrived against these serials, details should be reported by telephone to MIA, MIA for immediate clearance and decision with other MIA staff officers affected. Both the personnel and vehicles concerned should be immobilized at Naples pending receipt of final instructions.
7. Responsibility for ascertainment of the arrival and berthing of 3.3. RECONSTRUCTION was agreed to lie with Capt. MARCHELLI Italian Army Identification and Identification Office Naples Port (tel: 54607). On receipt of this information Capt MARCHELLI will immediately inform MIA Naples and ~~the~~ appropriate personnel MIA Naples (tel: 53520).
8. MIA Naples Office concerned with distribution of vehicles and delivery to Park will be Capt MADE. Italian Army Ordnance concerned are Lt. Col. BORGARINO commanding 10 Autieri and Lt. P. AQUINO operating the Park for 10 Autieri.
9. MIA Naples and 10 Autieri will each arrange for checkers from their respective offices to list the vehicles: (a) discharged from duty (b) delivered into Park.

10. 10 Autieri will be responsible for 201 at shipside.
11. 10 Autieri will be responsible for drivers to move vehicles from docks to Park. MILA Naples will in addition arrange for any drivers on hand at Afragola Camp to be pressed into service on temporary detail.
12. The Naples Runners' Park will be located in Caserta CANARULLA, Via Carabinieri, Rione Duca d'Aosta, Fiumi Crotto. This is a walled and guarded compound (former Italian barracks) of large area, of which a small section is at present occupied by Coy B 367 Engineers PBL, 9 1/2 Coy Capt GARDNER (tel: 14284). One of the spaces concerned for parking Italian vehicles was authorized by PBL on application by MILA 15 Naples, and arranged in detail on the site between Coy GARDNER - Capt 24241 - Major Papinesse on 15 Oct 44.
13. 10 Autieri will provide 2 sottufficiali and 1 Col and 12 men for guarding the Italian vehicles within the compound. (A U.S. military guard covers the compound as a whole). A vacant lot will be allotted for the Italian Military Guard.
14. On completion of discharge of S.O. REINDELL, MILA 10 Naples will furnish to MILA 15 ship's out-turn report and statement how vehicles disposed of as between former units and delivery to Park.
15. The working of the foregoing arrangements on this trial run should also be the subject of report by MILA 10 Naples with view to repetition and/or modification of the drill for subsequent shipment.
16. MILA 10, Naples is requested to supervise closely the working of the Naples Runners' Park and in particular to ensure that 20 vehicles are withdrawn by the Italian Military Authorities except on proper authorization by E. MILA. Copies of all MILA 10 to War Ministry instructions for release of vehicles from Runners' Park will be sent to MILA 10, Naples, who should instruct Comando Campania that all release orders must be referred first to MILA 10 Naples for endorsement before vehicles are released. War Ministry will be requested by this HQ to inform Comando Campania in the same sense.
17. MILA 10, Naples is requested to allocate an enlisted man to visit the Naples Runners' Park at least once per day to check the Vehicle Status.
