1. Could the usual monthly consignment of POL please be augmented as follows:-

(a)	Diesel Oil	Barrels	2
(b)	H.P. 30	"	2
(c)	Petrol	"	5

2. Reasons are as follows:-

- (a) 38 O.M.P. and CERSA use almost entirely vehicles run on Diesel and find the present allotment insufficient.
- (b) 38 O.M.P. have necessarily to change the oil in all vehicles repaired by them.
- (c) More vehicles are now in use from the output of 38 O.M.P. Their own estimate of petrol required for the month is 21,100 litres. They are allotted about a half.

1. C.I.P. have advised this Section that A.M.G. Perugia ordered them to deliver 11.7 quintals of M.T. 80 to the Eighth Raggruppamento Cerseti, during October 1944, although no allocation had been requested by you or approved by this Section.
2. It would be appreciated if you will investigate whether or not this was an emergency delivery to a passing convoy or a delivery to an established unit in the vicinity of Perugia.
3. If the former is true, the issue was in order. However, if the latter is the case, the Supply Officer at Perugia over-extended his authority as he can only request C.I.P. to make issue to A.M.G./A.C. Allied Army vehicles and issues to Italian Army units must be approved by this Section upon your recommendation except in bona-fide cases of emergency.

1. Confirming telephone conversation Major Borrego - Capt Baxter AM. 21 Dec. 44.-
2. It has been reported from M.M.I.A. IO, 1 District that as at 18 Dec. 44 the CIP, Ancona has not received the allotment of POL for the Italian Army for the month of December (PET/30/P/18 of 27 Nov. 44 column "G" refers).
3. It is noticed that CIP, Ancona is not on the distribution list on PET/30/P/18 of 27 Nov. and it is thought that the breakdown occurs between CIP, Rome, whose job no doubt it is to forward Ancona's allotment, and ANCONA.-
4. It is pointed out that the November allotment was received by the Italian Army from CIP, ANCONA on the last day of that month.
5. Will you please check the machinery in order to avoid this big delay in future months as it is greatly affecting the working of the Italian Units in that area.-

With reference to recent conversation, General PROPERZI/HOWARD at OSIMO on the above subject, the following are the classes of Italian Army M.T. in this District:-
(i). British vehicles on loan either temporarily or permanently to Italian Units working for the British (eg. H.Q., 209 Div., HQ., 413 Pioneer Regt.) and on charge to a British Unit (eg. 61 Area).
(ii). Italian or British vehicles on charge to Italian Units working for the British.
(iii). Italian or British vehicles on charge to Italian Units not working for the British and dependent on SMRE - ROMA. (eg. 38 Officina Pesante).

2. It is considered that the first two categories of vehicles should be furnished forthwith (if not already in possession) with British work tickets which will be kept and accounted for in the normal way, and without which no petrol will be available at British Petrol Points.

3. Provision should be made for the last class of vehicles mentioned to be furnished with POL from CIP dumps, or from Italian Army dumps formed by you as necessary with POL supplied from CIP sources I have

To cover the next months requirements from CIP sources I have requested MMIA to ensure that CIP of this area is allocated 3,000 gallons of petrol for the month of November to be released to you for Italian Army purposes and as directed by you. This petrol should be available towards the end of this month. In future please render a return to this office by the tenth of each month showing the quantity of POL required by you from CIP to cover your commitments for the following month under para I, subpara (iii). I also suggest that you contact CIP authorities in the area covered by I District to discover where their POL dumps are located and either to co-ordinate a system whereby Italian Army vehicles will be able to draw from them, or to arrange for direct delivery of all POL assigned to CIP for the Italian Army to your own POL dumps.

4. I should be grateful if you would also let me have by the tenth of each month a return as set out in Appendix 'A' to this letter.
5. Please send your transport officer to OSIMO as soon as possible to discuss the problems raised by para 2 with the supplies and transport branch of this District.
