March '45, which confirmed phone conversation (Major Clerehugh - Davie spoke) on this subject.

3. It is pointed out that, up to the present, signals asking for confirmation of availability have been sent from this office to the appropriate vehicle parks (or coys) on receipt of release notes and replies from parks or coys have in fact been received. But this practice causes a further time lag, and additional work for this office, which would be entirely unnecessary if an endorsement asking the vehicle park to signal availability as previously I suggested, were made on the original release note.
4. May the suggestion now be put into effect please.

1. It is understood from Major Colardi of R.L.I. attached R.T.C., I.C.F. that during last week he visited Q(AM) regarding releases of vehicles both now and during this month, and the attached sheet shows a summary of the promised releases under three phases. May it be confirmed please that phase 2 and phase 3 will be implemented on or about the dates shown, i.e., 16 and 23 March respectively.

2. As you are already aware (vide copy MM's letter M/17/71 of 23 Feb. '45 forwarded from this office on 5 March '45) some difficulty has been experienced by us in collection of vehicles.

3. In an endeavour to prevent any difficulties in the future I would suggest the following simple expedient as being worthy of adoption:-

2. It will be appreciated that a deficiency of 29 out of a total of 41 is rather a severe proportion and as 32 of these vehicles are required for a transport platoon, the position is serious.

3. It is requested that 29 lorries 3 ton GS 4 x 4 be released in lieu of the lorries 4 x 2 or alternatively that the balance be released from another Vehicle Park.

3. It is earnestly requested that all the above vehicles be released as Class II. If this is not so the workshop facilities of the RTC will have to be radically increased to enable the extra work to be undertaken. The following summary of the 3-ton lorry situation as at today will serve to show how overloaded the workshop facilities are when Class V vehicles are issued :-

therefore out of 55 x 3-ton Class V lorries drawn, 28 or 50 per cent are in workshops.

Moreover Class V vehicles are only supposed to be roadworthy for 2,000 miles. It is estimated that RTC vehicles run on an average at least 50 miles a day - therefore if Class V vehicles are issued all RTC vehicles will have to be changed approx every 40 days.

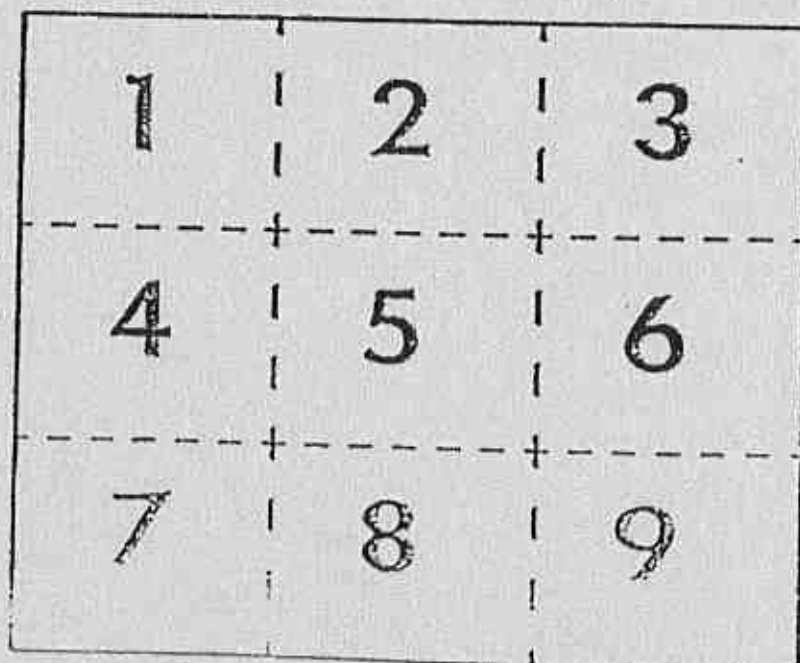
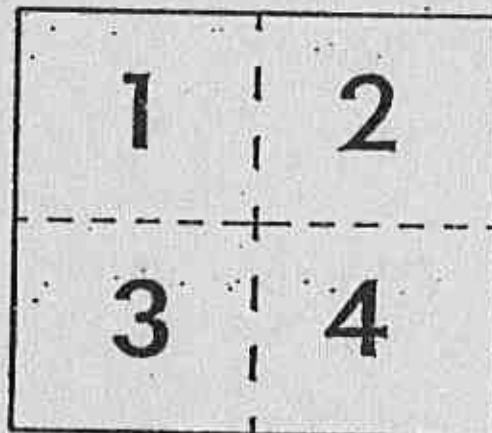
