- (a) C.C.S. approval in principle to allot arms and equipment of three British divisions to Italians.
- (b) War Office agreement to their reserves in MIDEAST and N. AFRICA being used towards this end.
- (c) AFHQ request for detailed organisations, W.E. etc which have been produced (less C. 1098 now being worked on by O.A.L. Staffs (MICHAELSON) assisted by my DADOS.
- (d) MAI. instructions to MMIA to organise and train selected Italian Units as follows: -

I need not enlarge on the political, psychological and post-war aspects of this undertaking, or the keenness of the Italians themselves, but want you to know that the Supreme Commander himself sent for General BROWNING and told him in the presence of General GARNETT that he fully approved the plans as far as they have gone and wished particularly there should be no failure to supply British khaki battledress and shaving equipment.
