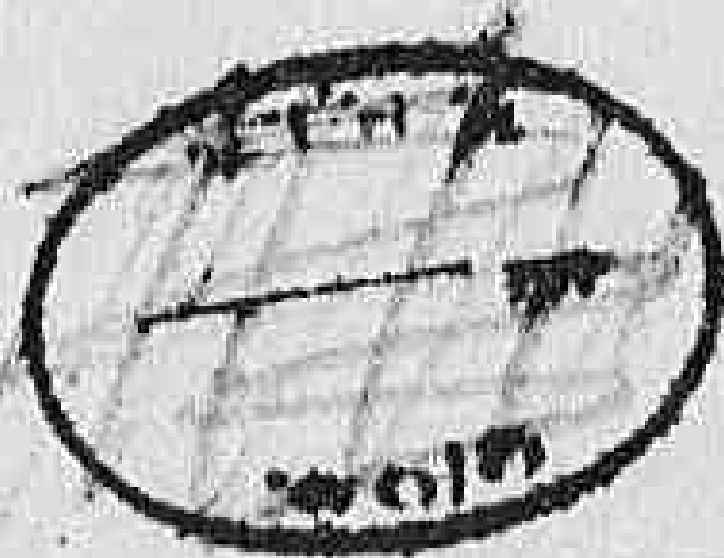

1. As a result of the reorganization of the Naval Command, ITALY by the Commander-in-Chief MEDITERRANEAN, the Italian warships, designated as category B ships will be operated by the Flag Officer ITALY and Liaison (FOIL).
2. Subsequent to 24 July 1945 movements by sea of Italian Service Personnel approved by NMIA, or of displaced persons, will, as a rule be made in Category B ships.

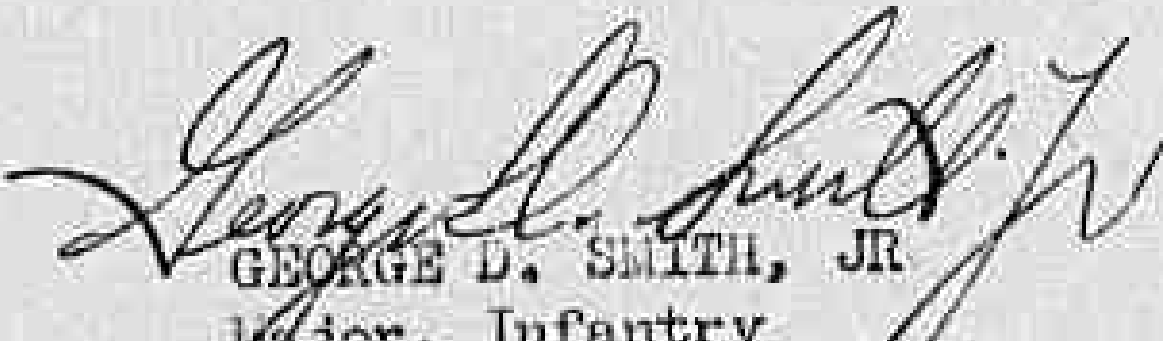

MEMO: To MMIA L.O., Naples.

1. Loaded on the SS Brighton was "KOHN" German R.R. Bridge. This bridge was held in the Engineer Depot at Abbasanta and its shipment was specifically requested by S.O.R.E. MMIA. The bridge is about 40 meters long, when constructed and weighs about 400 tons. It is made up of a large number of steel sections, beams, struts, and bearing plates. There is also included a number of cases which contain the bolts and nuts used in fitting the bridge together.

2. All of the material which constitutes this bridge was loaded in hold # 3 so that it will facilitate the unloading of this material and prevent parts of it being inadvertently diverted. Special attention should be given to unloading this equipment to prevent loss of any of the component parts.
