In the aim of this HQ to equip the Italian Army with one group of 3.7 H.A.A. guns for training purposes; this equipment should consist of 4 guns complete with 2 sets of RADAR No 9 Mk II Fire control.

The equipment required as far as possible:

- (a) The guns
- (b) The RADAR (2 receiving and 2 transmitting sets)
- (c) Two predictors
- (d) Two plotters Composite.

These items have been transferred to the Italian Army as listed and are not complete with full attachments and accessories to enable them to be used.

There is, unfortunately, no A.A. specialist officer in this HQ and it is therefore not possible to request these necessary items by them. The equipment required, however, which is indispensable, comprises the following:

- (a) The RADAR attachment and accessories for the 2 Predictors (including the heads).
- (b) The accessories for the Plotters Composite (instruments etc).

Please inform this HQ if this equipment is available and may be transferred to the Italian Army.

1. The technical commission entrusted with the task of identifying the RADAR apparatus existing in the depot of Montecorvino, has forwarded, on completion of its work, the following proposals:-
- a) - to purchase the marine type RADAR G D M K to be used for study purposes.
 - b) - To purchase the (I.M.) A A N 4 Mk 3 RADAR cars., of which 50 or 60 of the existing 155 can be made efficient.
 - c) - To purchase the type R D F A A N . 1 Mk 2 (G L T Mk 2 G L R Mk 2) RADAR, of which 152 apparatus with 50 generators exist (only those that have generators for Artillery firing are required).
2. This S.M. confirms the point of view already expressed for the purchasing of the above material, but it would be necessary that British specialist personnel should train Italian personnel on the functioning and repair of the apparatus.
- It would also be necessary that the British Authorities supply the missing spare parts which cannot be recovered from the existing sets.
3. For the purpose of examining all various aspects of the matter, this S.M. is of the opinion to hold a meeting at which we would appreciate the presence of a representatives of your IMA, who could give the necessary explanations for the settlement of the matter in question.


1. The external inspection of Radar held at Montecorvino Gun Park has been carried out resulting as follows:-

- (a) RADAR AA. No.1 Mk 2 sets Qty 156, (set consisting of Transmitter and Receiver) in my estimation are in fairly good condition, and putting myself safe I can definitely say, that fifty complete sets could be serviced. This is only an external inspection, but there are no signs of them having been rendered unserviceable by burning. To put the fifty sets in working order it will need at least three Radar Mechs.
 - (b) RADAR AA. No.3 Mk 2 sets Qty 2 with good Radar Mechs you may be able to service one of them.
 - (c) RADAR CD. No.1 Mk 4 sets Qty 1, could not be serviced.)
