



The Officer in charge of the Italian Increment at the time of disbandment was a Lieut. Ghiraldi and immediately on conclusion of the handover he proceeded to Avellino. It is understood he is not now at that location and his whereabouts are not known. There are no Italian Officers now with this headquarters; it is not possible therefore to obtain signatures as required.

It is pointed out however that Unit records held show the quantities of articles as handed over to the Italians on 30/6/45 and quantities returned on 24/4/46 both entries being supported by the signature of the responsible Italian Officer, i.e. Capt Montalto on 30/6/45 and Lieut Ghiraldi on 24/4/46.


